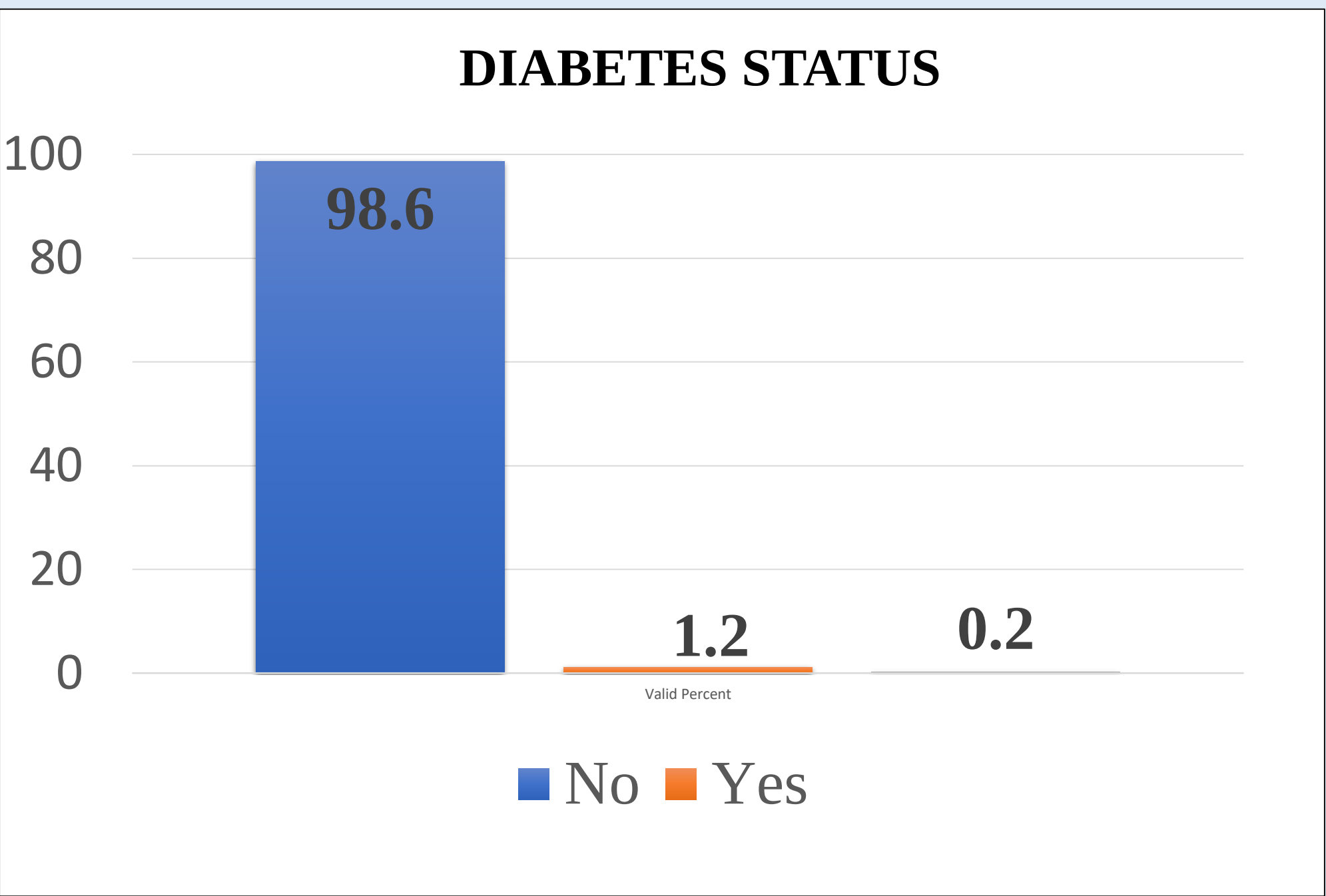

Design: India's 5th National family health survey includes a population-based cross-sectional study of men and women. With a 97% overall response rate, the sample is a multistage cluster sample.

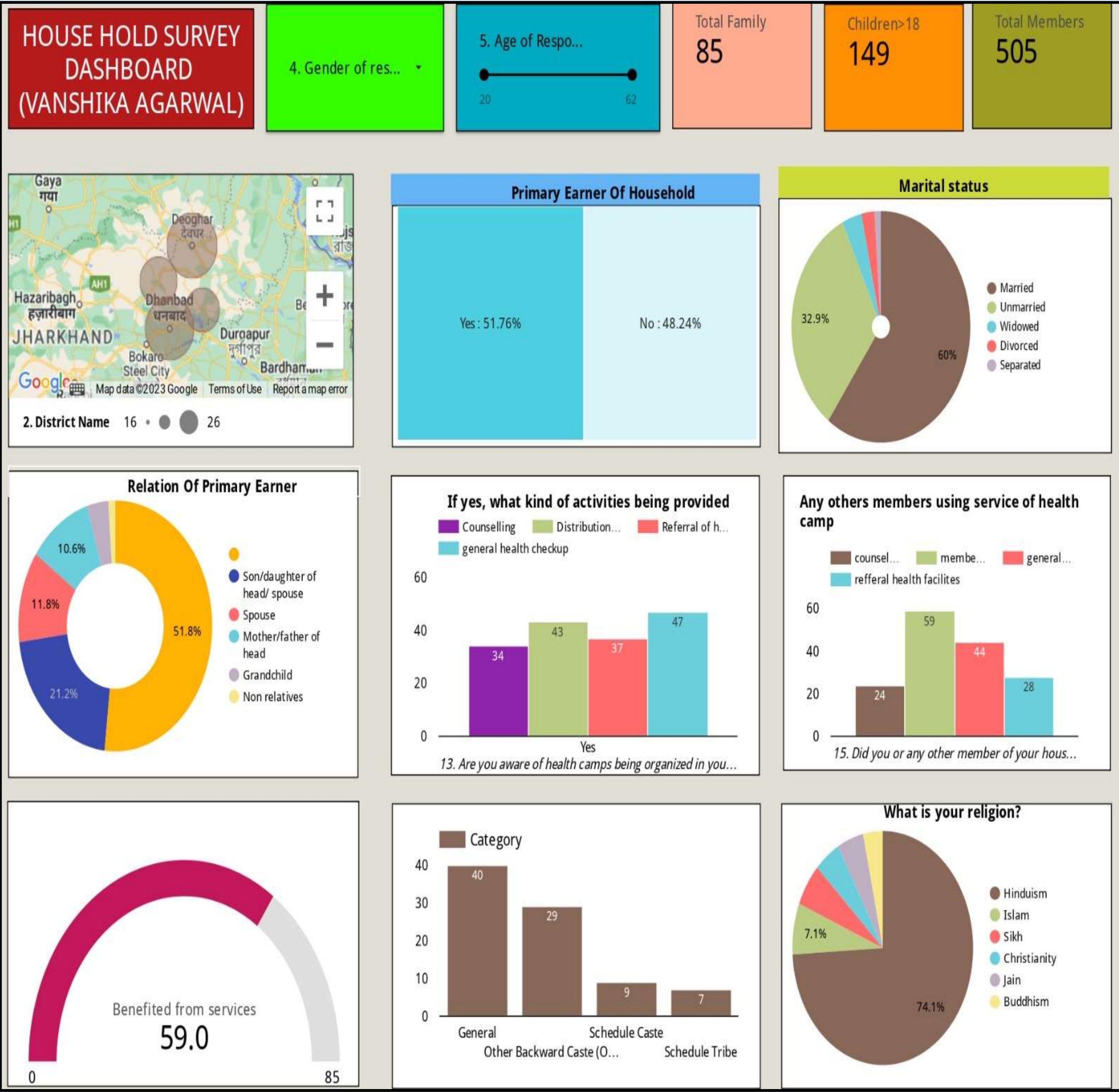
