1. Introduction:

3. Organization Profile:

Bhavna Jagvani, the Chief Convener of MFJCF (Mohan Foundation A Unit of Jaipur Citizen Forum) Wanted to launch Organ Donation in the state of Rajasthan, and Dr. Sunil Shroff from MOHAN Foundation, Chennai became the God Father. In the year 2014, Dr. Sunil Shroff addressed the first meeting explaining the concept of organ donation. The seeds of the movement were sown. It was a clarion call and geared up and vowed to realize the dreams of Ms. Bhavna Jagwani.

MOHAN Foundation is a non-governmental organization which was founded in 1997 to promote organ donation in the state of Chennai by one of the medical professionals, and philanthropists led by Dr. Sunil Shroff. MOHAN it means Multi Organ Harvesting Aid Network. Its offices are present in Delhi NCR, Chandigarh, Jaipur, Mumbai, Nagpur, Chennai, Hyderabad, and also in the USA. This is run by a group of medical and non-medical

professional who is committed to increasing the reach of the THOA. In 1994, the Government of India passed THOA act to promote the concept of organ donation and to prevent the commercial dealing of donated organs. But now it is possible to donate organs like Pancreas, kidneys, lungs, liver, and heart.

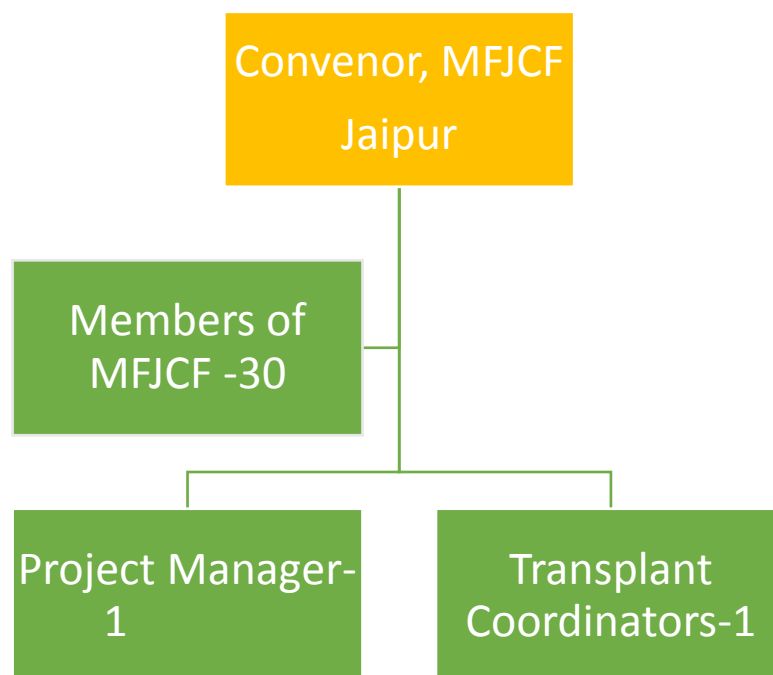
3.1 Mission:

The main aim of MOHAN Foundation is to ensure that every Indian citizen who has organ failure, receives the gift of life by getting an organ.

3.2 Objectives:

- To educate the public about organ donation.
- To provide knowledge on transplant coordinating to medical professionals
- To counsel families of brain-dead victims to donate their loved ones' organs
- By creating a strong network for logistic support for organ donation in hospitals, that leads to the effective use of the organs.
- To create a partnership with central, and state government to pass favorable legislation that will help increase organ donation in the country.

3.4 Key Activities/ Projects:

We are running Organ & Tissue Donation Project under the MFJCF since 2014. Our aim is to spread awareness about Organ Donation through various trainings and awareness campaigns. We are conducting awareness sessions in schools, colleges, corporates and governments offices to spread awareness about the noble cause of organ donation. we are sensitizing the people so that they can be the ambassador of change and spread the message of organ donation in society. Since 2015, 44 deceased organ donations have taken place in Rajasthan saving the life of 150 people.

3.5 The main work done by MFJCF so far is as follows:

1. "Do you want to donate?" this option in the application form for a driving license has been added and approved by Mr. Nitin Gadkari, Transport Minister, Government of India.
2. India's first "*Angdata Smarak*" is established in Rajasthan, which was inaugurated by Hon'ble CM Shri Ashok Gehlot Ji on the occasion of National Organ Donation Day (27th November 2020).
3. All the historical monuments in Jaipur light up in Green Colour on The Organ Donation Day.
4. An organ transplant institute is under construction in Jaipur due to our constant and tireless efforts.
5. Also, the RNOS website was developed to aid the sharing of data of recipients.
6. Under our guidance 250 transplant coordinators were trained.
7. We have inspired 60,000 people to donate organs by launching a "*Sahodaya Project*" and conducting more than 200 awareness campaigns from various schools and colleges.
8. We have done 544 organ donation awareness programs in 136 villages of Rajasthan under the Panchayat Project which is still being run.
9. Also, Organ donor families will get free Blood from "*Swasthya Kalyan Blood Bank*".
10. Apart from this, many other types of work are being done by us like:
 - i) Toll-free helpline for organ donation has been made available in 6 languages.
 - ii) We have also started Mohan Foundation Mobile Application and Website in 6 languages so that people can get all the necessary information regarding organ donation.
 - iii) Regular programs are being organized on All India Radio to reach the "*Gao Gao*" organ donation initiative.

4. Key Learnings:

As we know that learning is a continuous process. It is practical journey equip with practical knowledge and also improved my skills in this field. These practical knowledge and learnings are something which will stay us in my entire career life.
