DEPARTMENT WORKED

MEDICAL GAS DEPARTMENT PARAS HOSPITAL, GURGAON

Supplies the highly sophisticated life support network, which supplies medical air and oxygen for patient breathing, nitrous oxide for anaesthesia, medical air for driving orthopaedic tools and vacuum for suction

Manifold room-contain gas cylinders and compressors, vacuum pump (suction)

Liquid Oxygen tank is located outside the hospital.

Medical gas department in Paras hospital comprises of:

1. Bulk liquid systems, cylinder manifolds, medical air compressor, medical surgical vacuum producers, and equipment.
2. Pipeline distribution systems comprising of alarms, zonal control boxes, line pressure gauges, risers.
3. Point use delivery connections, panel support boxes, outlet points, pendants
4. Monitoring and control equipment for ensuring safety

Location- 2nd Basement

- Near maintenance area
- Separate enclosure for full cylinders, empty cylinders, compressed air, vacuum supply
- No fire hazard
- Liquid oxygen area is cordoned off
- Sufficient space – Vehicles can come into that area.
- Electrical devices located at or above 5ft.
- Oxygen & Nitrous Oxide stored separately from Flammable gases & Liquids.
- The area is free of combustible materials such as paper, plastic material, and cardboard.
- When quantity of gas stored exceeds 2,000 cubic feet, the storage area should ideally be outside the building therefore liquid oxygen tank is placed outside the hospital building

OBSERVATIONS

- Cylinders are outsourced by company named Asynergy and hospital manifold room is managed by their company person(technician)
- One technician in day shift (8 am to 8 pm), One technician in night shift (8pm to 8am)
- Reading is taken by them 4 times a day (8am, 2pm, 8pm, and 2am)

Daily consumption is noted down in register

- One technician in day shift (8 am to 8 pm), One technician in night shift (8pm to 8am)
- Reading is taken by them 4 times a day (8am, 2pm, 8pm, and 2am)
And consumption is noted down in register.
- This way records are maintained in the department and monthly consumption report is send to the HOD by the company person/technician in excel file.
- Cylinders are sent to the departments as per their requirement
- Refill of the cylinder is done as soon as the cylinder is empty.
- Company person/technician (PMP) calls the company and gets the cylinder refilled by them.
- Daily rounds are taken by manifold room in charge to see that the gases are transferred smoothly to the patient or to check and note down the complaint if there is any problem and rectify it.
- There are two banks BANK 1 and BANK 2 of oxygen in the manifold room which is used in emergency

Quality indicators of medical gas department

- Number of complaints of malfunctioning, from the users
- Correctness of pressure level in the oxygen, nitrous oxide and compressed air pipeline
- Correctness of negative pressure in the vacuum line
- Bacteriological culture of the gases and the air delivered
- Leakage at the outlet points
- Functioning of audio-visual alarm system

Role of health care teams in medical gas department

- Biomedical technicians are the primary caretakers of medical gas pipelines within a health care facility.
- They are usually responsible for accepting medical gas deliveries and validating the contents of the delivery as well as its date and source.
- They should conduct scheduled shutdowns; establish protocol; maintain written policies and procedures; and remain informed of new standardized recommendations within the medical gas supply industry.
- They must also ensure that persons working under them have the proper training to identify medical gas cylinders, connection valves, regulators, and the distribution system within a facility.
