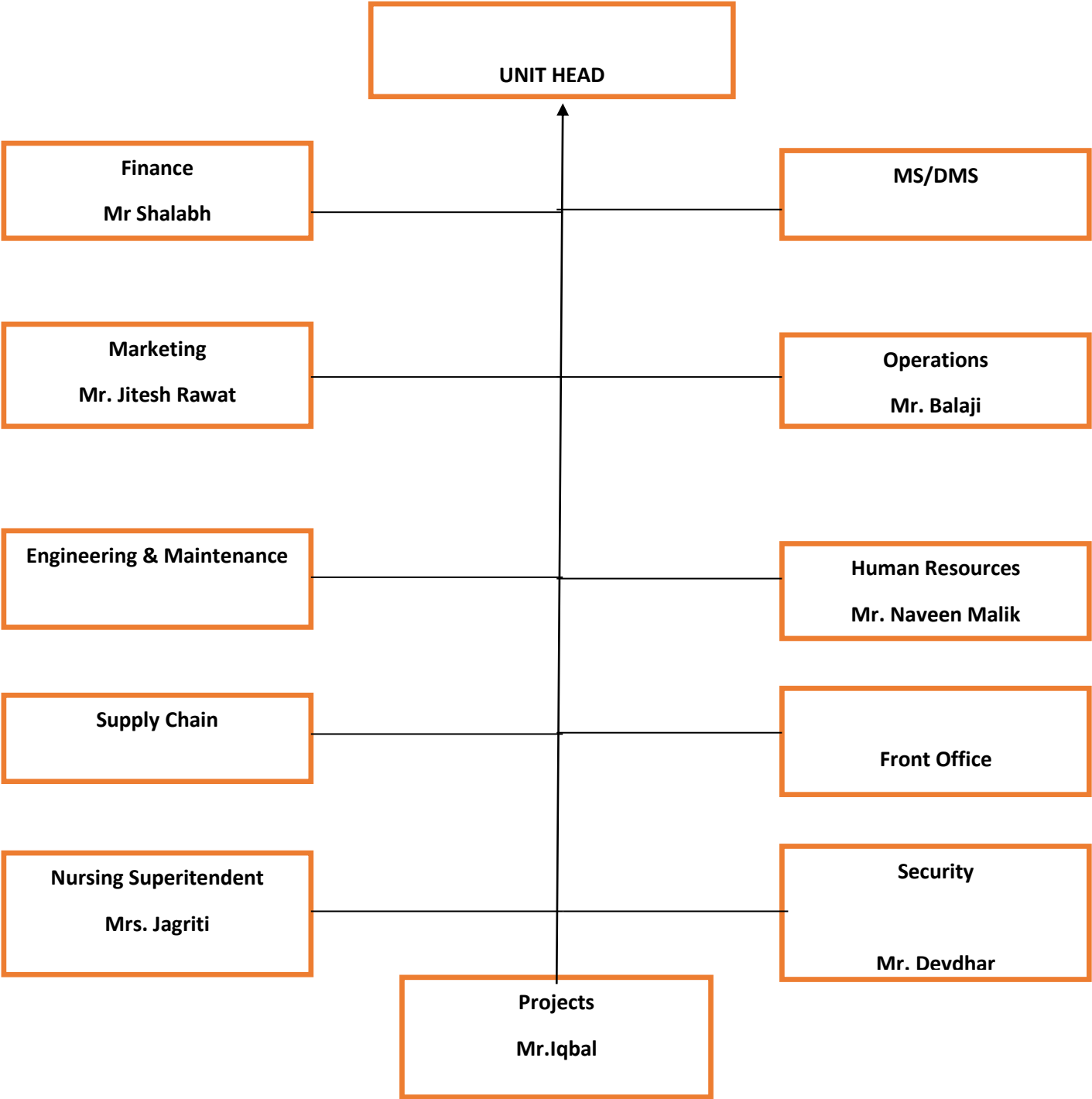

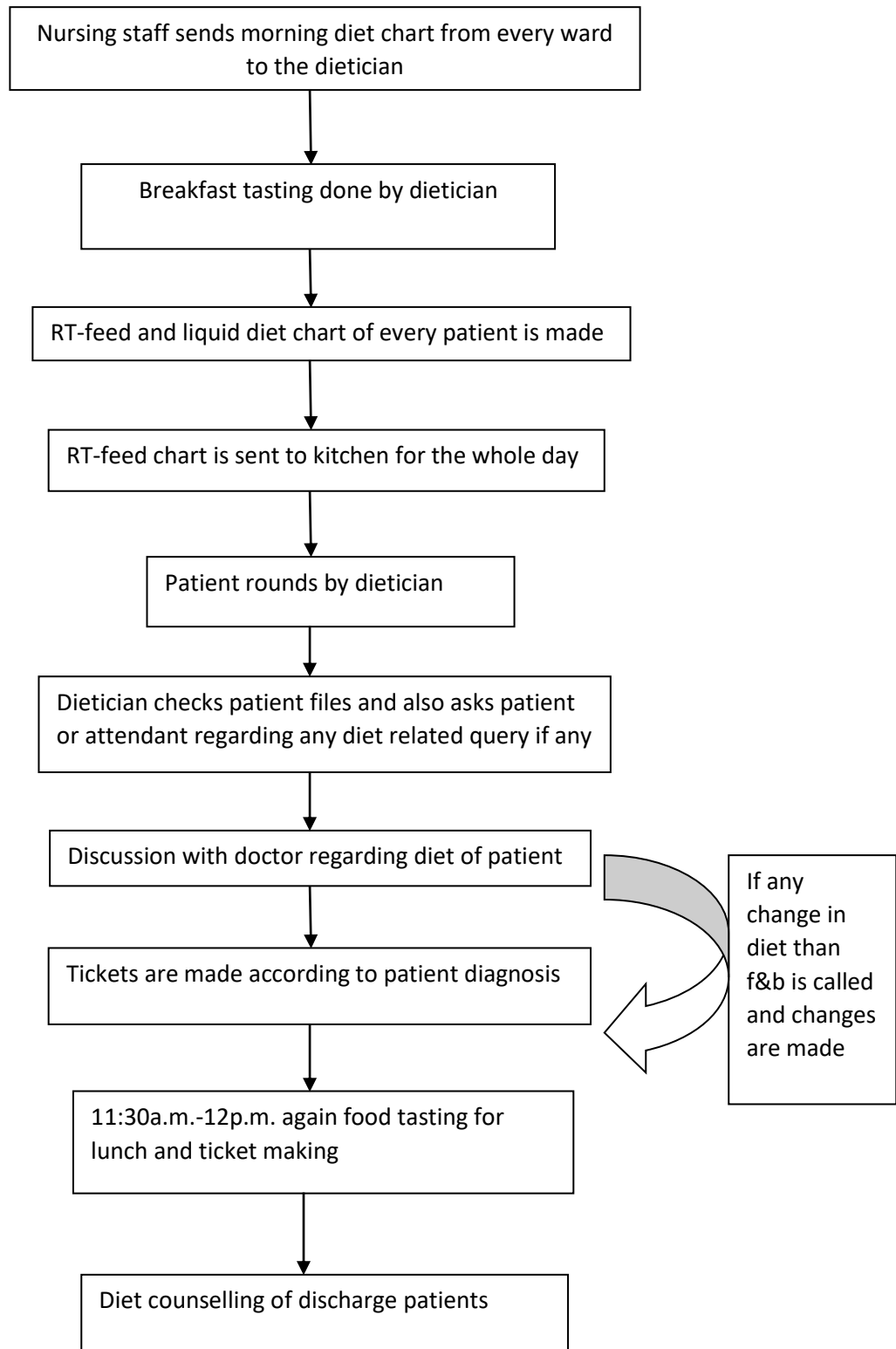

PROCESS



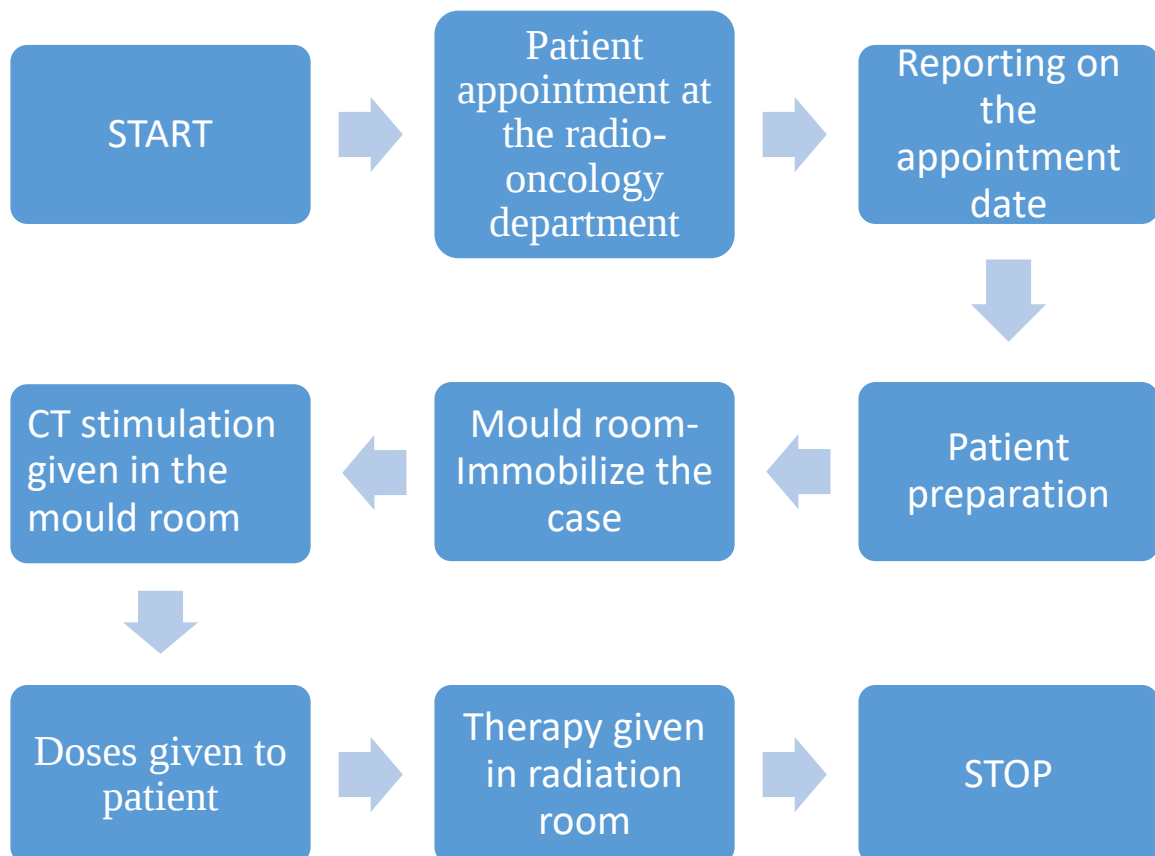

PROCESS FLOW OF NEW PATIENT:-

STEPS:-

- 1) Consultant refers the patient to radio-oncologist for radiation therapy
- 2) Patient counselling by radio-oncologist suggests and explains
- 3) Patient comes to reception for entry
- 4) Patient enters in the radio-oncology department
- 5) Radio-technologist and oncologist do mould preparation in mould room
- 6) CT-stimulation of patient
- 7) CT images comes to the treatment planning system(TPS)
- 8) Oncologist will conclude from the CT image
- 9) Physicist plan for the patient/case
- 10) Oncologist approve the case
- 11) All information appears in therapist system
- 12) patient called on second or third day for the therapy
- 13) second day patient came directly to the department
- 14) consent form signed by patient
- 15) procedure is explained to the patient
- 16) verification of treatment
- 17) treatment starts in the radiation room (15-20min)
- 18) treatment done
- 19) card/diary given to patient for follow up
- 20) exit

The three months internship period at the organization was a highly enriching experience with learning new ways of process of work, acquiring skills, facing few difficulties and learning lessons to overcome them
