ABOUT ORGANIZATION

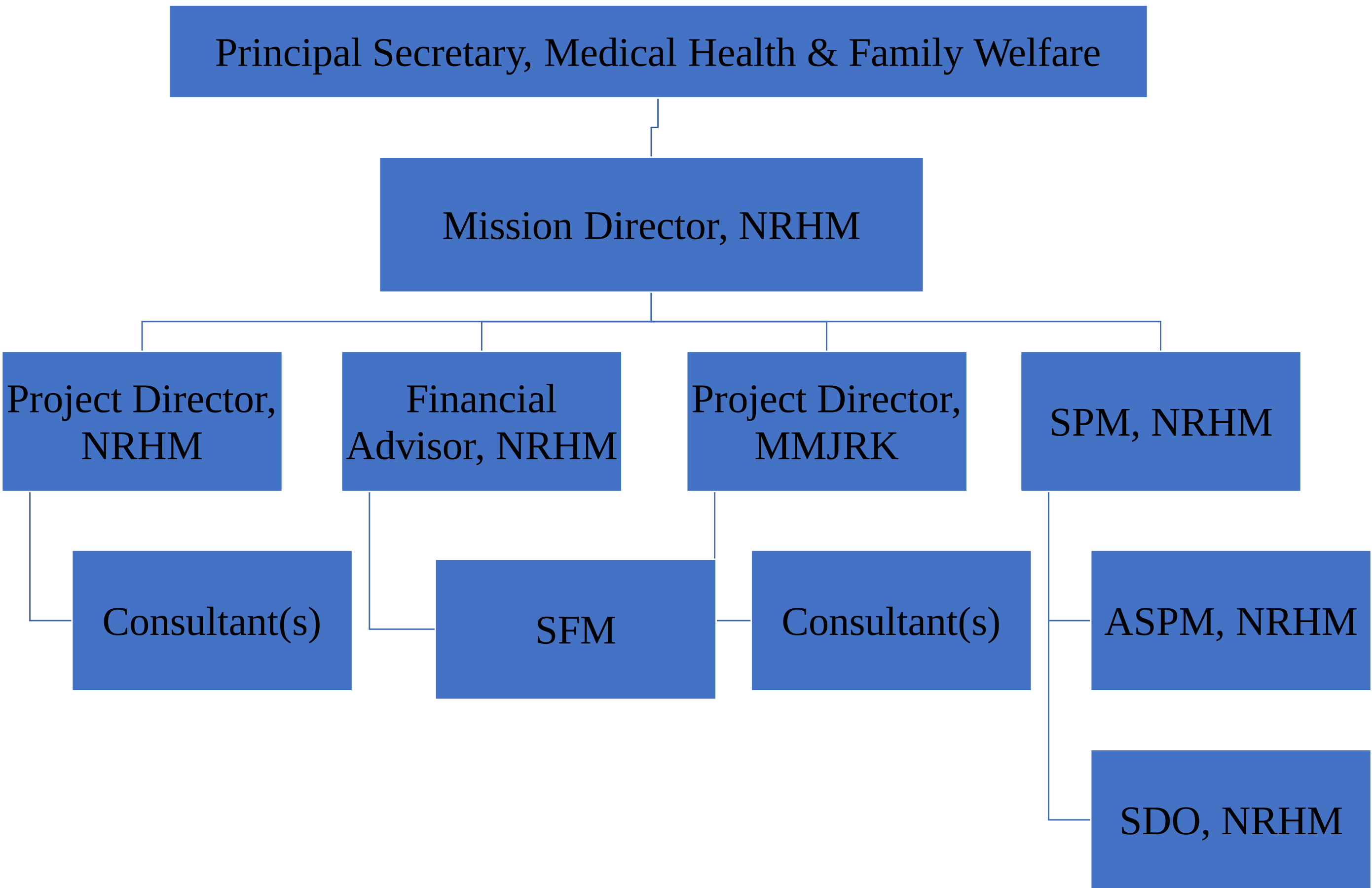
National Health Mission

- National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) was launched on April 12, 2005, to address the health needs of the underserved rural population especially women, children and vulnerable sections of the society and to provide affordable, accessible and quality healthcare.
- The National Urban Health Mission, (NUHM) was launched in May 2013 and was subsumed with NRHM as a sub-Mission of the overarching National Health Mission.

Vision and mission - "Attainment of Universal Access to Equitable, Affordable and Quality health care services, accountable and responsive to people's needs, With effective inter-sectoral convergent action to address the Wider social determinants of health".

The main aim is to create a fully functional, decentralized and community system With greater inter- sectoral coordination so that Wider social determinant factors affecting health of people like water, sanitation, nutrition, gender and education are also equally addressed.

SUGGESTIONS

- Integrate screening, early detection and management of vaccination and spread of awareness among rural as well as urban population .
- Emphasis on findings of left out cases of vaccines should be undertaken by frontline workers.
- Training of the frontline workers periodically.
- proper record of vaccination is necessary for filling the details of vaccination in PCTS portal.
- More staffs required at CHCS where the patient flow is high.

SWOT ANALYSIS

STRENGTH

- Screening and counselling done at all 33 districts of Rajasthan .
- immunization is working on 10 vaccines and 11 diseases and there is adequate supply of vaccination.

OPPORTUNITY

- Routine Immunization aims to ensure that every child is fully immunized ,regardless of their socio-economic background and geographic location.
- MCHN day is organised every Thursday in CHC and PHC for child and mother vaccination .

WEAKNESS

- One of the significant challenges of immunization is the limited awareness of vaccination in parents .
- Competence of frontline workers needs improvement.
- Skill based training required at CHC and PHC.

THREAT

- Shortage of trained skilled healthcare workforce , particularly in rural areas ,which and impede the smooth functioning of the program .
- lack of skipping of vaccination among parents and caregivers about the importance of vaccinations and the services it provides can be a barrier .

LEARNING

- Learned about Routine Immunization programs and its functioning.
- Choose to work under Routine Immunization program and learned about its functioning and the diseases covered under it and its management by medical officer, ANM and ASHAs.
- Did secondary data compilation and analysis of 33 districts of Rajasthan from march 2021 to march 2023.
- Learned about making and evaluating the indicators of immunization program and analyzing the data.
- Learned about the ODK collect portal of NHM which is filed by ASHAs and ANMs.
- Learned about the PCTS portal and evin portal under immunization.



CHALLENGES FACED DURING INTERNSHIP

- Dealing with some GNM who where less co-operative.
- Language Barrier.

- Theoretical principles were correlated and then used practically in the organization.
