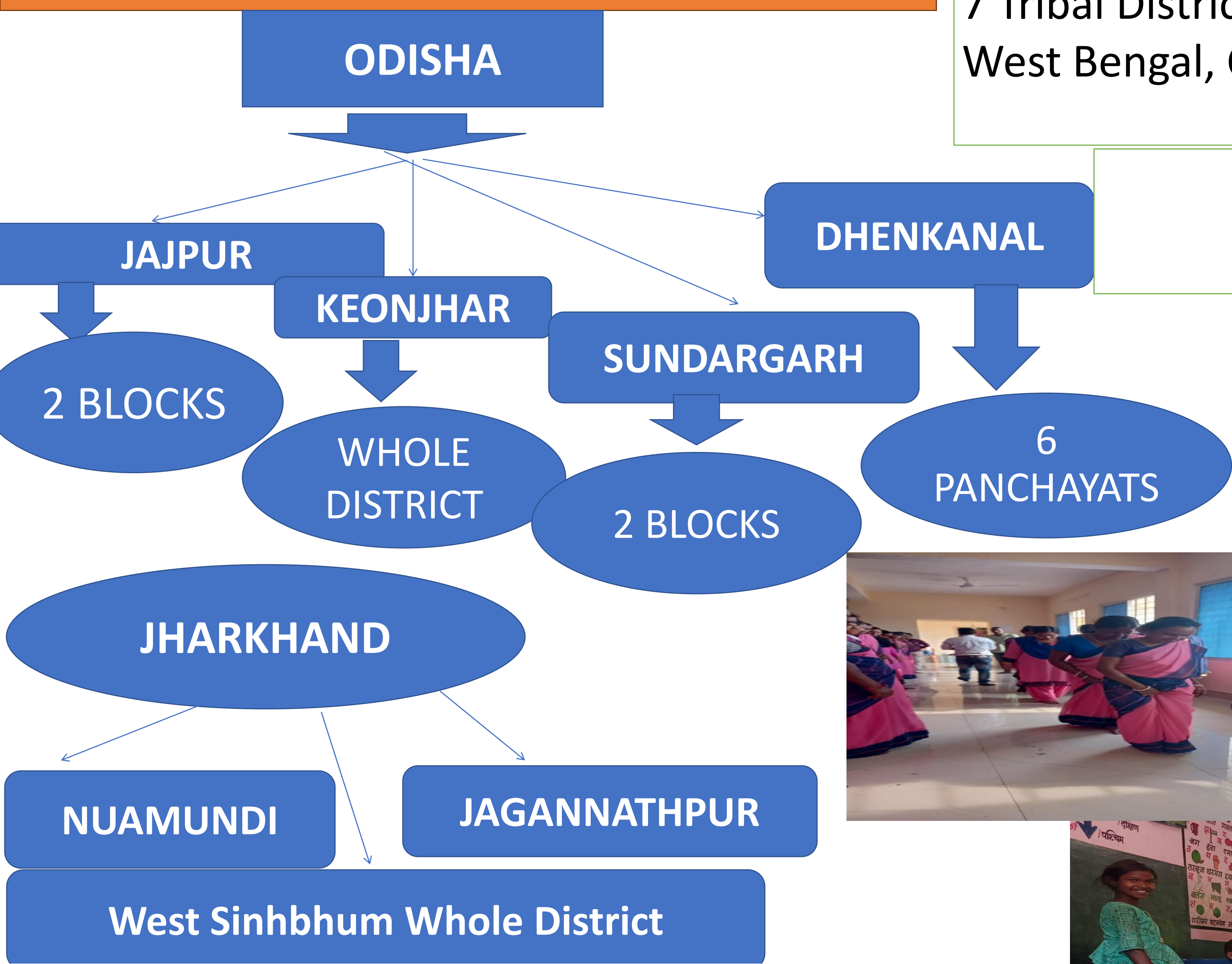




Introduction

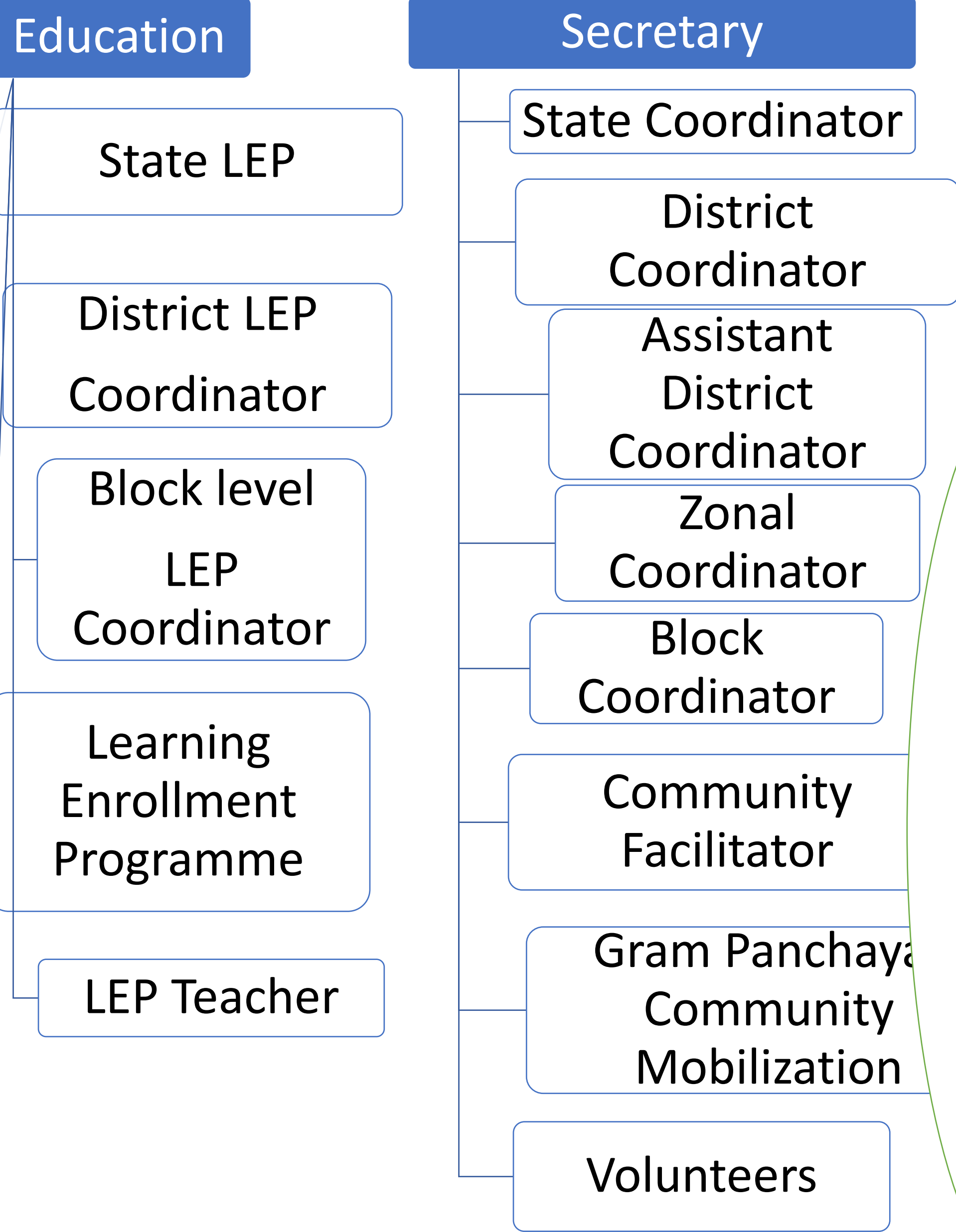

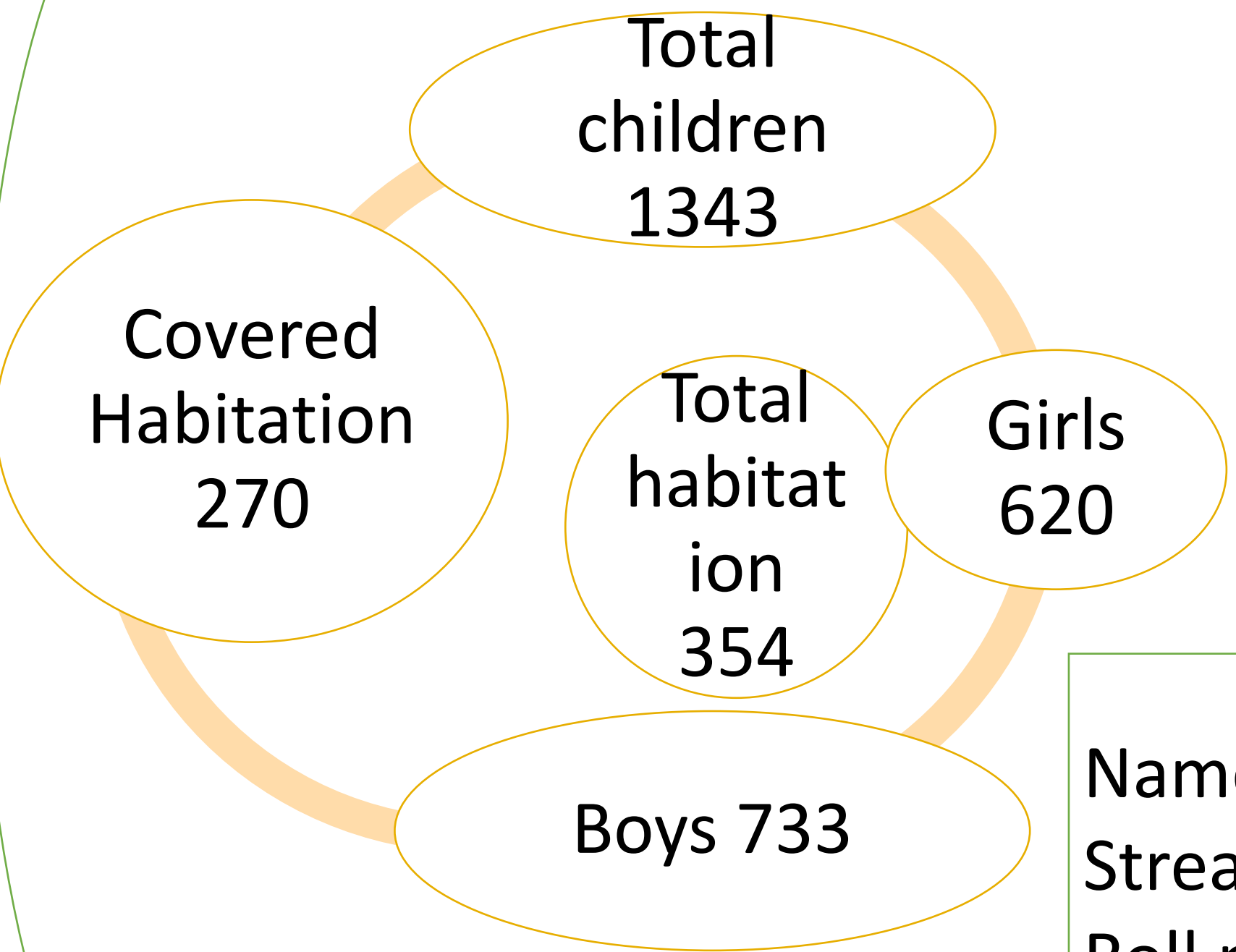
