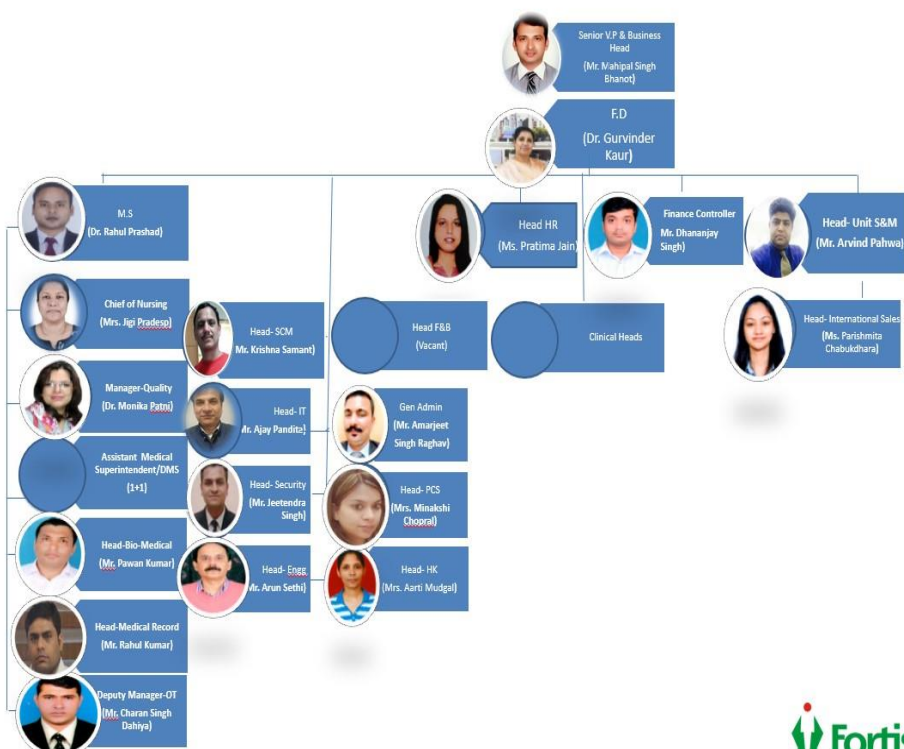


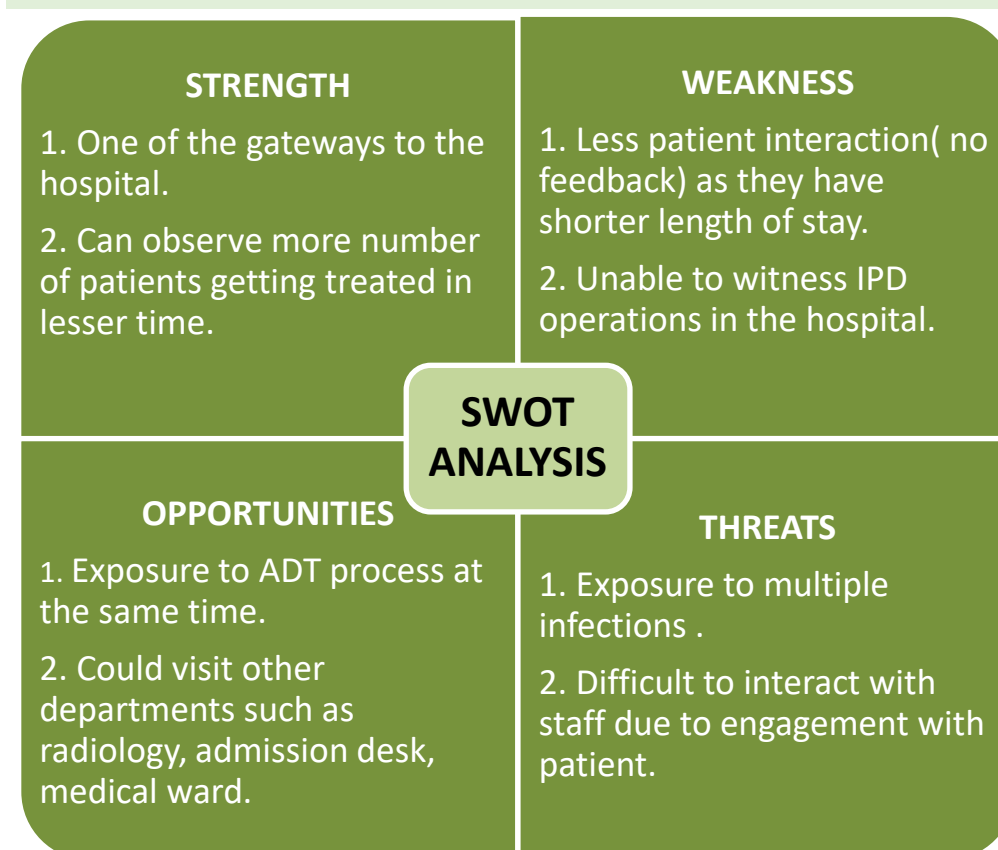

## LEARNINGS FROM INTERNSHIP

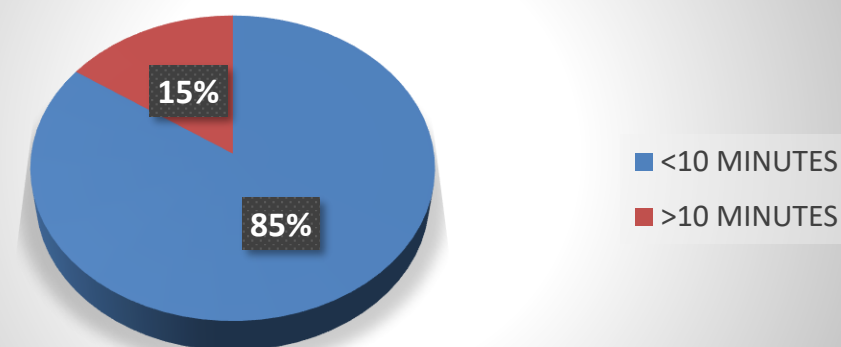
1. *In depth understanding of the workings of a hospital can be understood through practical exposure and having a hands-on experience.*

## CHALLENGES DURING INTERNSHIP

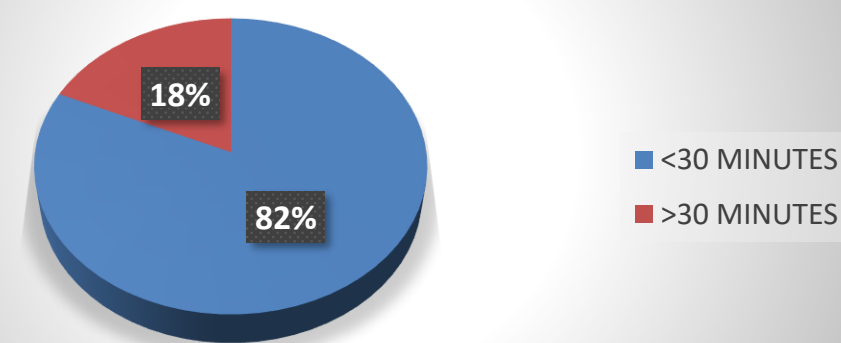
- *Due to lack of practical exposure, time taken is high.*

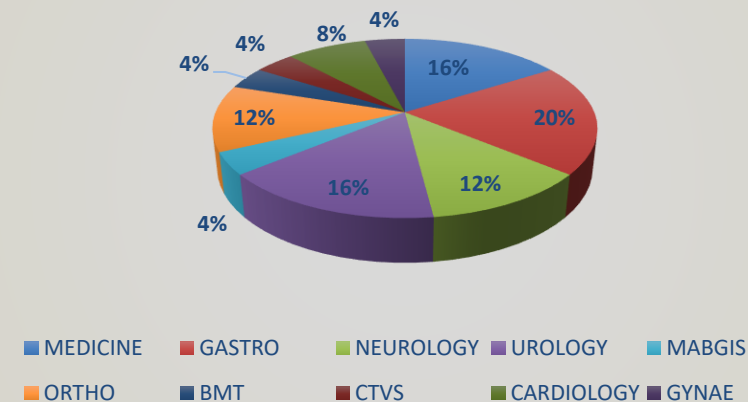
### TAT FOR INITITAL ASSESMENT BY THE DOCTOR



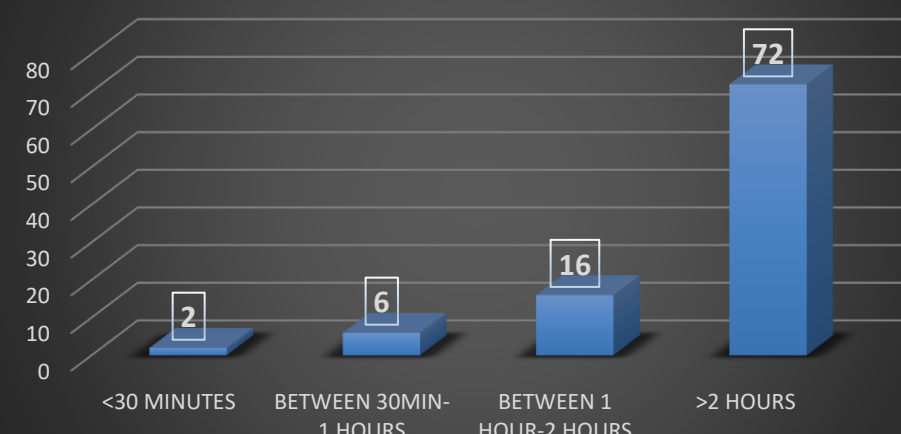
### TAT FOR CROSS REFERENCE



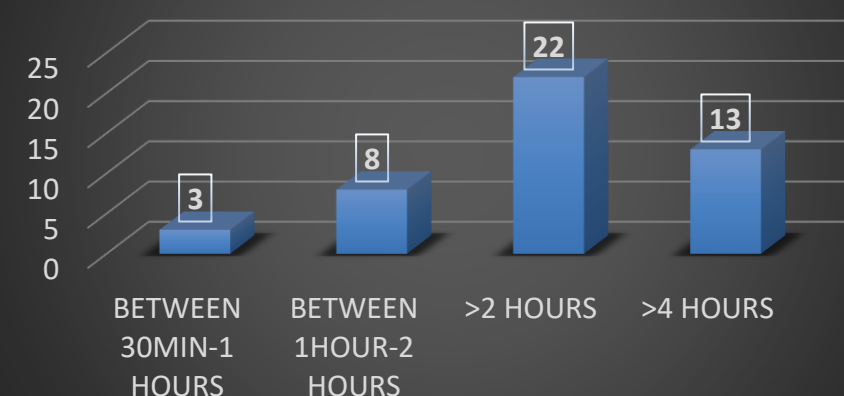
### SPECIALITY WISE CROSS REFERENCE DELAY
