ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION

History

IGMC- Himachal Pradesh Medical College at Shimla (HPMC) was established in the year 1966 with admissions of 50 students in the first batch. Indira Gandhi Medical College is affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. With the establishment of Medical College in the State, the hopes and aspirations of the people of the state were met with the standards of health services going on and students benefiting with the advantage of staying home and getting better educational avenues. Medical College then had a modest beginning with makeshift arrangements for hostels etc., but ecstasy of joining the Medical College located in Shimla with its salubrious climate, took away the agony.,

Indira Gandhi Medical College and Hospital was established as an institution of state importance with the objects to develop patterns of teaching in Undergraduate and Post-graduate Medical Education in all its branches so as to demonstrate a high standard of Medical Education in Himachal Pradesh; to bring together in one place educational facilities of the highest order for the training of personnel in all important branches of health activity; and to attain self-sufficiency in Post-graduate Medical Education.

The Institute has comprehensive facilities for teaching, research and patient-care. As provided in the Act, IGMC conducts teaching programs in medical and para-medical courses both at undergraduate and postgraduate levels and awards its degrees. Teaching and research are conducted in all disciplines. In the field of medical research IGMC is the lead, having more than 40 research publications by its faculty and researchers in a year. IGMC also runs a College of Nursing and trains students for B.Sc.(Hons.) Nursing post-certificate) degrees.

NHM, Himachal Pradesh- For the effective implementation of National Health Mission in the State a separate Mission Directorate (NHM) has been created within the Directorate of Health headed by Mission Director. It has a Programme Management Unit (PMU) headed by a Deputy Director cum State Programme Officer and a Financial Management Unit (FMU) headed by Jt. Controller Finance. The Mission Directorate functions in close co-ordination with Directorate of Health and reports to the Principal Secretary (Health). The plans and budget of the vertical programmes have been integrated in the State NHM.

In Himachal Pradesh the Mission is operating through the existing structures of Health Department up to Sub-Centre level. There is a State Health Mission at the State level chaired

by Hon'ble Chief Minister. A District Health Mission has been constituted at District Level with Chief Medical Officer as Member Secretary and Deputy Commissioner as convener. The Govt. has decided to constitute Rogi Kalyan Samities up to PHC level with increased public and Panchayati Raj partnership. The community is also involved in the functioning of health institutions through Village Health Committees at village level, Panchayat Sub-Committees on Health Education and Sanitation at Panchayat level and Rogi Kalyan Samities in all the Hospitals from PHC upwards.

The public health services in the rural areas at village level are delivered through Anganwadi Workers as Link Workers. The Anganwadi Workers are already involved in ante- natal registration of pregnant women, nutrition and immunization of children and providing of DOTs etc. Keeping in view the vast presence of Anganwadi Workers in the State (more than 18,000 Anganwadi's for 17,495 villages). The Department of Health and Family Welfare intends to utilize the strength of Anganwadi Workers for health delivery system at village level in place of ASHAs. There are 2068 Health Sub-Centres, 479 PHCs, 80 CHCs and 53 Sub-Divisional and Higher Hospitals in the State. The Sub-Centres are manned by a male and female health worker, a Medical Officer heads the PHC. There are 70 Block Medical Officers functioning in the State. The Chief Medical Officers control the implementation of all the programmes in their districts through Programme Officers and BMOs. At the Directorate level, the Director Health Services looks after general establishment, budget, planning and other programmes through additional / joint / Deputy Directors and other Programme Officers

Additionally, NHM organization has comprehensive facilities for research in medical and related sciences. Training and research are conducted in all Programs Divisions. And separate budget is allotted for research activities under the different programs in each year state PIP

Departments

IGMC- Thirty-three clinical departments including nine super specialty centers manage practically all types of disease conditions with support from pre- and Para-clinical departments. IGMC also provide services as follows: **Inpatient**-In Patient and outpatient services are provided in Rural Training Health Center at Mashobra attached with department. **Outpatient**- Outpatient services are provided at Urban training Health Center, Boileauganj.**Diagnostic & Lab services**- Routine diagnostic and lab services are provided at both the training centers. Hb, TLC, DLC,ESR, Urine for alb. & sugar at Boileauganj. Hb, TLC, DLC,ESR, Urine for alb. / sugar, X Ray, semi auto analyser at

Mashobra. **Special Clinics** -Provide consultation to referred animal bite patients on rabies prevention. Immunization for Swine Flu.
