STUDY DESIGN - Cross sectional descriptive

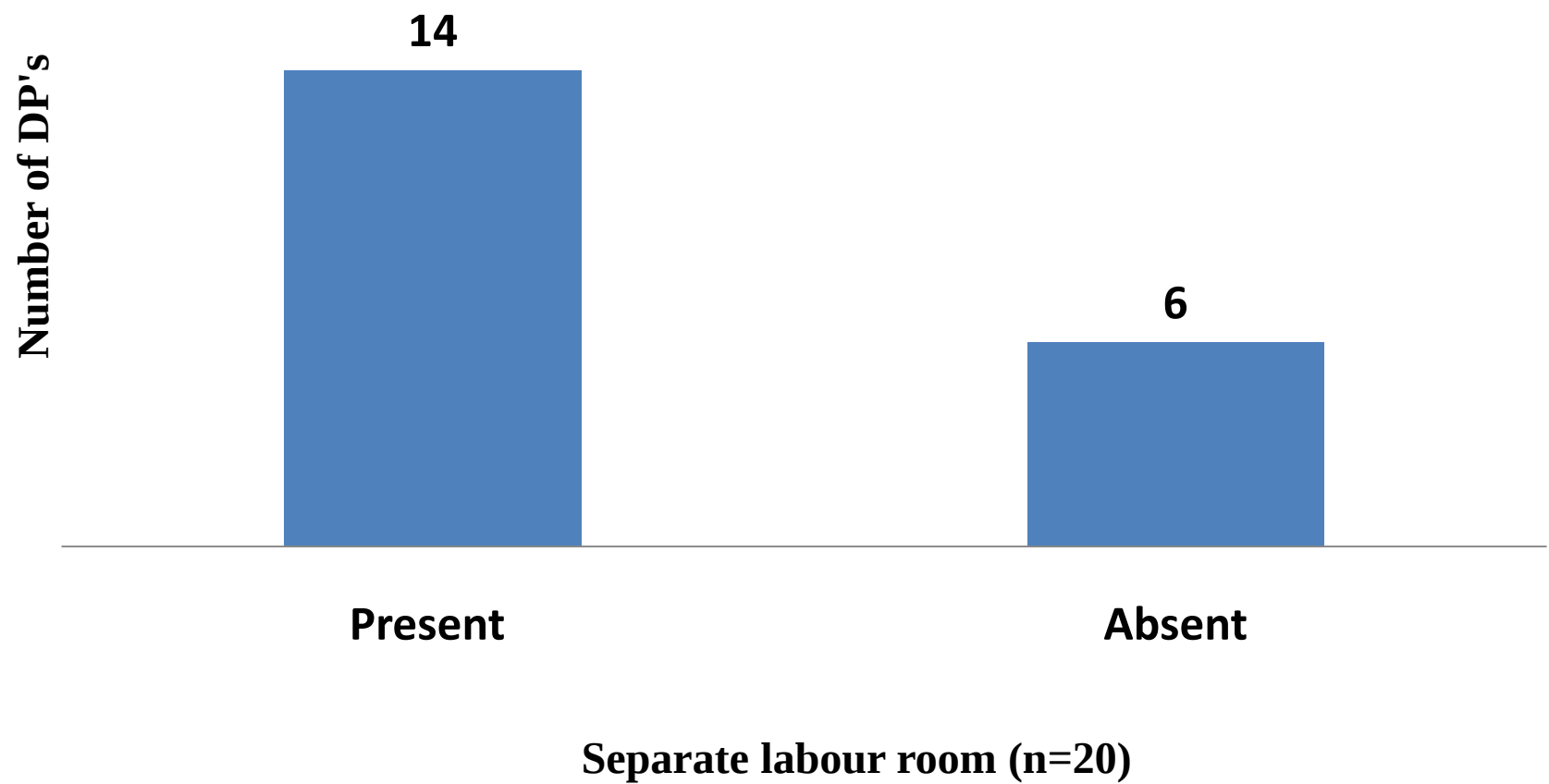

April)

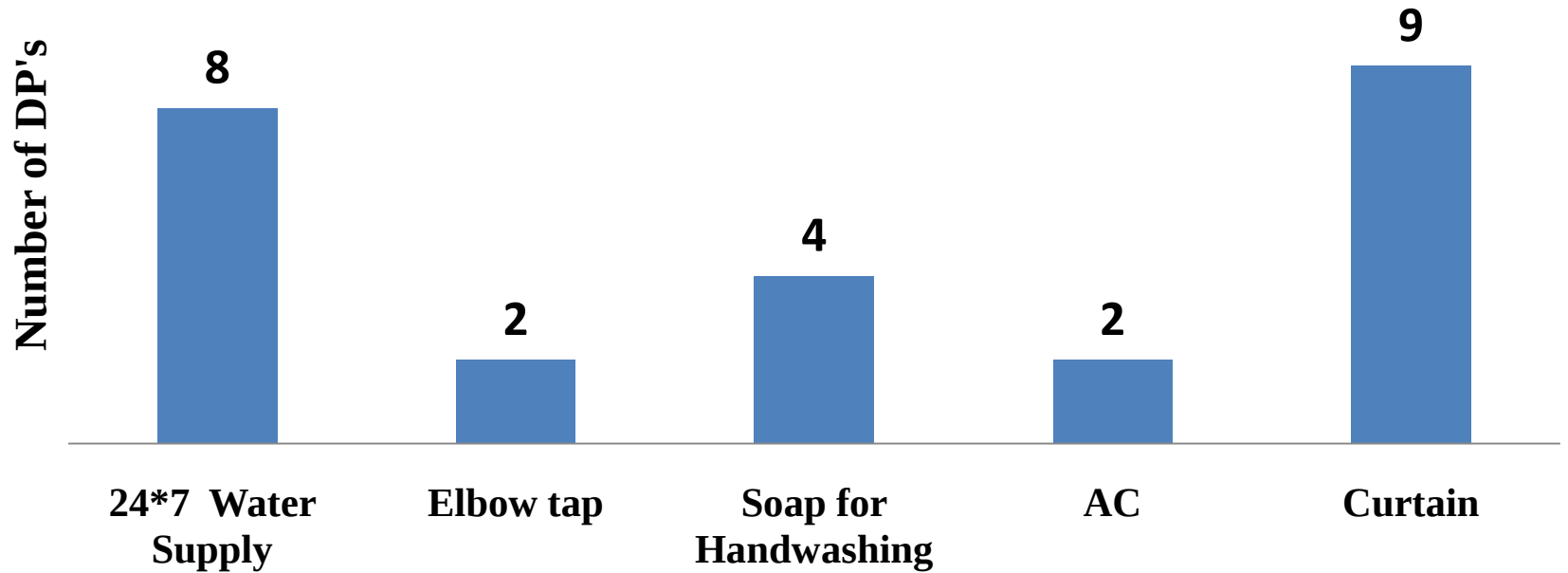

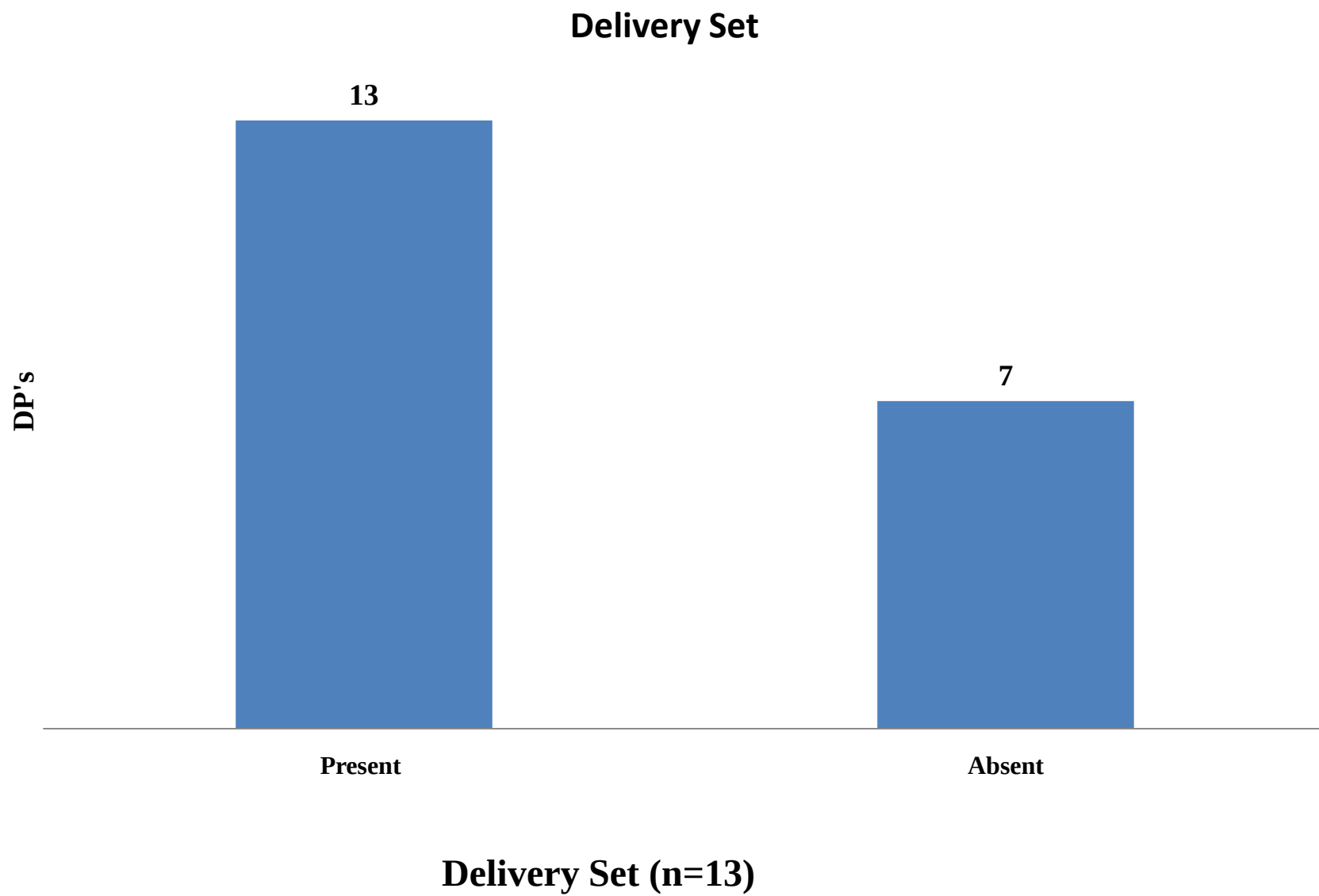

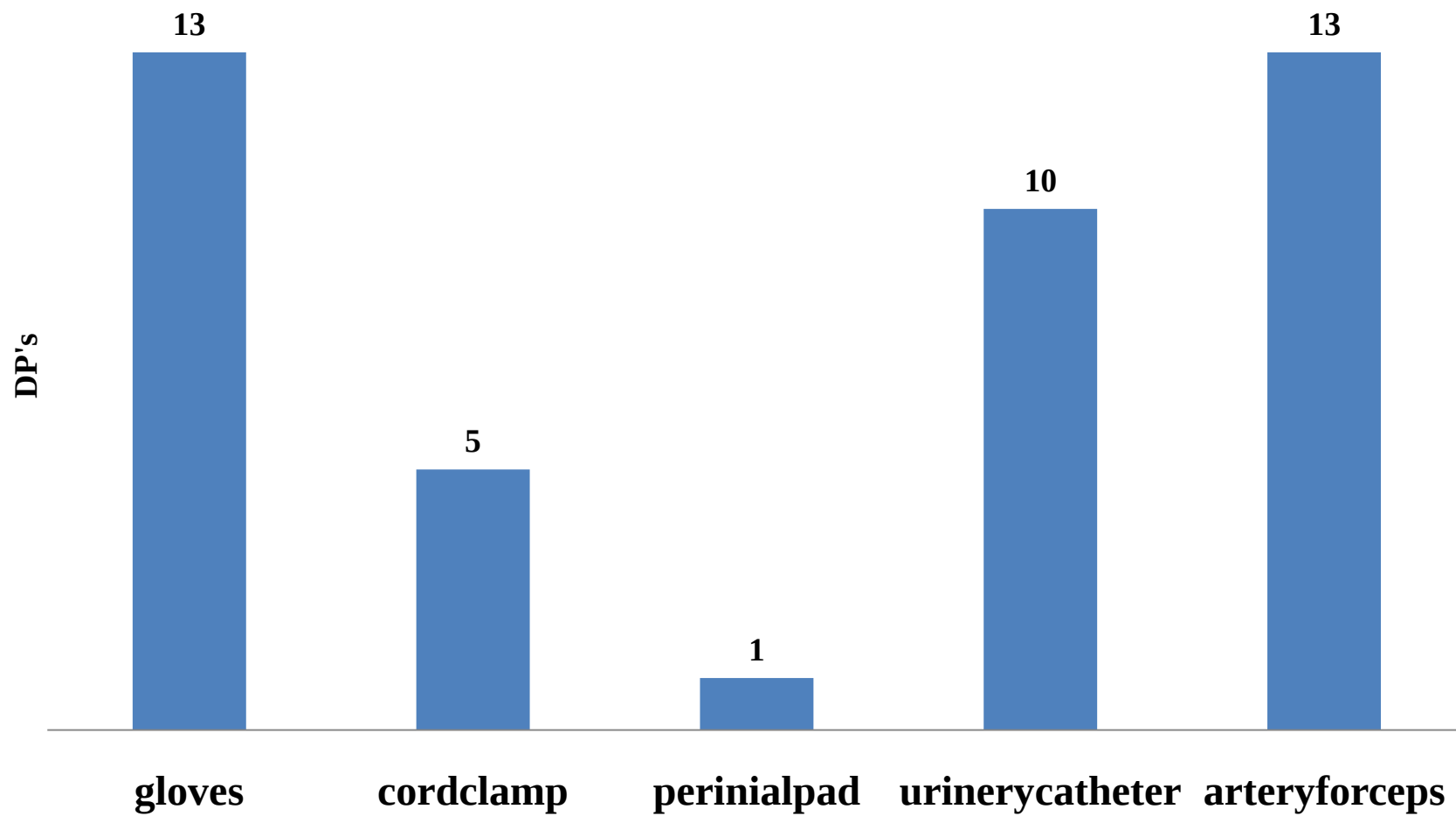


Basic Amenities (n=14)

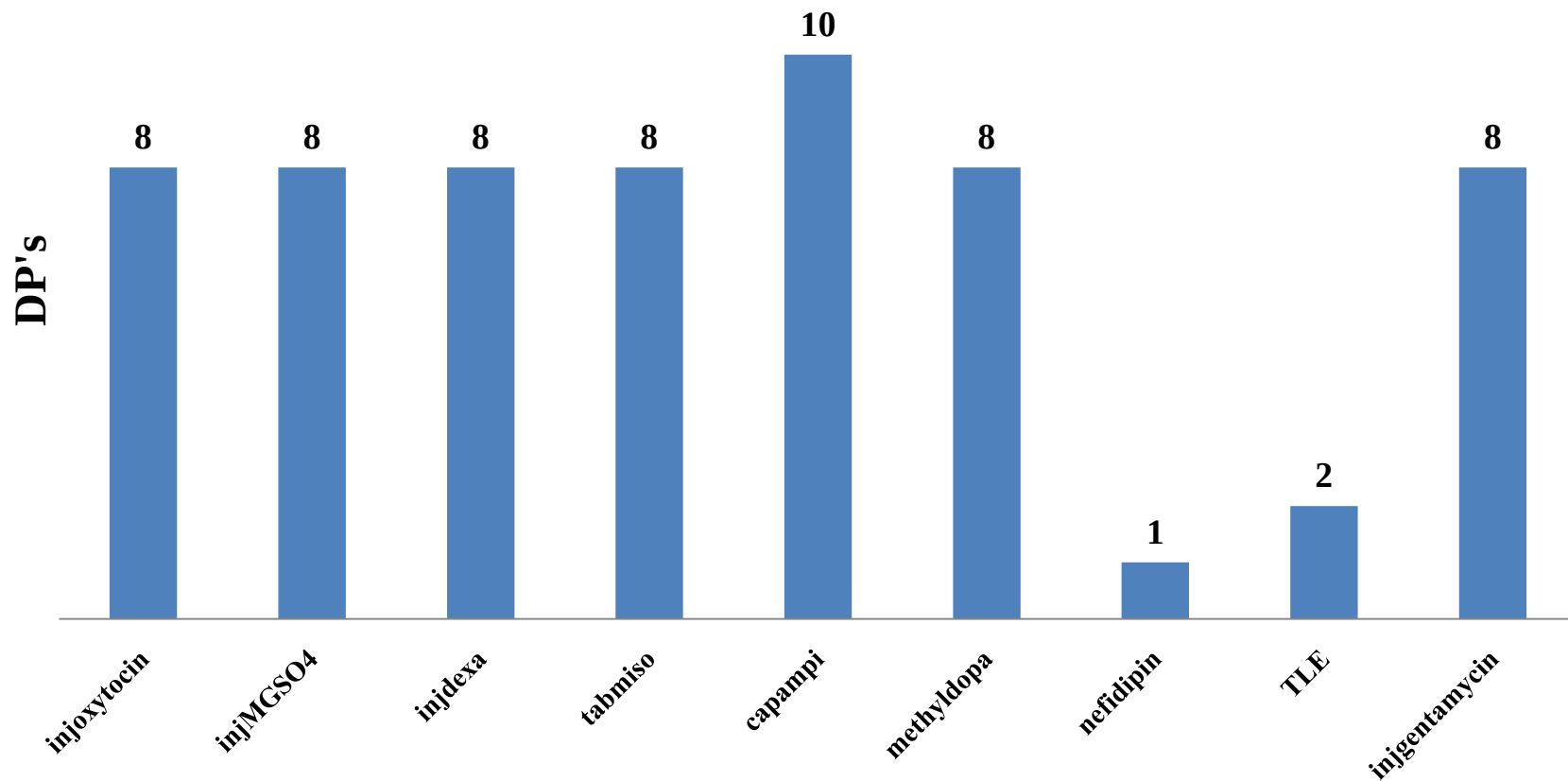

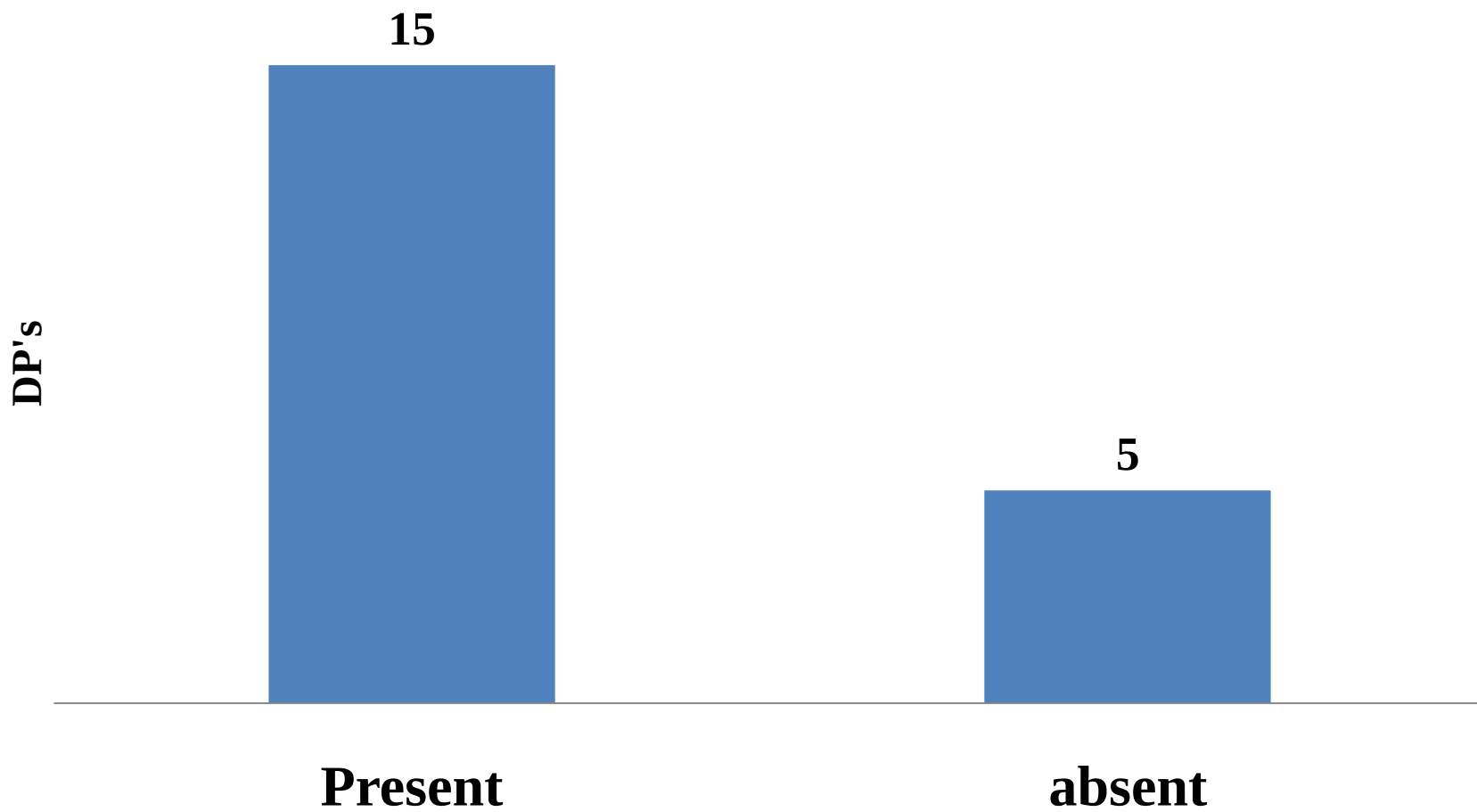




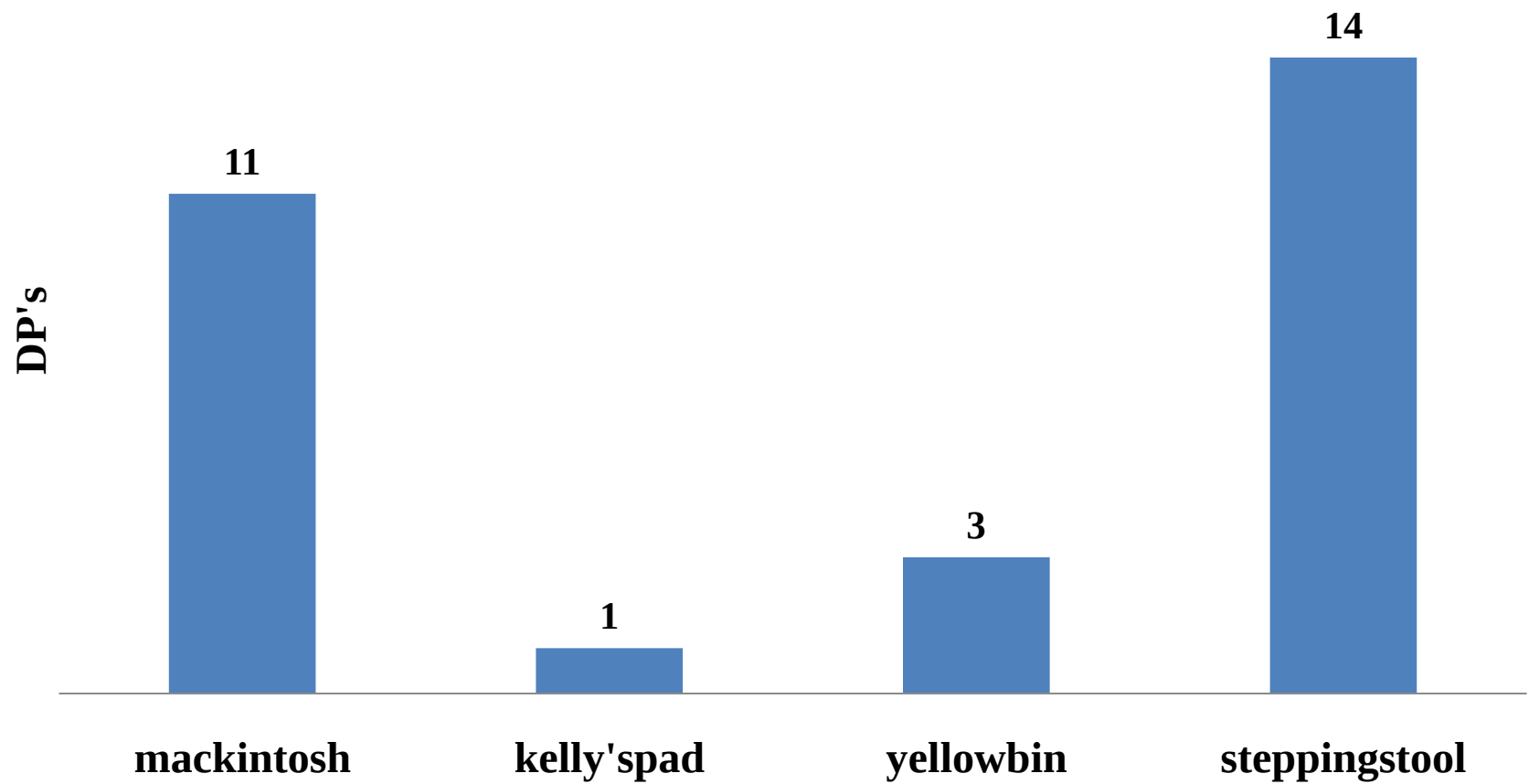
Availability of items in Delivery set (n=13)



Medicines in medicine tray (n=14)

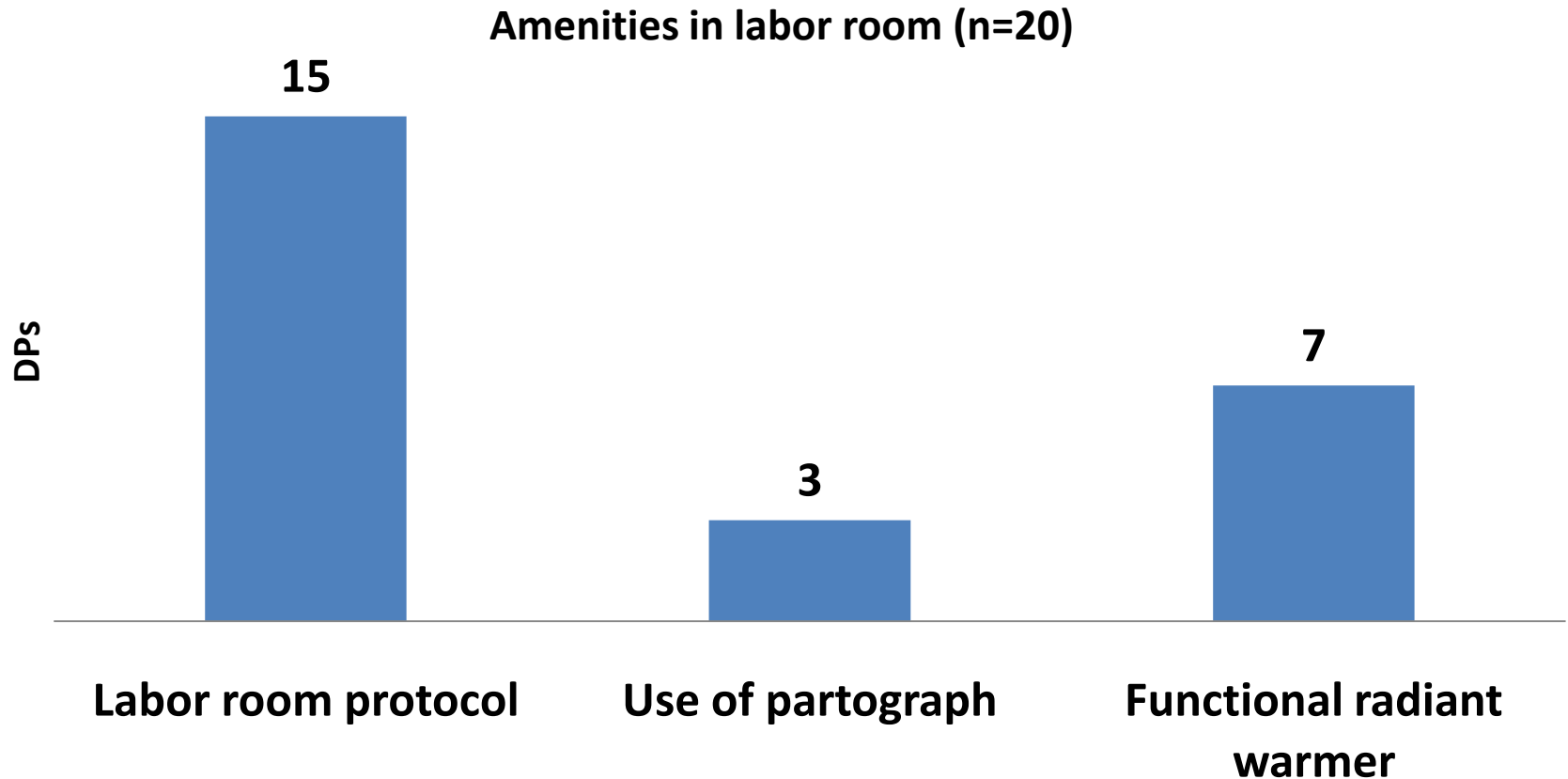


Labour table present (n=20)



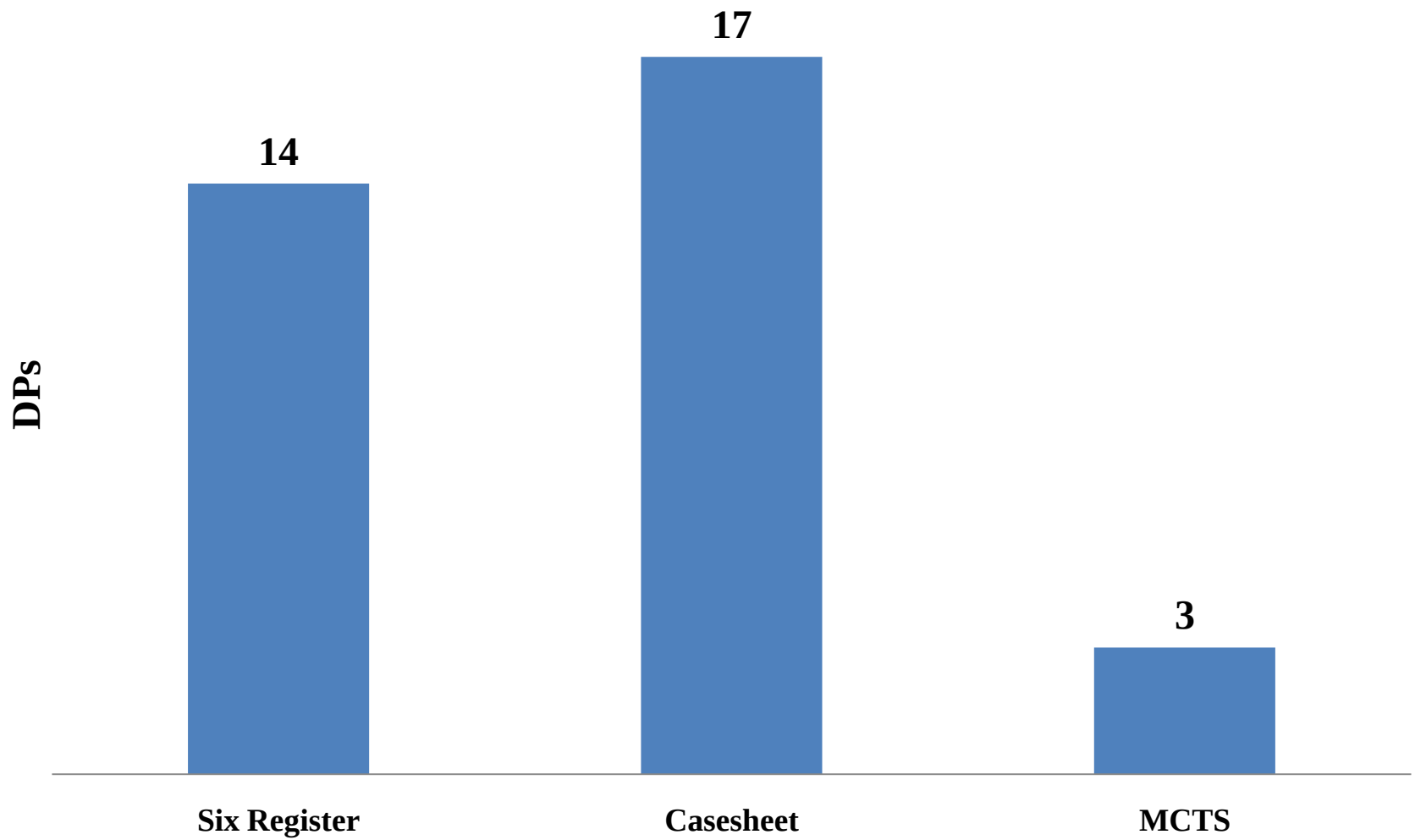
Things present in labor table(n=15)

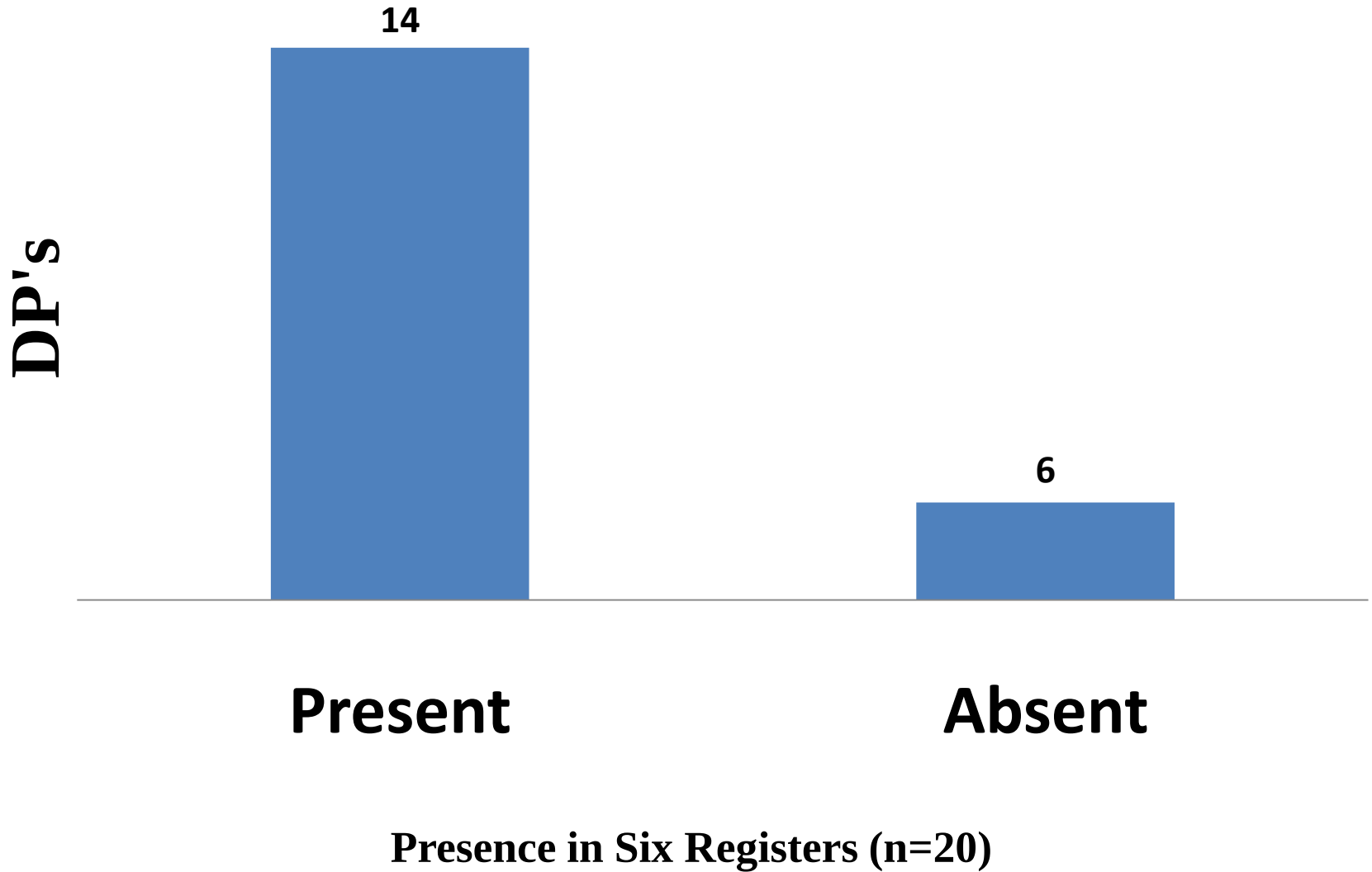


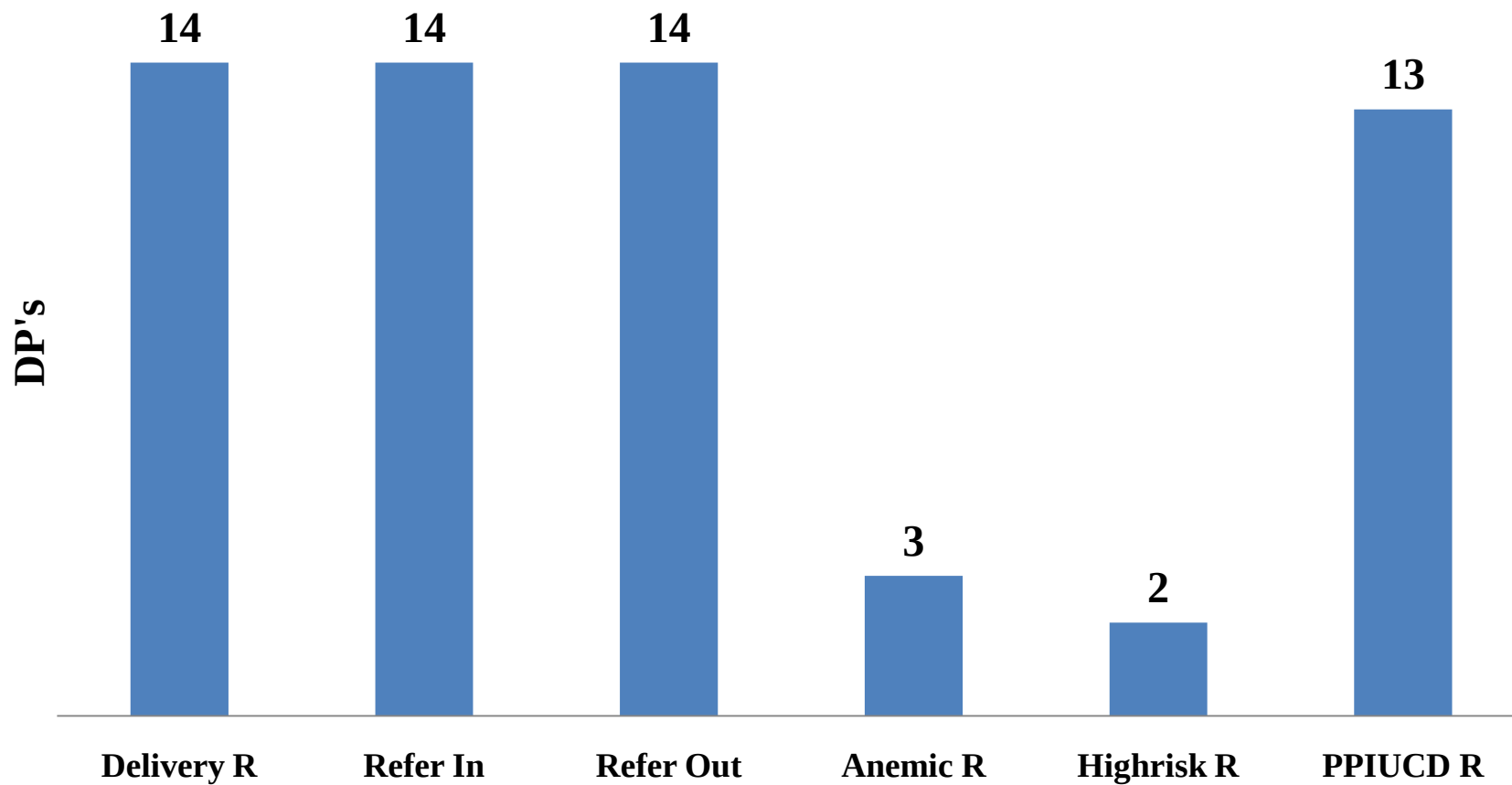

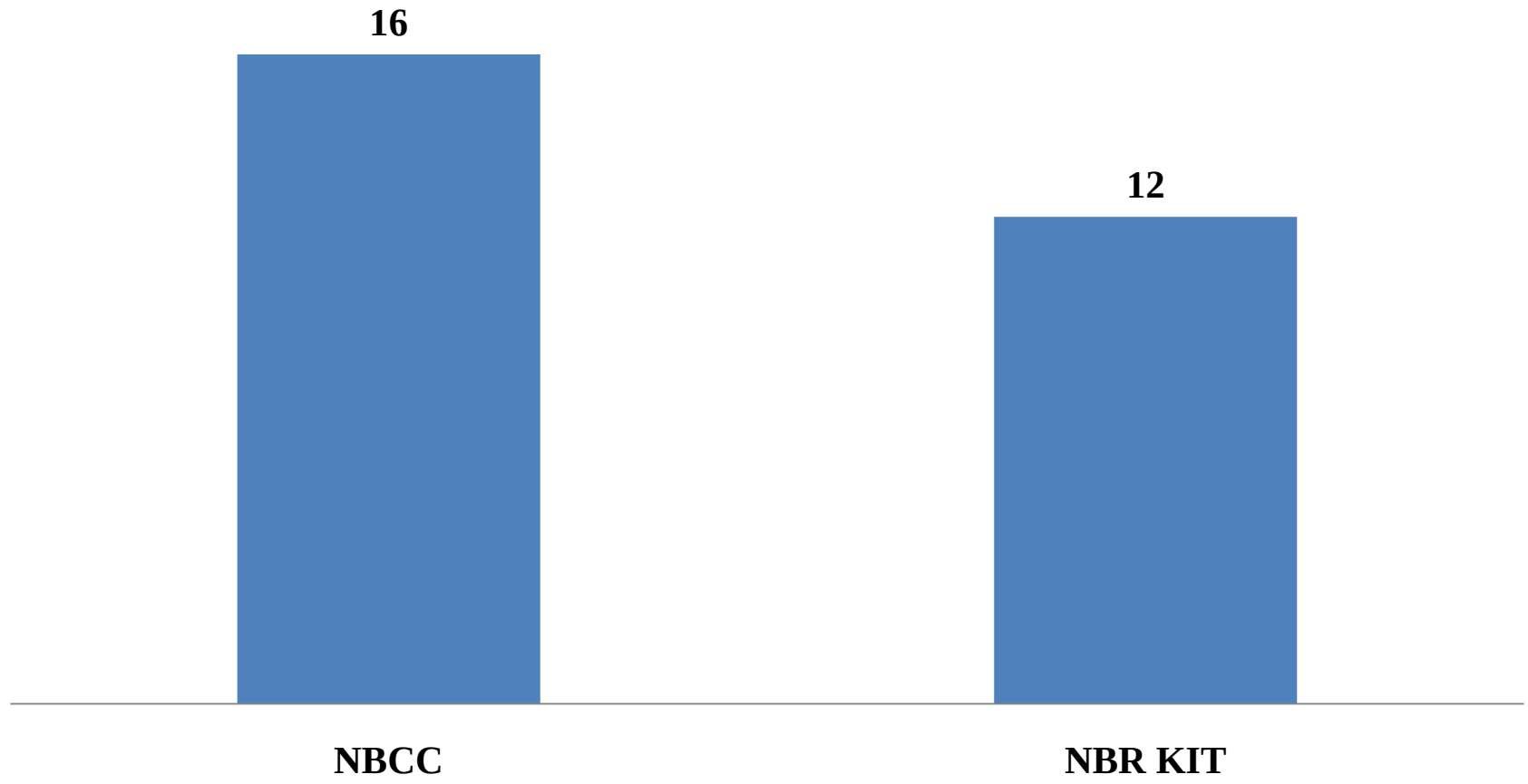
PRESENCE OF RECORDS (N=20)



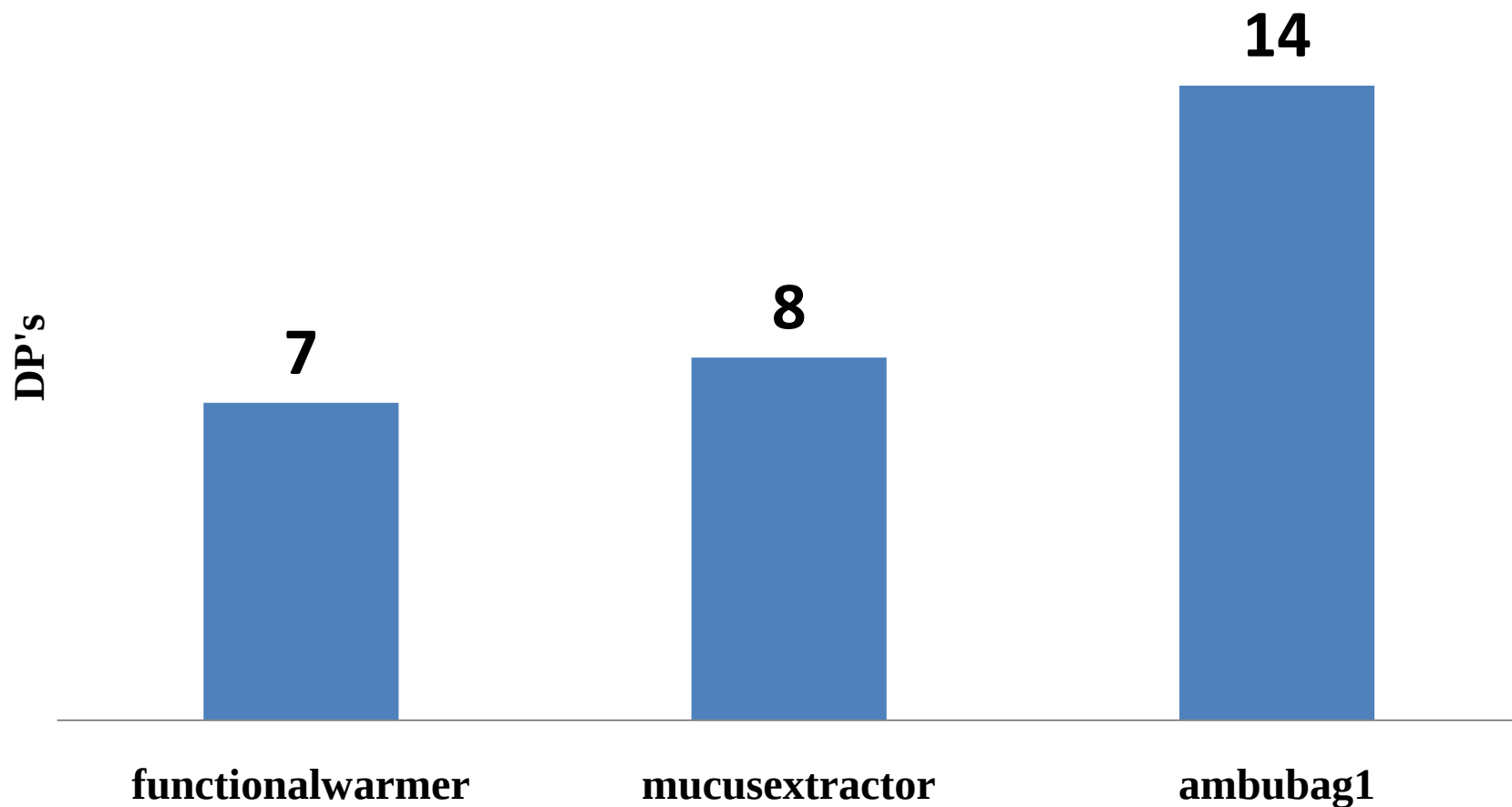


Type of register (n=14)

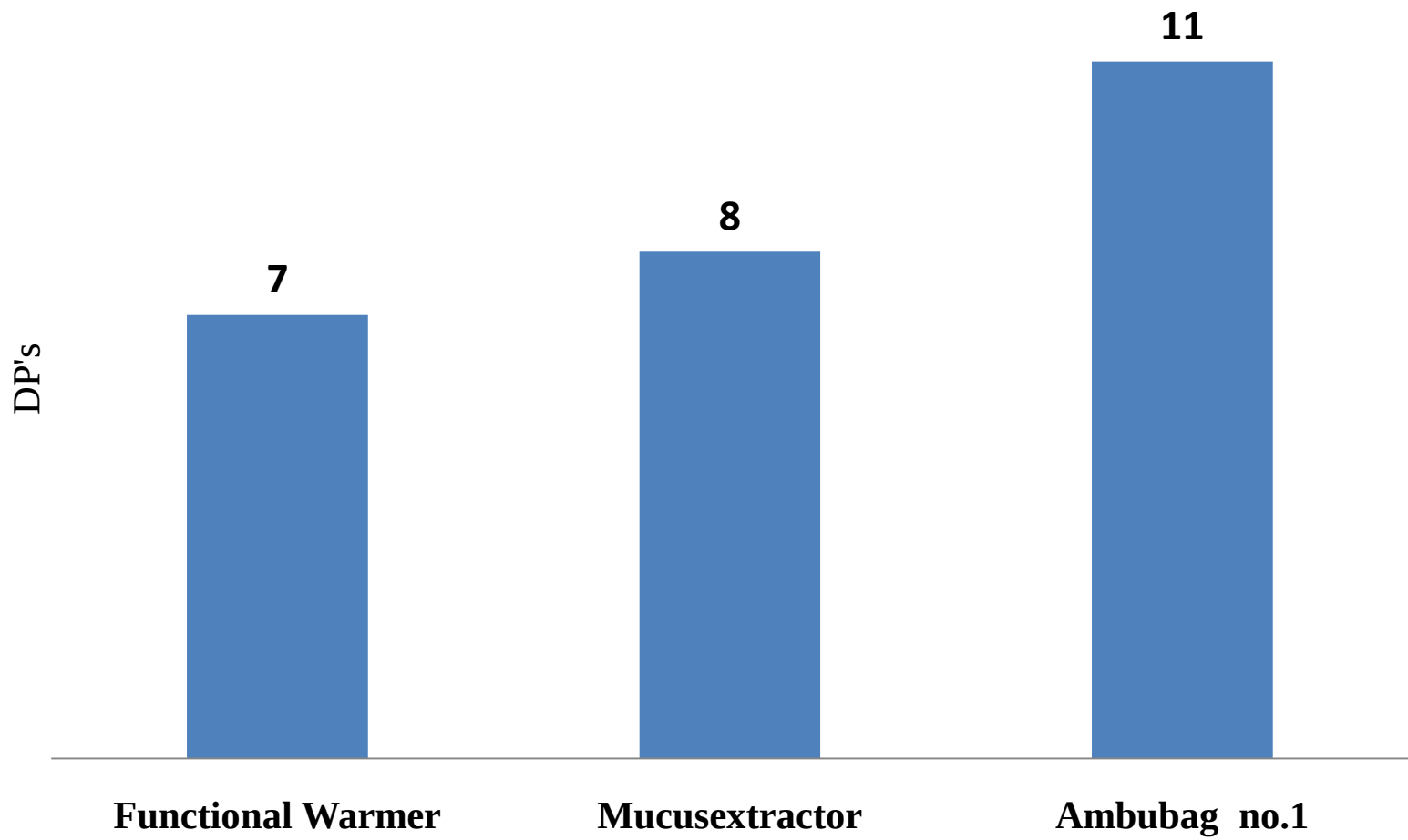

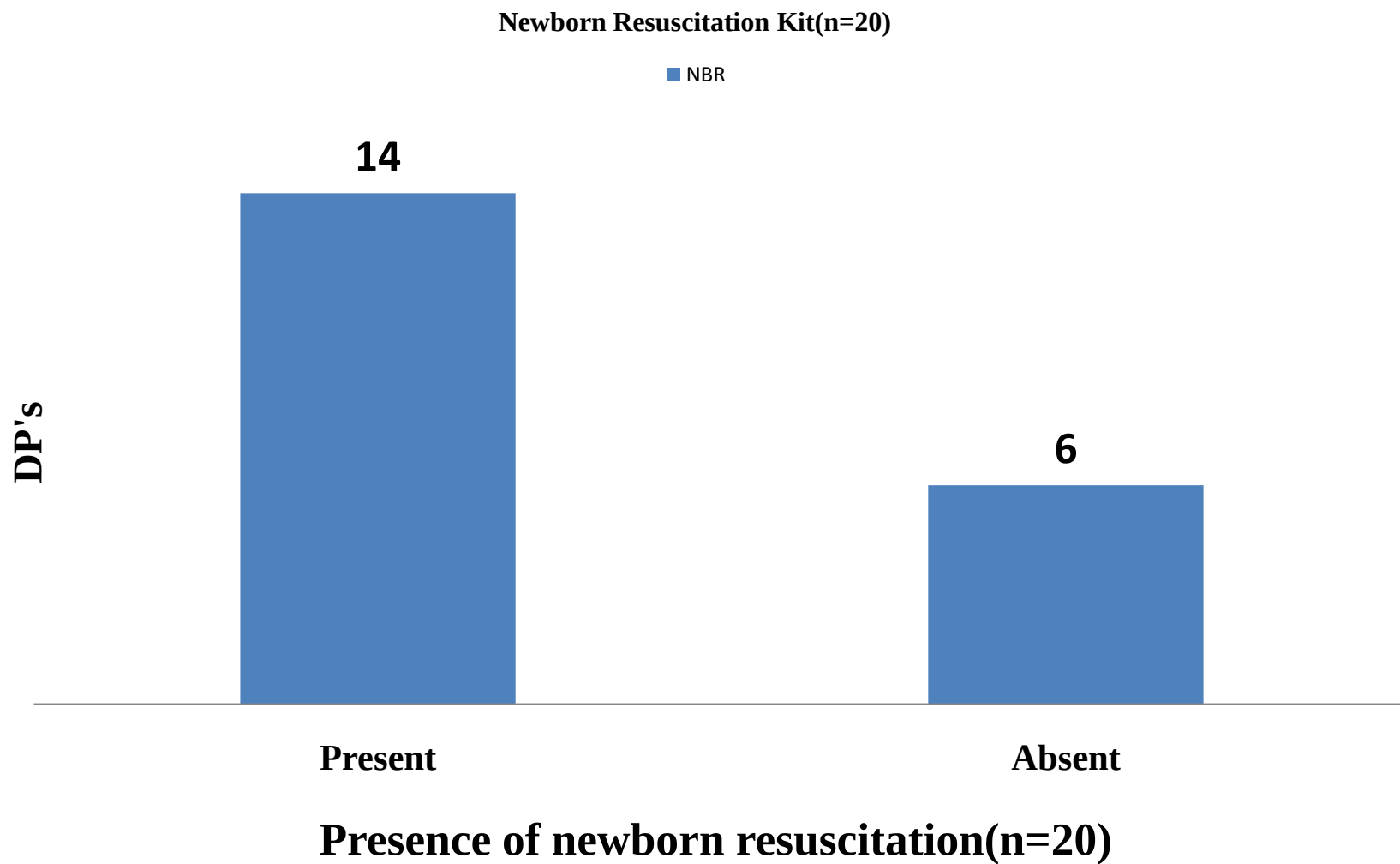

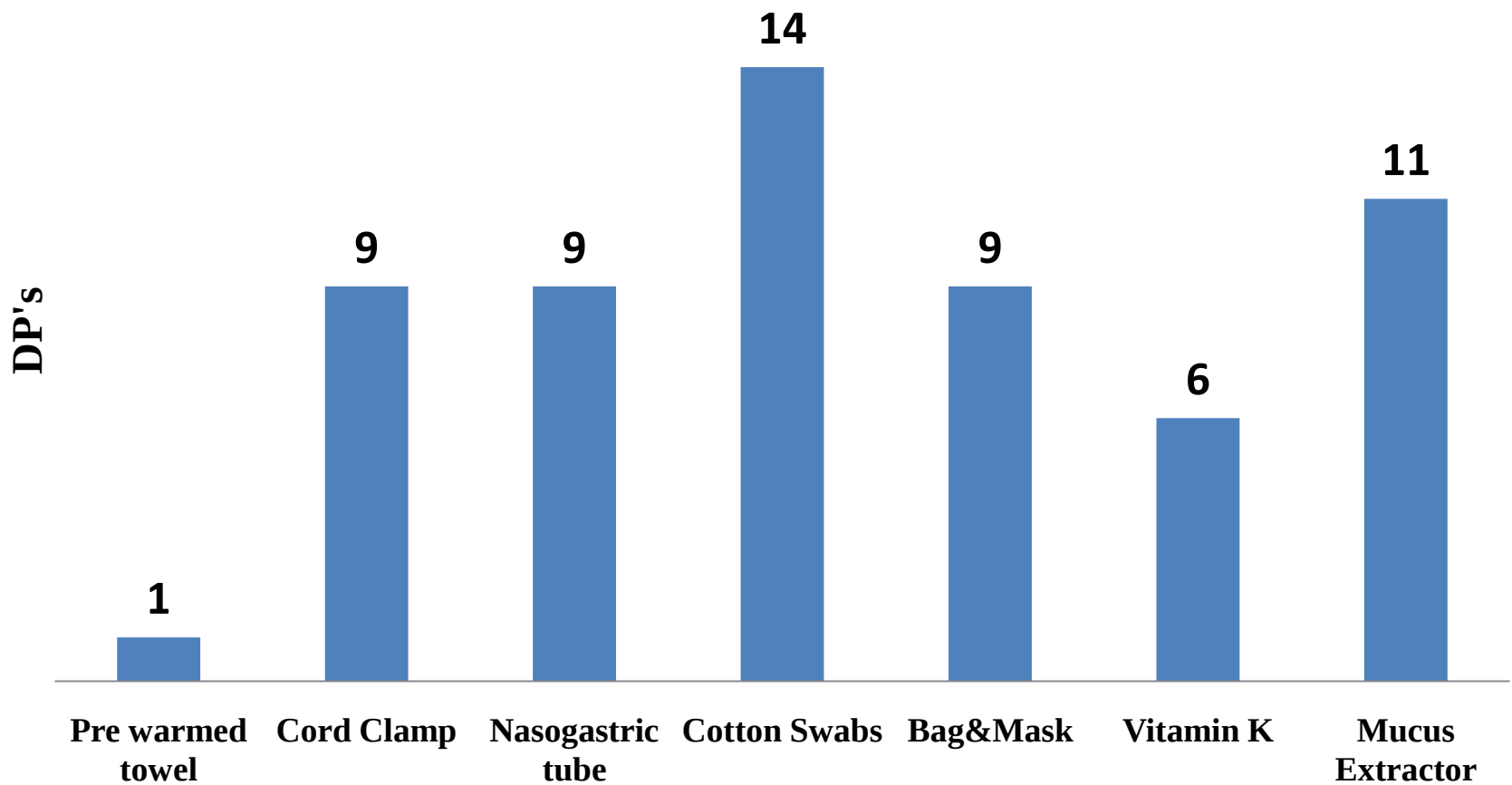


Amenities present at NBCC(n=16)



Amenities at NBCC(N=12)





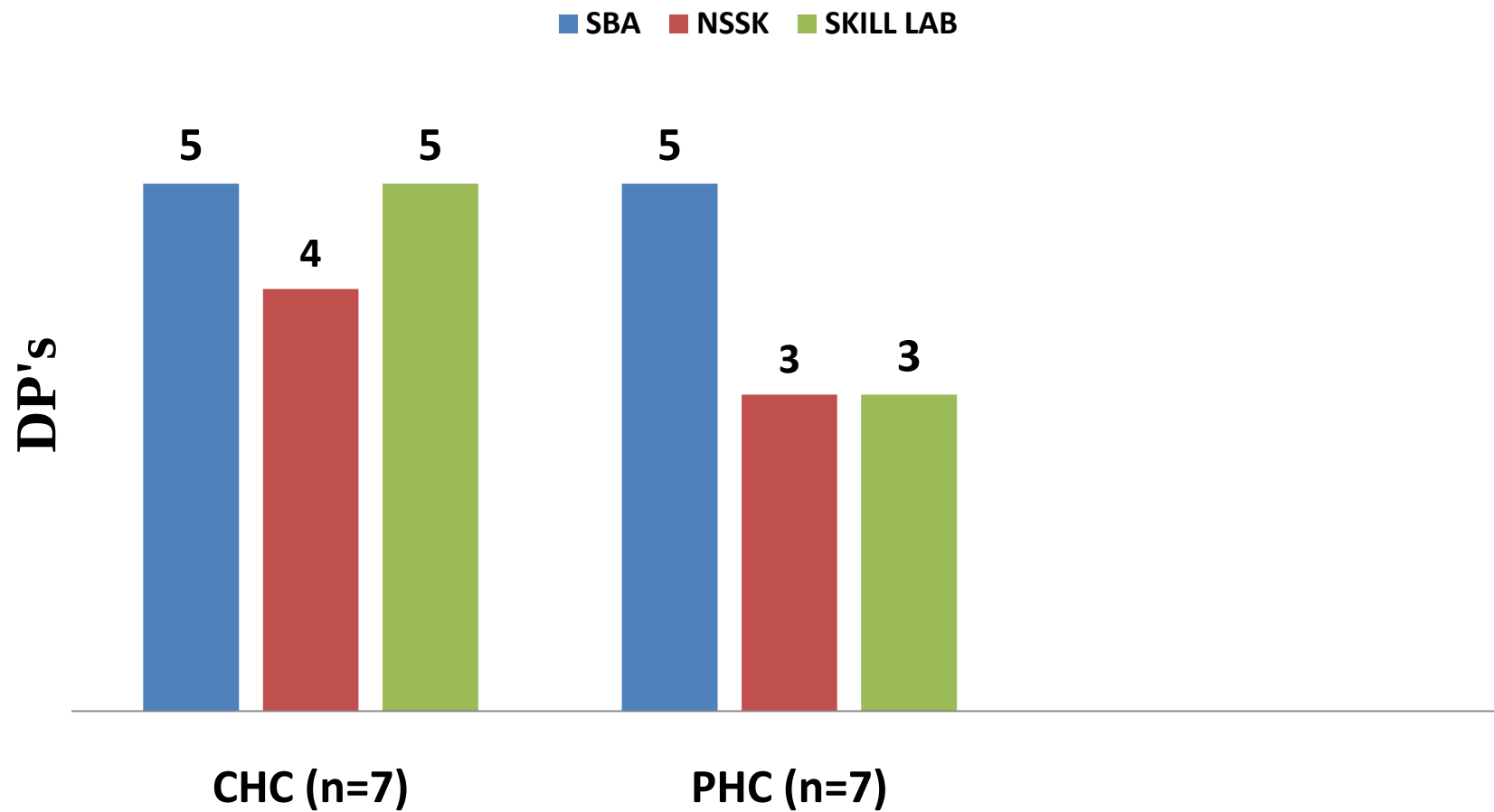

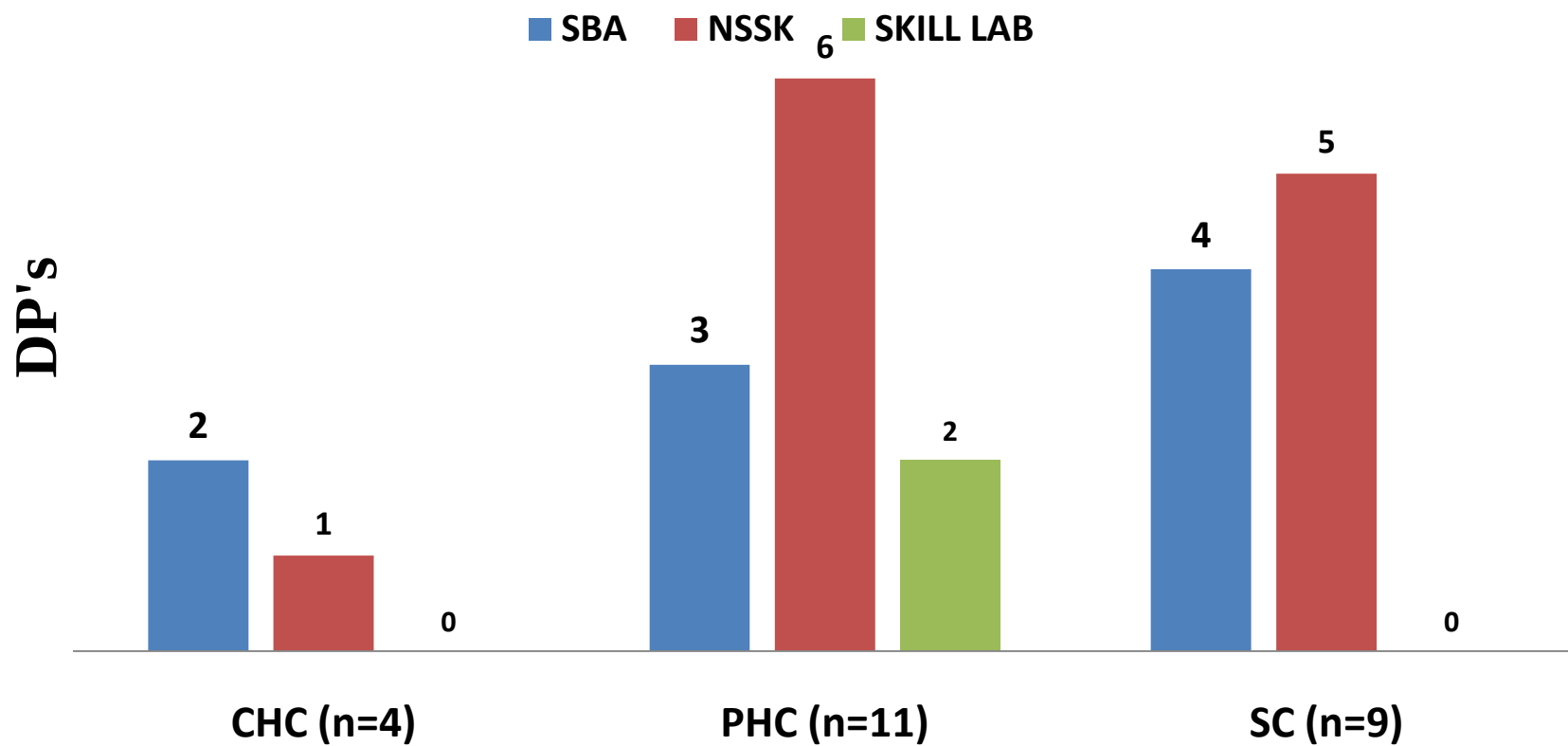

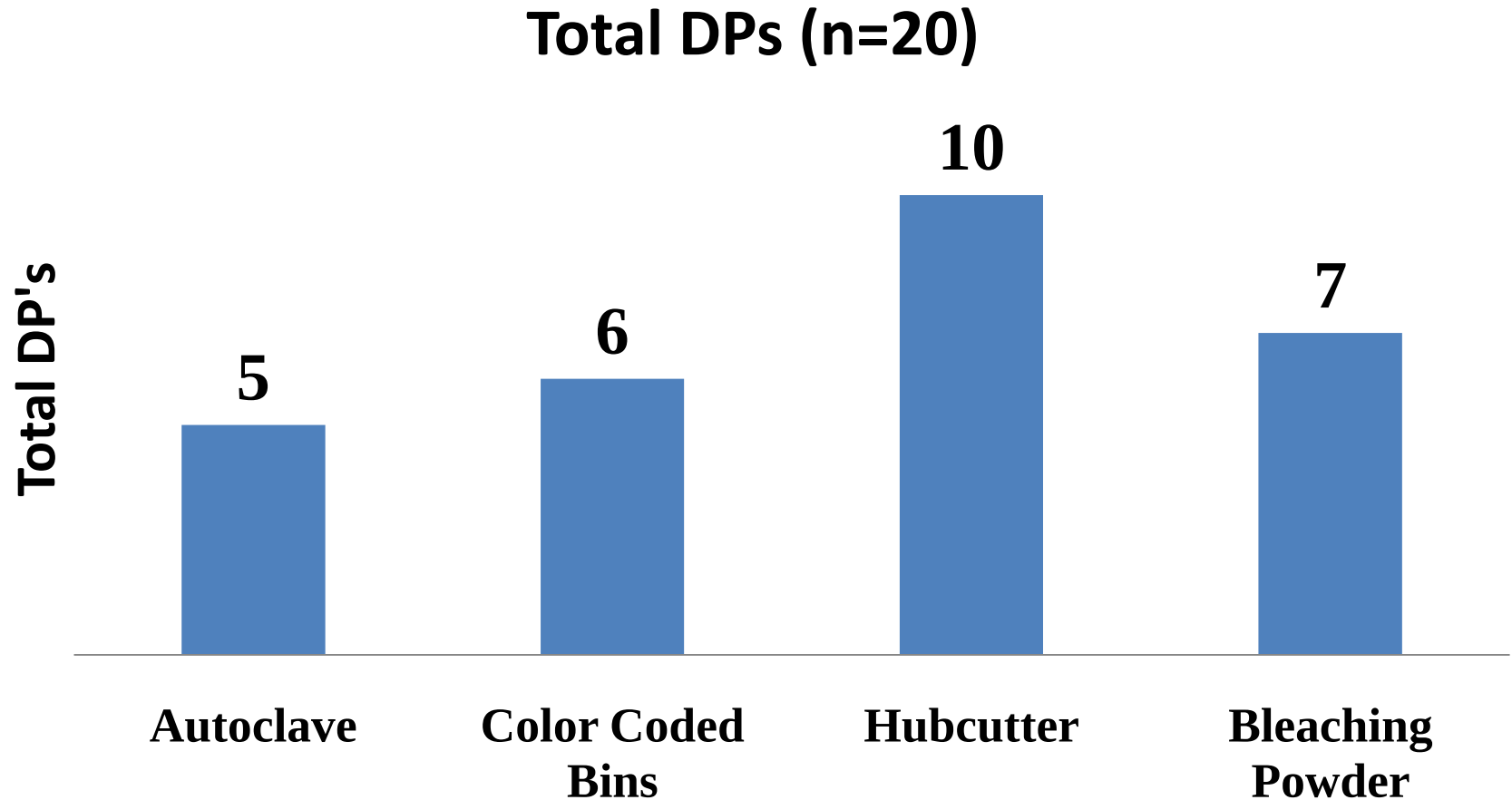


Training Status of SN
