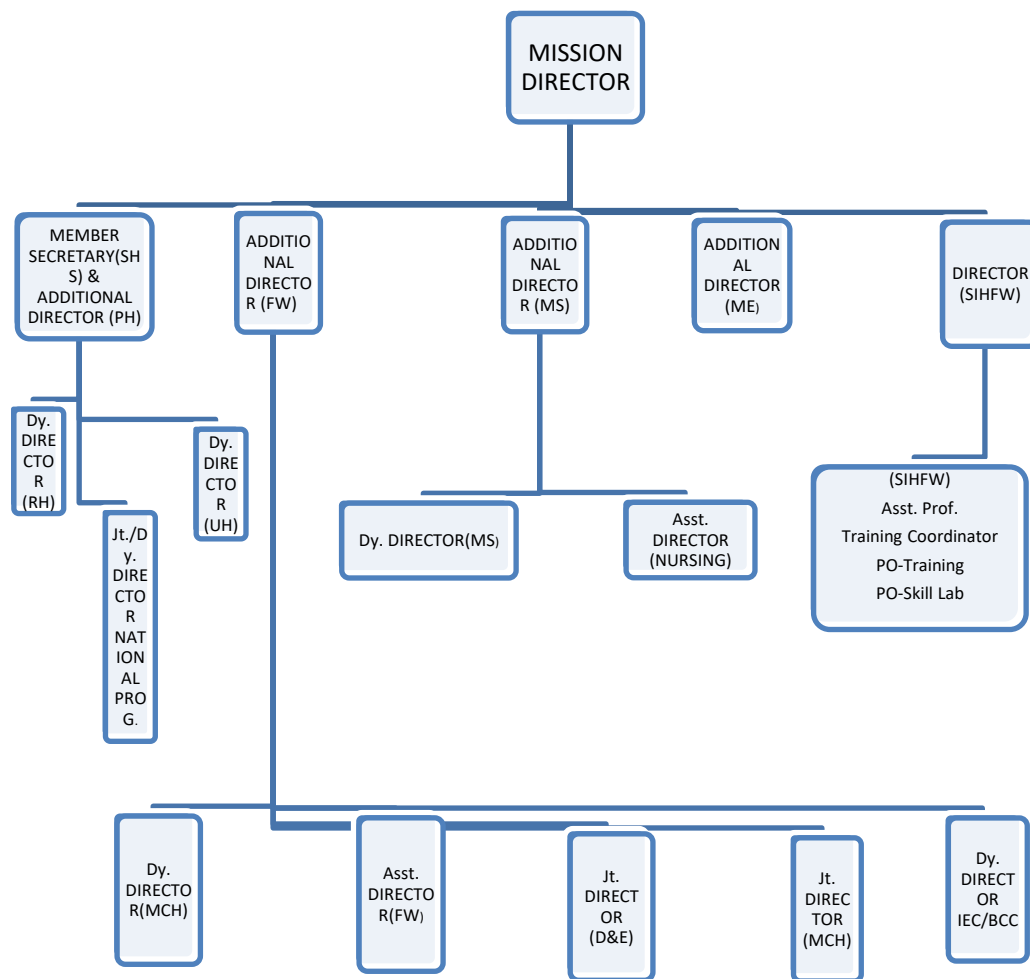


Fig 1. Organogram
