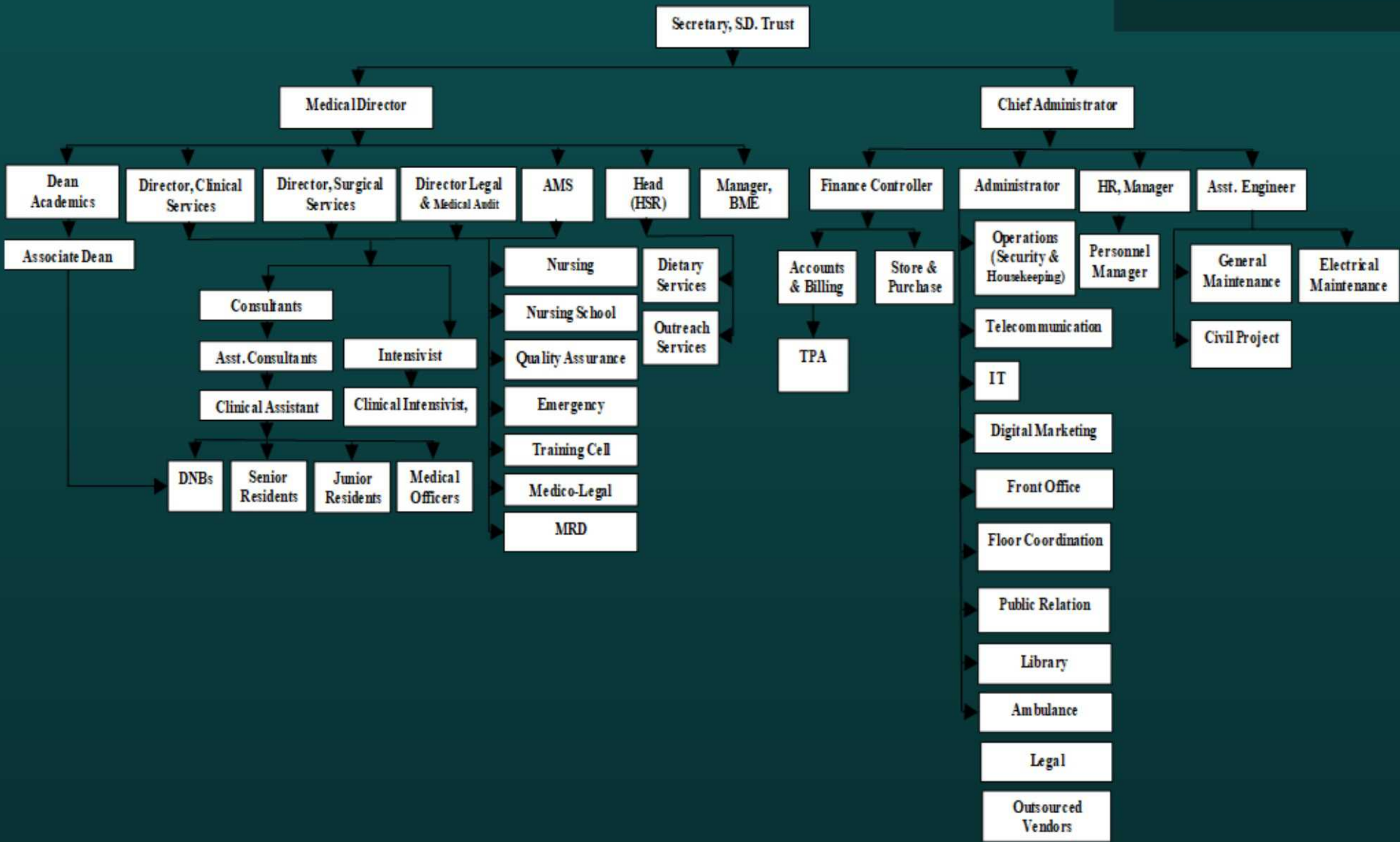
VISION
