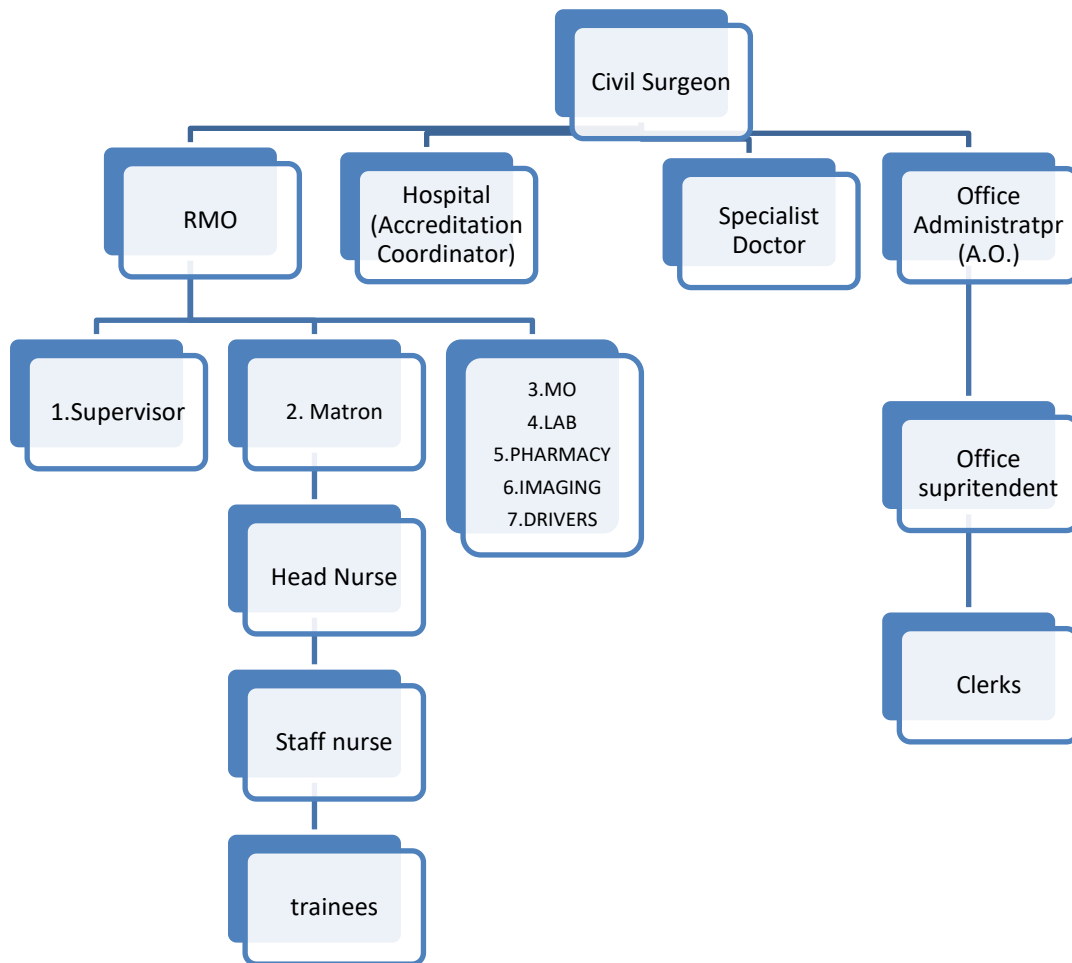
Jai Prakash District Hospital in Bhopal Madhya Pradesh Jai Prakash Government Hospital located in Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh , india), was started in January 1962 as a 75 bedded hospital and today it is one of the largest district hospitals in M.P .as 550 bedded hospital spread over in 25 acres of land it receives cases from all the neighboring districts and also has high number of facilities and specialists which results in high number of cases. In a year, Hospital provides services to 7 lacs patient in OPD, 27000 cases in IPD , 50000 in Emergency and about 4000 major and 6000 minor operations takes place annually.

It is the model hospital of Madhya Pradesh and serves as a hospital for the treatment of poor and needy people. It has one of the best doctors from the state and specialists who deal with their specialty in the areas. It has a normal footfall of over more than 1000 patients in a day receiving the treatment.

Services provided in the J.P. Hospital related to maternal and child health in the hospital.

Assessment of maternal and child health – in J.P. Hospital, there are various facilities provided for the improvement in maternal and infant mortality rates. These services are being provided on a wider scale and in under the reach of each and every patient whether rich/poor/rural/urban. As maternal health play a major role in developing the future generation- a healthy mother can build a healthy family. In healthy sense, it has to be healthy and fit physically, mentally and socially. These care services are delivered through the health workers not only in the hospital but also by the ASHA and USHA karyakarta who play essential role in tracking these patients who are requiring these basic and important health care services. The various programmes working for the welfare and development of maternal and child health in the hospital includes the following:

1. JANANI SURAKSHA YOJANA: It was introduced in year 2008. In this service there is pick and drop service provided by the hospital for the mother to reach hospital on time and from any area of the treatment. This service is carried out by JANANI EXPRESS /108. They also have a toll free number along with the call centre located in the hospital. The number is 07552551291.

For the appreciation of ASHA and USHA health workers sum of Rs. 1400 for rural and Rs. 1000 for urban areas is given as a motivational fee.

2. MILK BANK: It has been established since 2014 and is located near pediatric ward in the first floor. This service is provided to those children who are under SNCU and also who cannot suck milk themselves.

Process for the Milk Bank is followed as below:

Newborn admitted to SNCU- concern mother visit milk bank for collection of milk for baby- mother has to wash her hands before procedure and wear clean gown placed in bank- after maintaining personal hygiene sterilized bottle along with the tube is collected- with the help of vibrator machine which is attached to the mother's breast and suction the milk for baby-the milk is collected in the bottle with the help of tube-the machine stopped when the required amount is collected-the bottle lid is closed and sealed with the name of mother and baby, date and time of milk collection-the bottle is stored at 8 degree centigrade in the refrigerator- supplied to the SNCU as and when required.

3. IMMUNIZATION ROOM: It is located near NRC room on the second floor. It provides the basic vaccination facilities for the children in order to build up their susceptibility and immunity towards diseases. This facility improves the self defense mechanism in newborn and children.

Vaccines that are provided most commonly are

IPV, OPV, DPT, PENTAVALENT, TT BOOSTER, POLIO, VITAMIN, MEASLES, BCG, HEPATITIS B etc.

4. ROSHNI CLINIC: This clinic was started on 26th jan 2016, it provides health care facilities including diagnosis and treatment to the females aging between 20-40 years. All the health problems including fertility, cancer, STI, RTI or any hormonal problems or age related health issues are dealt here. This clinic works only on Wednesday every week for 2-5 pm under the guidance of 1 senior gynecologist and 2 counselors.

The workflow is followed as:

Patient is registered- checkup is done by the doctor- patient is sent to lab for diagnosis if required- treatment provided- follow up.
