

NATIONAL HEALTH MISSION

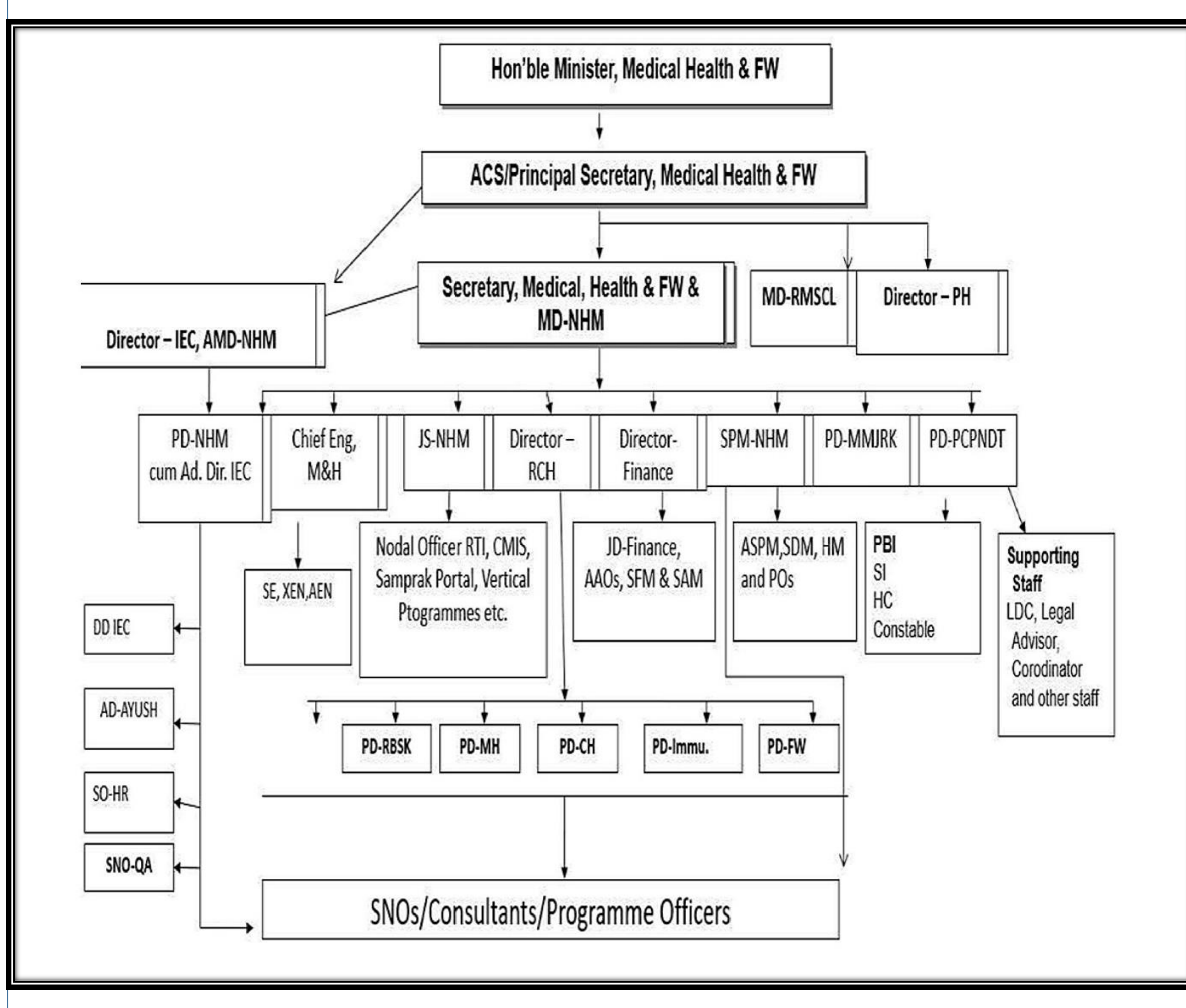
- The National Health Mission (NHM) was launched by the government of India in 2005 subsuming the **National Rural Health Mission** and **National Urban Health Mission**. .
- The NHM envisages achievement of universal access to equitable, affordable & quality health care services that are accountable and responsive to people's needs. Government of Rajasthan, Ministry of Panchayati Raj Vibhag under Nation Rural Health Mission, United Fund can in action in the budget announcement year 2011-12.
- In which 3% to District Council, 12% to Panchayat Committee and 85% to Gram Panchayat was announced.

VISSION

- Providing a certain measure of financial freedom and to encourage the local levels to plan some scheme in their discretion.

OBJECTIVES OF Untied Fund

- **Flexibility:** The primary objective of an untied fund is to provide flexibility in allocating resources.
- **Strategic Priorities:** Untied fund often aim to support strategic priorities of an organization or entity.
- **Innovation and Experimental:** Support the new ideas, pilot projects by offering the freedom to invest in untested or high-risk initiatives that have the potential for significant impact but may not fit within traditional funding models.
- **Capacity Building:** Strengthen the capacity organization or communities by providing resources of trainings, skills development, infrastructure improvement, or technical assistance.
- **Collaboration and Partnership:** By collaboration and Partnership among different stakeholders by encouraging joint efforts and pooling resources.

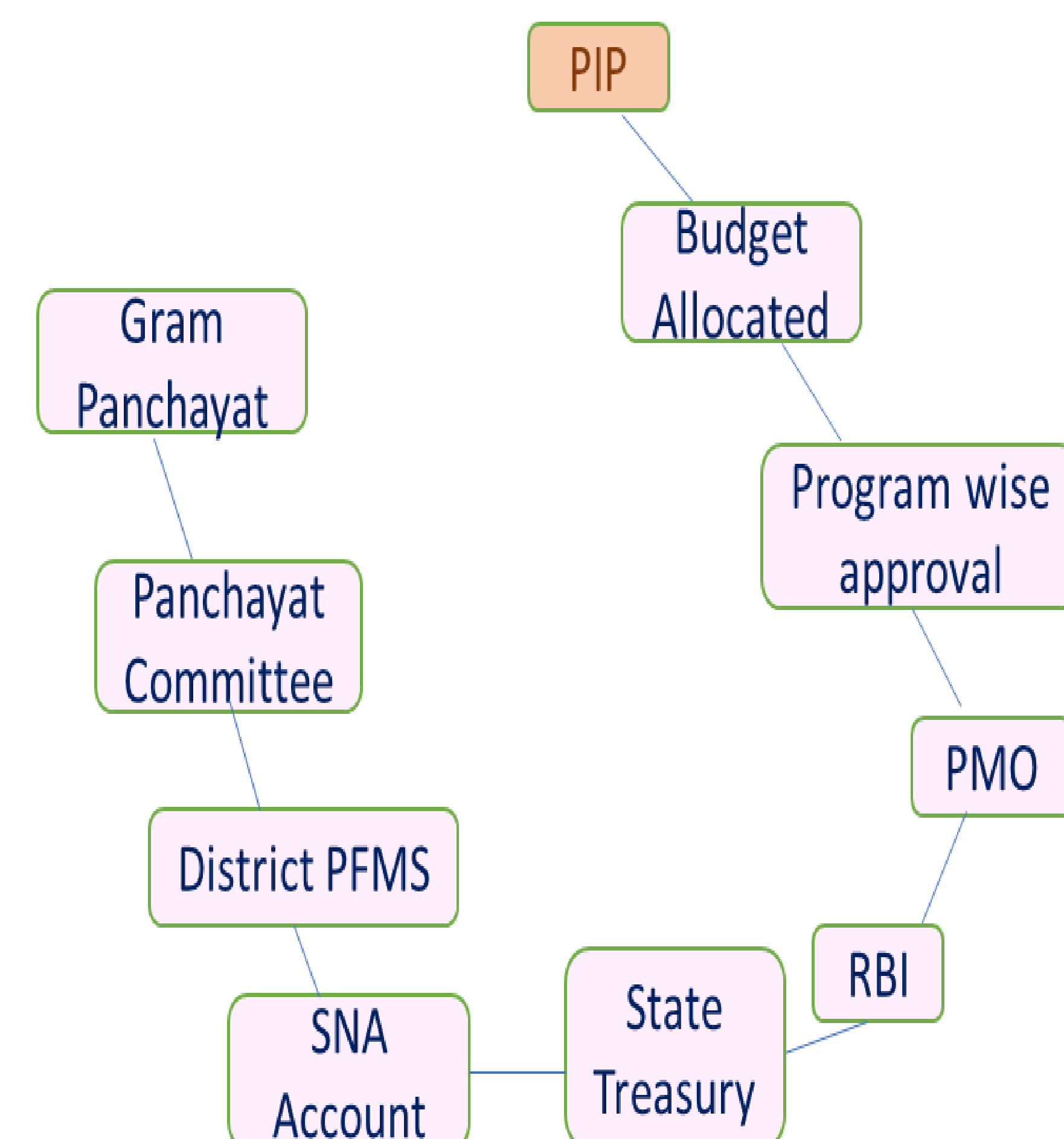

- Uncertainty making it challenging to plan and execute long-term healthcare program.

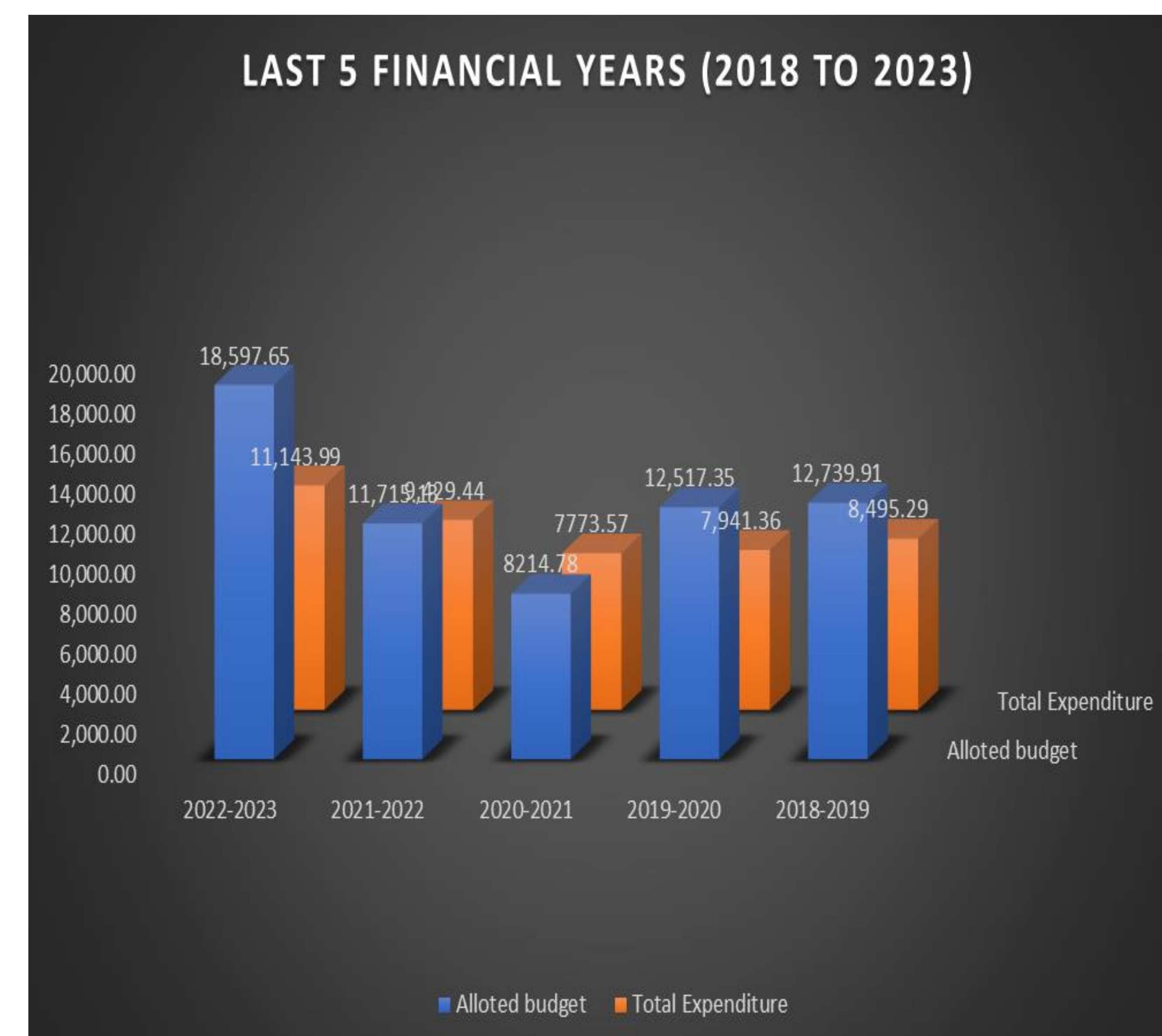
OPPORRTUNITY
