- 4.The project does not include any schemes or activities that provide crop protection.

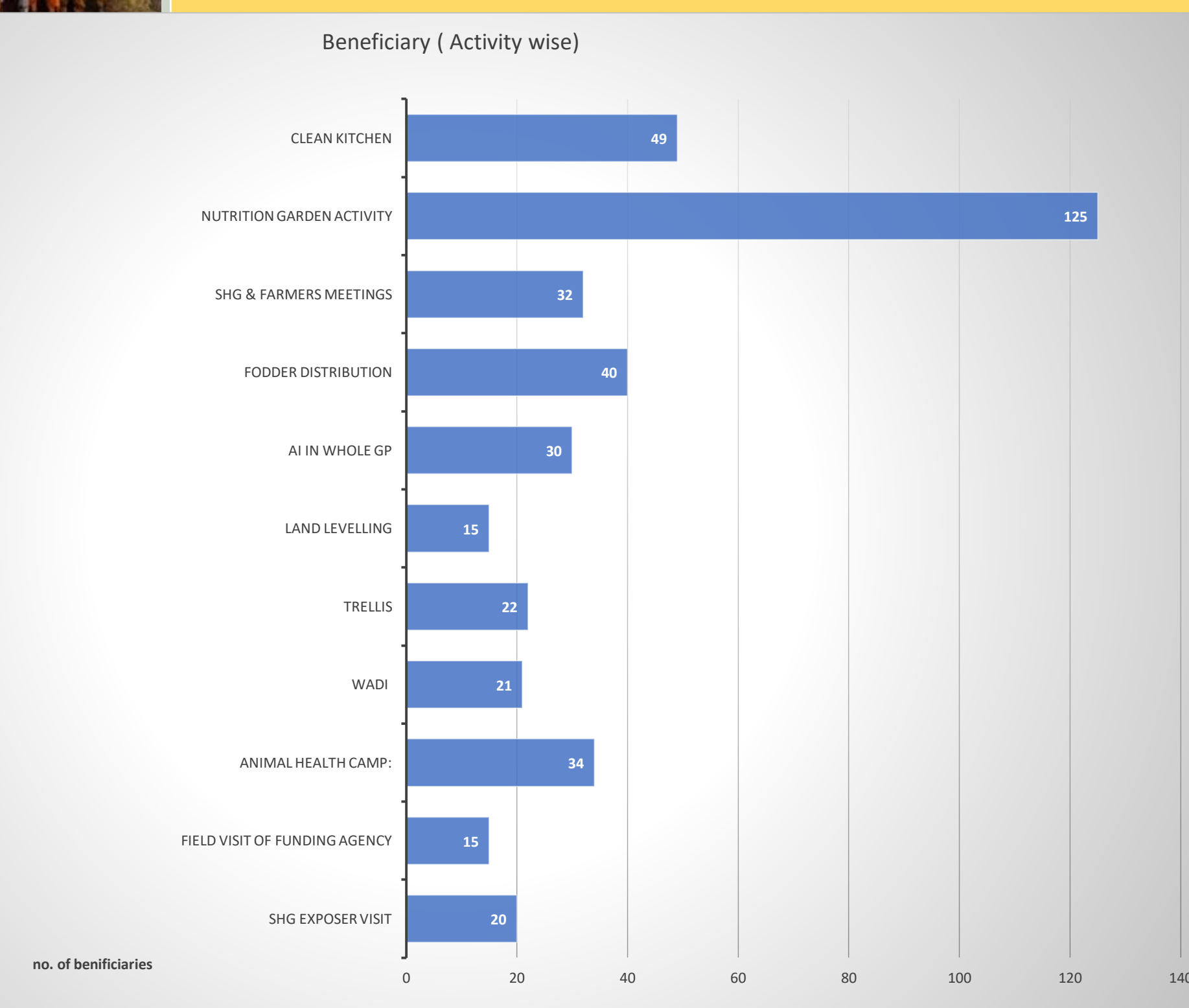

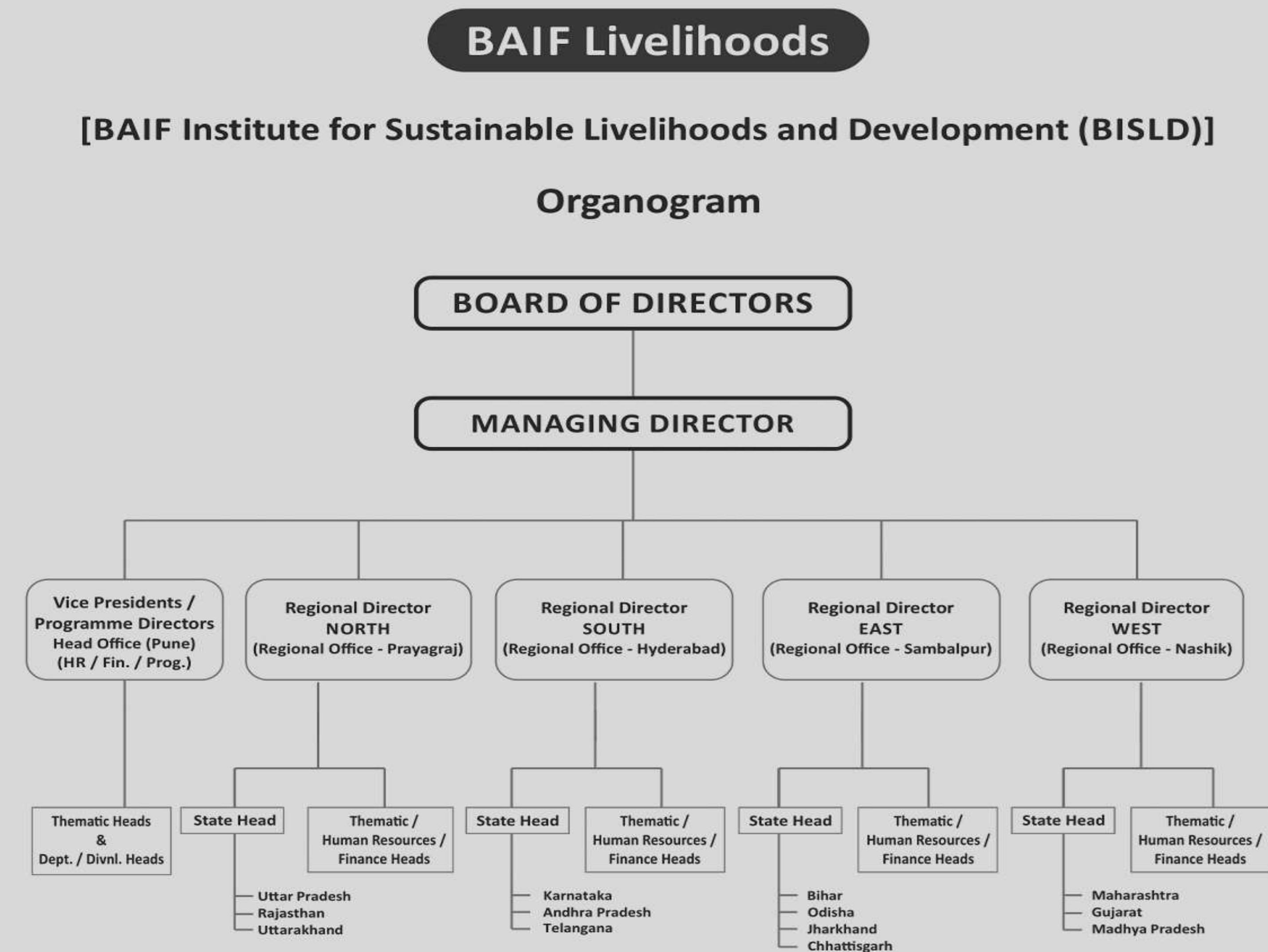
