1.4.1. ASTER CARDIAC SCIENCES:

As one of the flagship institutes of the group, the Aster cardiac sciences will bring together an exceptional team of Cardiologists and Cardiac surgeons to work collaboratively in order to provide comprehensive cardiac care. Equipped with cutting-edge technology to diagnose and treat cardiovascular diseases, the institute will encompass cardiac catheterization laboratories with lowest radiation, Biplane systems, Hybrid Cath lab, Echo Gating, Intravascular and Intracardiac ultrasound ,fractional flow reserve measurements and 3D mapping systems, high end cardiac imaging including Single Photon Emission Computed Tomography (SPECT)and Positron Emission Tomography (PET CT)

The Cardiac sub specialties includes: Interventional Cardiology, Cardiac Electrophysiology, Advanced Cardiac Imaging, Heart Failure/ Heart Transplantation ,Paediatric Cardiology ,Cardiac surgery Procedures like Coronary Artery Bypass Graft- CABG (off and on pump),Valve replacement and repair ,and newer procedures like Percutaneous Valve Replacement ,Renal Denervation Therapy and Robotic Cardiac Surgery. Paediatric Cardiac surgery is also available for patients with Congenital heart diseases such as Transposition of the great Artery, Ventricular septal defect, Atrial septal defect, and valve repairs.

1.4.2. ASTER ORTHOPAEDICS:

Aster Orthopaedics is somehow different because of its various sub specializations led by experts. The nine subspecialties which it includes-

- Joint Replacement (Hip, Knee, Ankle, Shoulder and Elbow)
- Spine Surgery
- Sports Medicine
- Hand Surgery
- Paediatric Orthopaedics and Tumour Surgery

The CoE includes: Diagnostic, surgical and rehabilitative services for bone, joint and connective tissue disorders, bone banking facilities and integrated operation suites, further aided by dedicated digital X-ray units in Orthopaedic OPD itself. It is supported by 256-slice iCT, 3 Tesla MRI, PET scan and SPECT scan. They are supported by a state-of-the-art physiotherapy division manned by internationally qualified Physiatrists and Physiotherapist. The presence of Rheumatology consultants will complete the scope of services provided.

1.4.3. ASTER NEUROSCIENCES:

Equipped with Internationally acclaimed physicians and surgeons, the Aster Institute for Neurology and Neurosurgery shall facilitate the treatment of disorders of the brain and the nervous system. The institute will offer a full range of diagnostic and therapeutic modalities of Neurology and Neurosurgery. The institute will have additional dedicated programs for Neuropsychology, Neuro-rehabilitation and Interventional Neuro-radiology.

The CoE includes:- Expert teams for Dementia, Epilepsy, multiple Sclerosis and Stroke, cutting-edge treatments for movement and Behavioural disorders including deep brain stimulation, advanced Neurologic and Neurosurgical techniques for brain tumours and Neurovascular problems.

1.4.4. ASTER ONCOLOGY:

Aster oncology provides full range of preventive, curative and palliative care with a multidisciplinary team of medical, surgical and radiation Oncologists. Aster Oncology will collaborate closely with the Centre of Excellence in cancer treatment, using evidence-based pathways for providing exceptional care.

The CoE includes:-Advanced True Beam HD Liner Accelerator the **first one in Kerala**. It has cyberknife precision with high treatment dose and unflattened beam. Aster Oncology also has a Positron Emission Tomography-Computed Tomography (PET CT) for molecular imaging, Digital Mammography for complete breast screening and equipments for quaternary treatments such as Bone Marrow/Stem Cell transplantation, Stereotactic Radio surgery and Radiotherapy (SRS/SRT).The COE will include a dedicated centre for Chemotherapy, and an integrated Brachytherapy unit. Aster Oncology has a multimodal approach to cancer treatment that will be assisted by joint teams and tumor boards looking at optional solutions.

1.4.5. ASTER GASTROENTEROLOGY AND HEPATOLOGY:

The Aster Institute for Gastroenterology and Hepatology will have a team of Gastroenterologists, Hepatologists and Gastrointestinal surgeons, who focus on providing comprehensive, high quality multidisciplinary care of digestive, pancreatic and liver disease.

 - a. No paper work in ICUs (Clinical charts in digital and automatic, may be integrated to HIS and **ICCA** for medications, to medical equipments such as ventilators patient monitors, syringe, infusion pumps)
 - b. Ceiling mounted Pendants to carry equipments, electricity, Medical Gases to provide ease of care.

 - b. Truly Modular OT (Factory fabricated Wall panels with surgeon control panels, storage box, Automatic sliding doors etc.)
 - c. Auto pilot facility Anaesthesia Machine.
 - d. Isocentric C Arm
6. Automatic Drug Dispensing Pharmacy (Robotic)
 7. Pneumatic chute (to avoid time lapse in medicine, sample dispensing)
 8. Oncology Department with True beam LINAC and HDR Brachytherapy.
 9. Nuclear Medicine department with PET CT, Gamma Camera
 10. Digital Telemetry (Patient vitals transferring through Wi-Fi access points) makes loss of patient vitals ideally zero. (Patient vitals will be always monitored at his/her base nursing station when the patient (*carrying a vitals monitoring transponder) is moving around the hospital premises)

1.6.1. Housekeeping: -

Work flow:-

The housekeeping department using colour coding mops in order to avoid intermixing of infections.

Colour coding of mops:

- Yellow: High risk area
- White: OT
- Blue : General area
- Red: Bathroom
- Green : Patient room or wards

1.6.2. MRD (Medical Record Department):-

- Provision to generate age wise, nationality wise, gender wise disease statistics report.

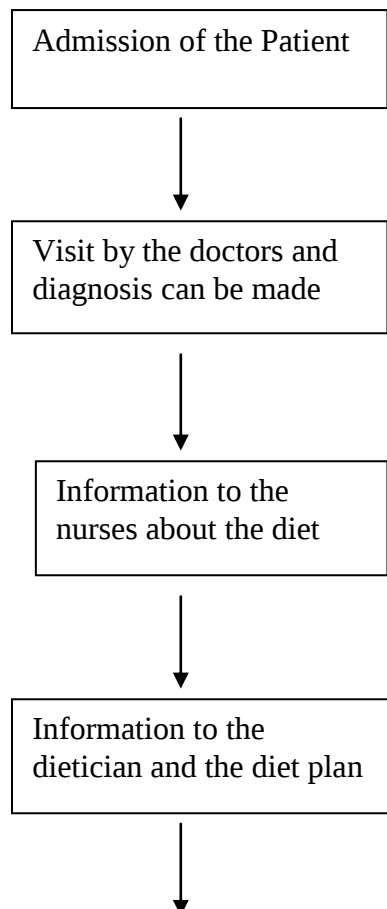
1.6.3. CSSD:-

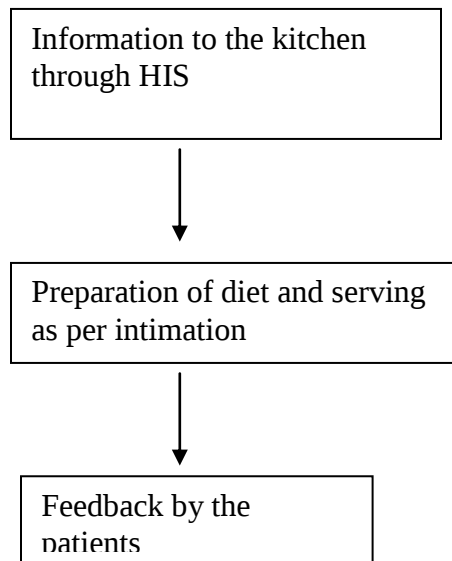
Sterile supplies continue to be a major support area in the hospital. Central Sterile Supply Department (CSSD) is located in the lower ground floor. Major responsibilities of CSSD include cleaning, processing and sterilization of surgical instruments, treatment trays and sets, dressings, rubber goods (catheter, tubing) etc. It is also responsible for economic and effective utilization of equipment resources of the hospital under controlled supervision.

1.6.4. CATH LAB:-

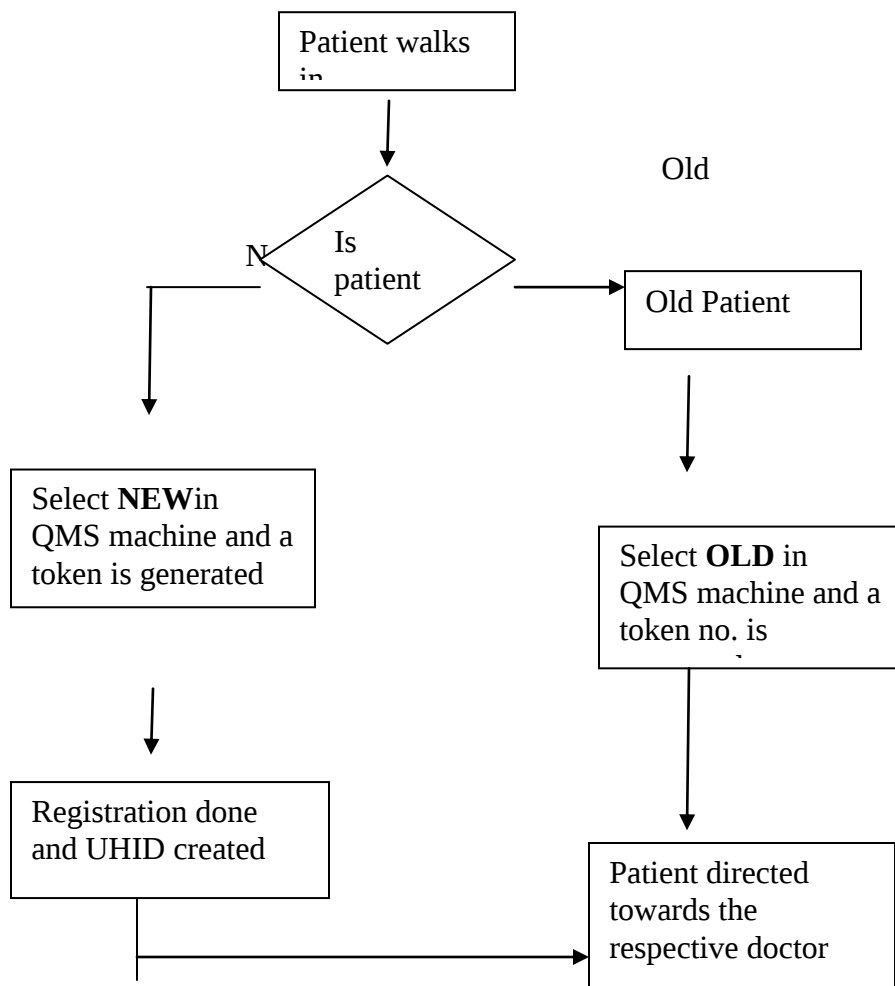
In Aster Medcity, 3 Cath labs are there, out of three one is Hybrid cath lab. Since it is in commissioning stage we were facing many problems with equipment installation. The ideal humidity for cath lab equipments to be 55-60. But it was not coming down to that level. It fluctuated between 75-80. The main reason behind it was design of AHU. Now everything is in place.
