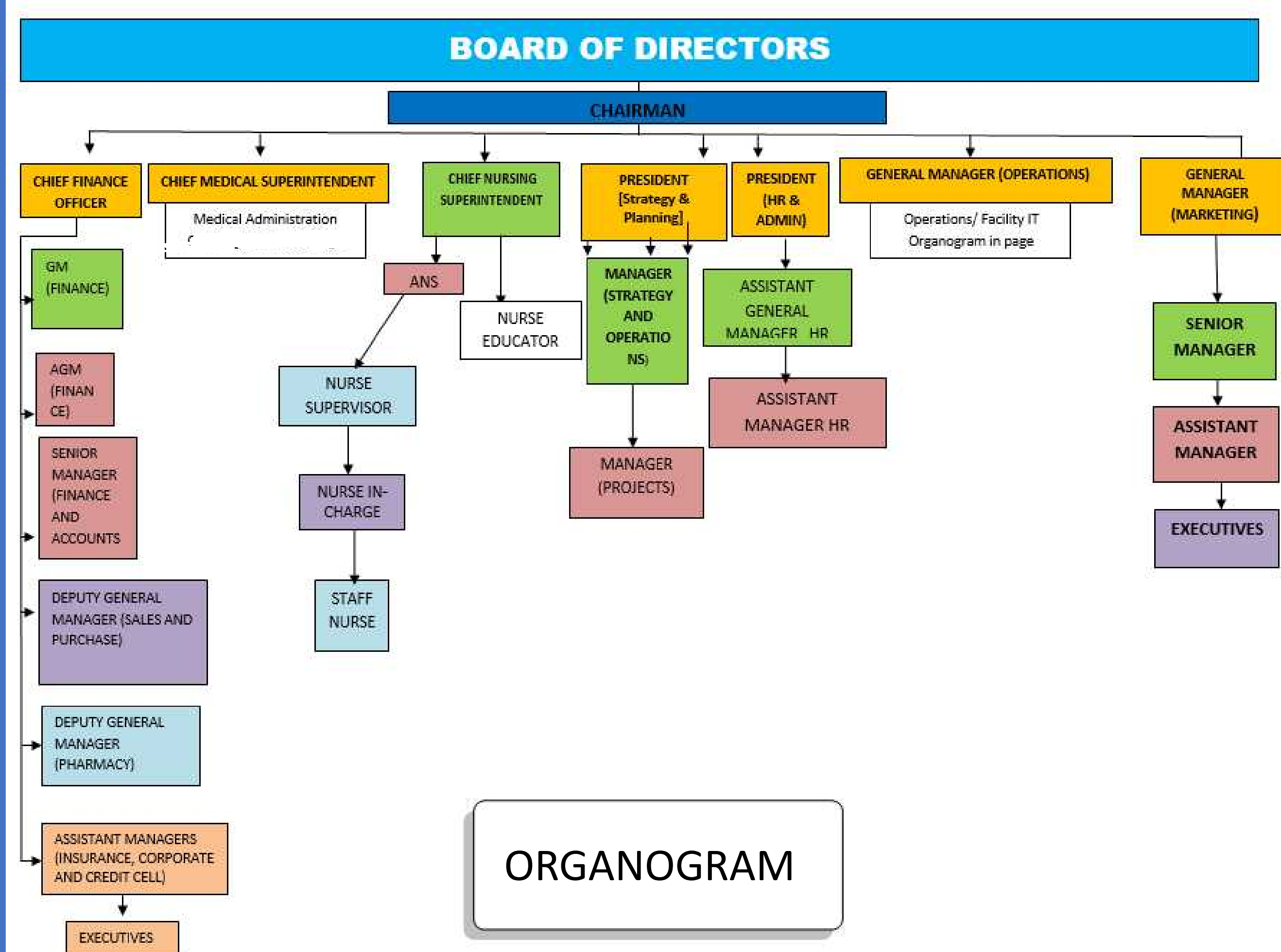

Vision and Mission:

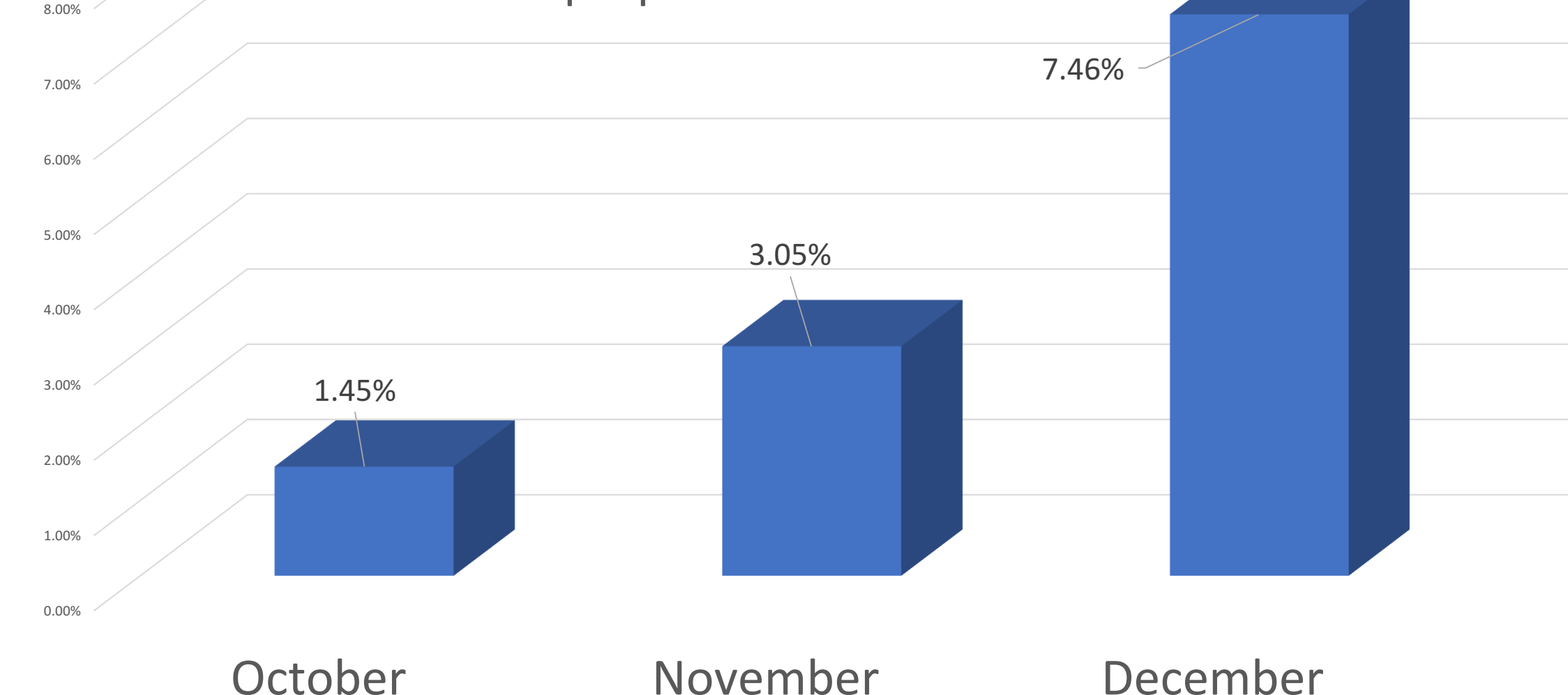
To provide affordable and quality healthcare and to become a centre of excellence by brining tertiary level healthcare to the people of Eastern India.

Introduction to project:

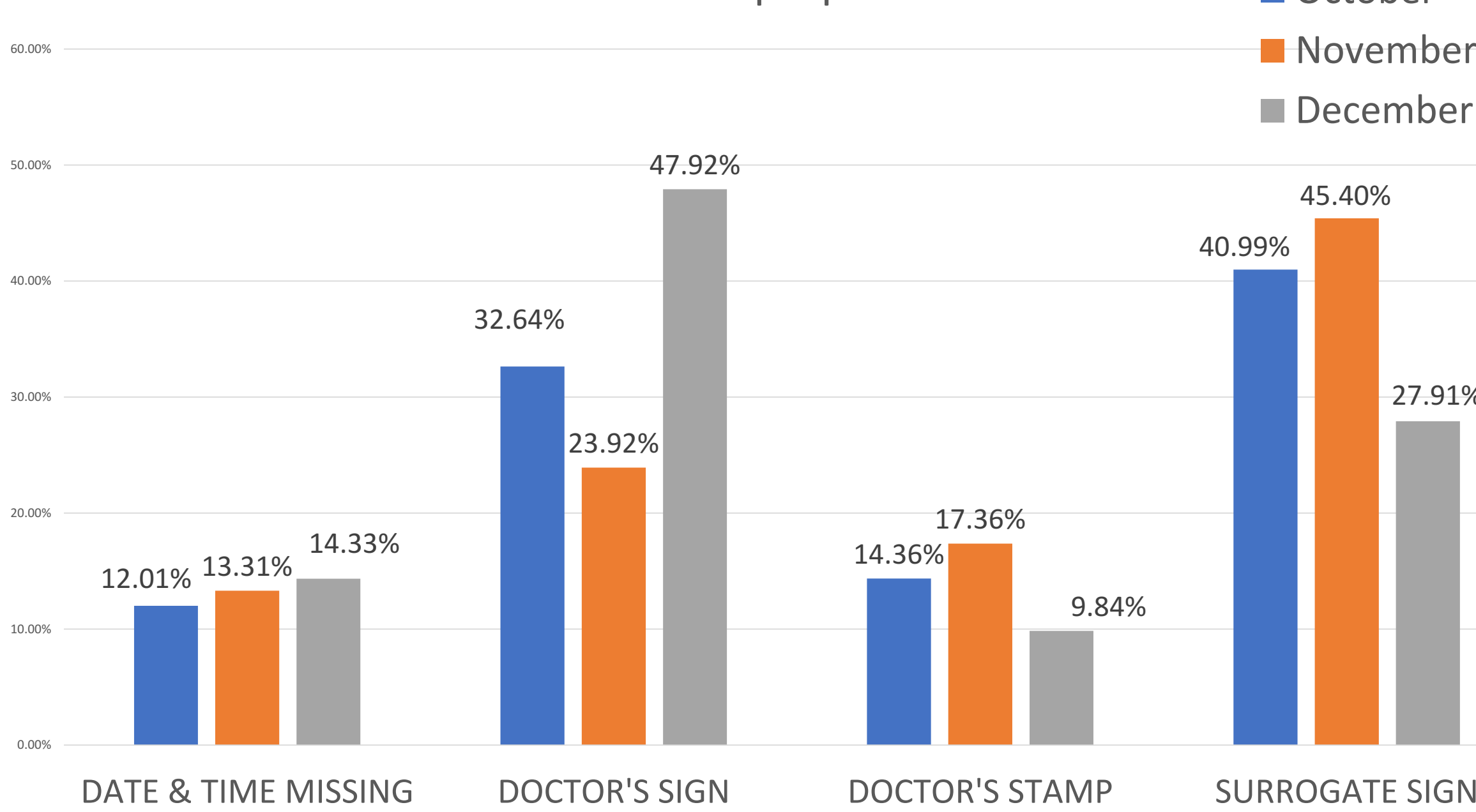
- Medical Records of a patient are all the detailed information sheets or orderly written documents that are maintained while the patients visit or stay in the hospital

Reasons for Improper Consent



Findings:

- Improper consents have been found in the study which comprises of surrogate sign and missing date and time among others
- Improper consent in October was as high as 3.93%
- Demographic and general information have been found to be recorded satisfactorily
- Nutritional assessment was found to be incomplete
- A significant spike in number of improper cases in December was due to the turnover of RMOs who were not oriented optimally

The internship helped me to gain valuable insights into the implementation of the NABH 5th edition standards and its interpretation for the development of the hospital.

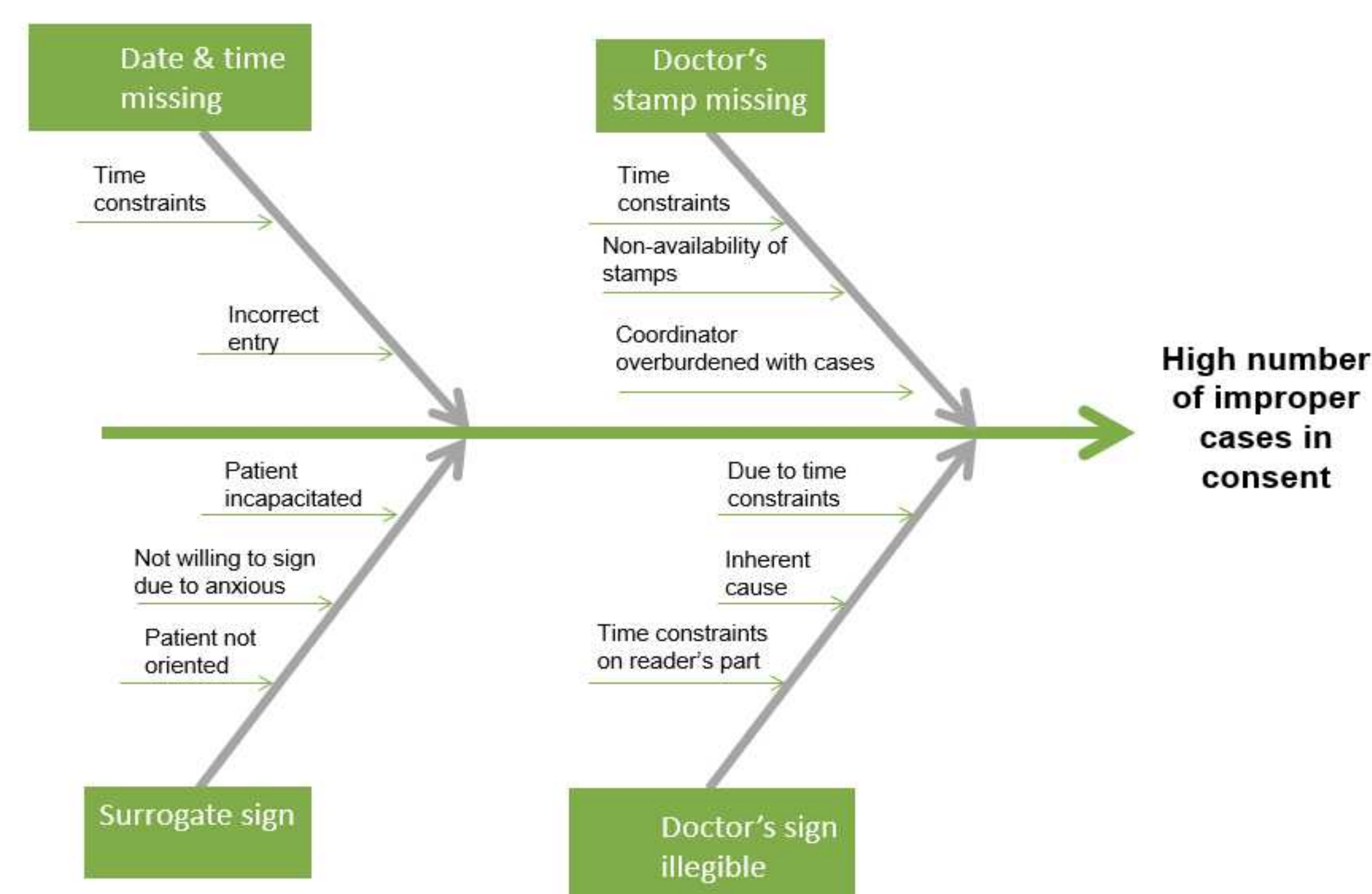
Theoretical insights and practical observations:

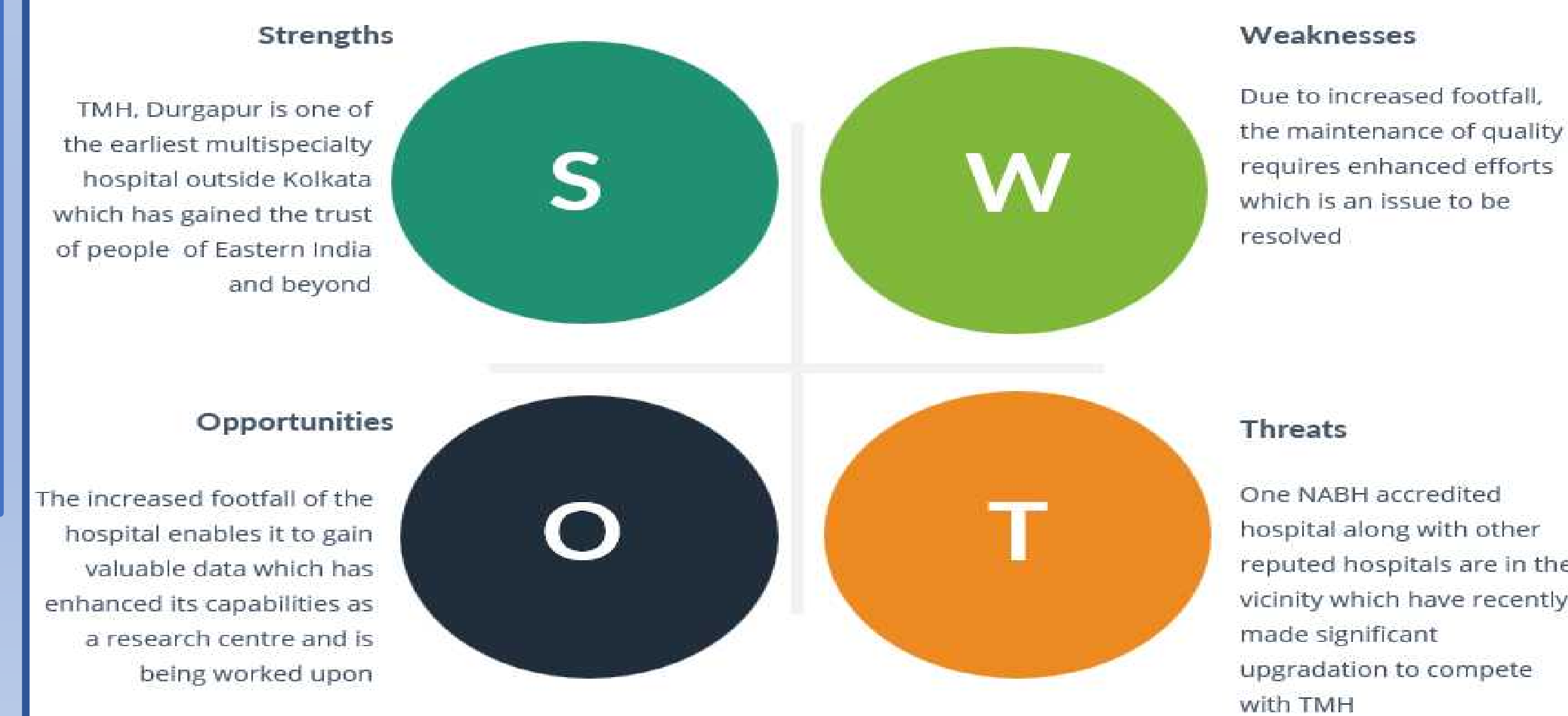
Fish Bone analysis for Improper Consent
