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About IHAT:

Established in 2003 by **University of Manitoba (UM)**, as part of a five-year (2001 to 2006) bilateral development project between Canada and India and registered with the **Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA)** under the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act, 1976 in 2009, aims at improving public health initiatives by supporting programs nationally and globally through providing comprehensive technical assistance in program planning, management and monitoring.

India Health Action Trust (IHAT) has been providing comprehensive technical assistance and training in programme planning and management to the **State AIDS Control Societies of Karnataka, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Bihar, Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Goa.**

IHAT has set up a **Technical Support Unit (TSU)** for the **Government of Uttar Pradesh** in 2013, to provide integrated and embedded techno-managerial support to strengthen existing health system for achieving sustained health outcomes at scale. **IHAT** focuses on improving the coverage of key RMNCHA+, Nutrition, Family Planning, Pneumonia and Diarrhoea interventions and services in the state from the funding support of **Bill & Melinda Gate Foundation (BMGF), Central and State government.**
