Vision

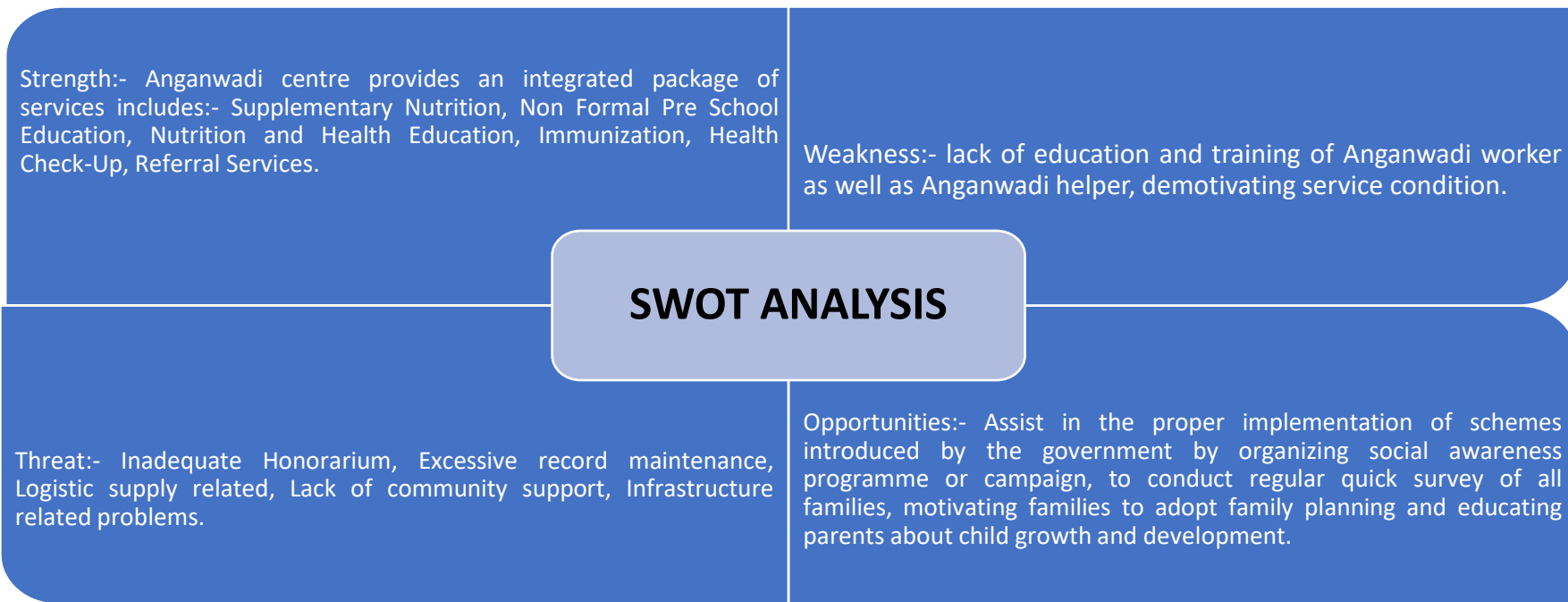
