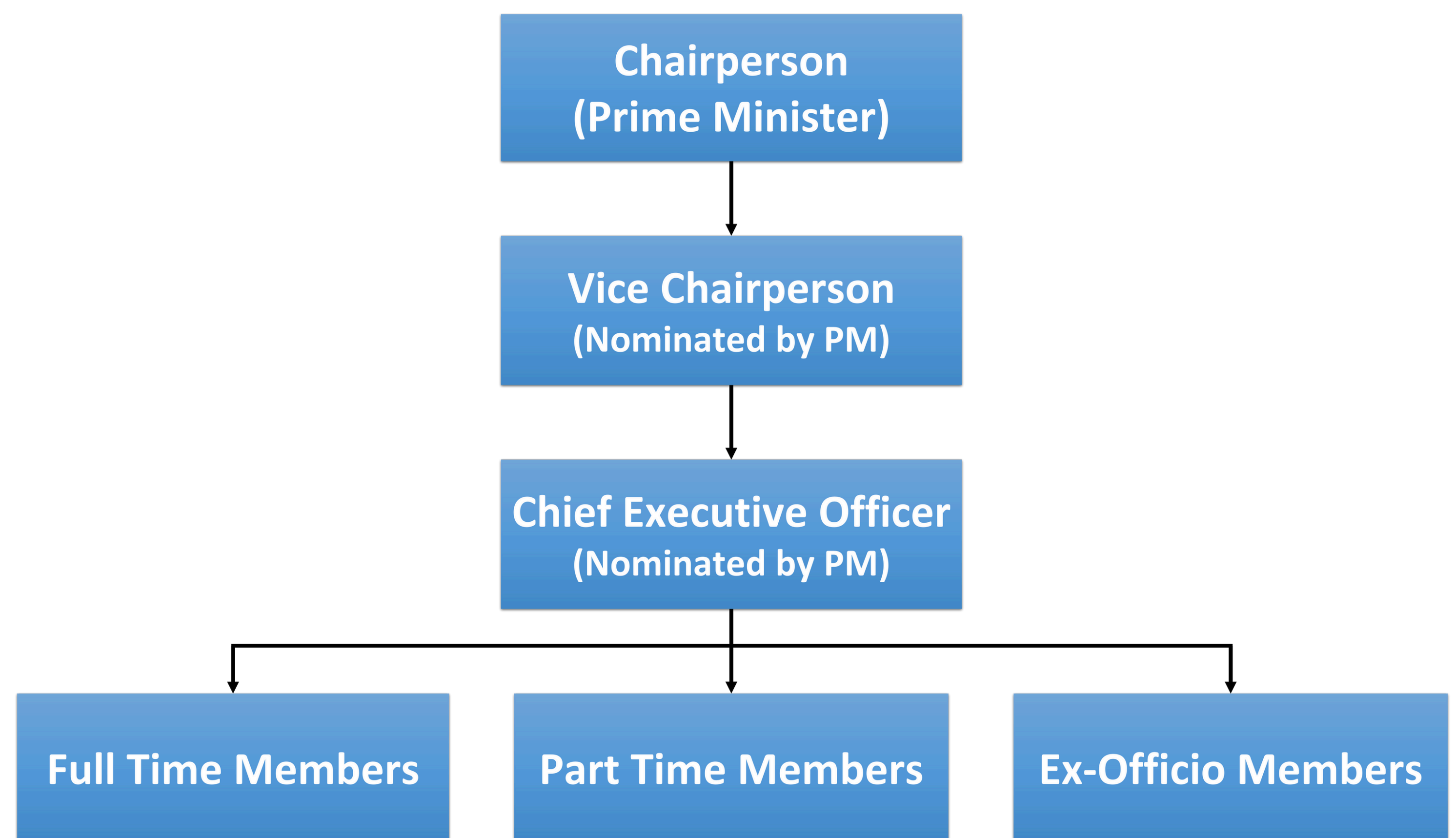




NITI Aayog also known as National Institution for Transforming India Aayog was formed on 1st January 2005. After the dissolution of the Planning Commission, it was replaced by the NITI Aayog, the country's premier policy-making think tank of the Government of India.
