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INTROCTION

This internship report is a detailed report of my internship at Jharkhand State Livelihood Promotion Society (JSLPS), which provided exposure to learning and experience of working at the ground level with a real-life organization. JSLPS is an autonomous society formed in 2009 within rural development department, Government of Jharkhand. This society was established as a mission to serve as a special purpose vehicle for smooth implementation of poverty reduction strategies, schemes and programs Jharkhand for disadvantages groups.

JSLPS works in various locations including West Singhbhum district Jharkhand completed my internship for three months in this institute where I participated in various projects apart from my personal research work. West Singhbhum is completely tribal and got the opportunity to work with the organization in three taluks(blocks) namely Tantnagar, Sadar Chaibasa and Chakradharpur in the district.

The main objective of this internship was to gain hands-on experience in the field of rural development, and at the same time to evaluate the work done by the organization. The aim was to

implement the theoretical concepts learned in the university and to increase insight into the problems and potential of rural areas. During the internship, I got the opportunity to work under the supervision of different experts like agriculture expert, governance expert who introduced me to the reality of rural development process.

These parts of the report include information on the organization of JSLPS, detailing the activities of the interns, evaluation of the results and outcomes of the projects carried out, and evaluation of the acquired knowledge and skills.

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OBJECTIVE OF INTERNSHIP

- The main objective of this internship is to gain practical, hands-on experience in the field of rural development by actively participating in various projects and activities undertaken by the JSLPS.
- To evaluate the effectiveness of PGC in improving antenatal, intra natal, and postnatal care practices.
- To assess the role of TPCA in enhancing community participation and accountability in health and nutrition initiatives.
- To determine the combined impact of TPCA and PGC on maternal and child health indicators.

PROFILE OF JSLPS

Jharkhand State Livelihood Promotion Society is an autonomous society form in 2009 within rural development department, Government of Jharkhand. This society was established as a mission to serve as a special purpose vehicle for smooth implementation of poverty reduction strategies, schemes and programs Jharkhand for disadvantages groups.

JSLPS works as a nodal agency for livelihood promotion strategies and interventions in the state and it collaborates with various government departments. NGOs/CBOs, technical institutions, and private sector. It functions democratically through its executive council, and general body which represent secretaries from government departments. Policy makers, social makers, and representatives of NGOs, Hon'ble minister, rural department is chairperson of GB while the EC is headed by the Principle Secretary, Rural Department. The EC of society is empowered to approve the system and policies of the society as well as supervises day to day business.

The JSLPS was designed by the state government to anchor and implement the National Rural Livelihood Mission in Jharkhand I the September 2011. The society was initiated the SRLM activity in the financial year 2012-13. The state level State Mission Management Unit (SMMU) has been established within the society, which is headed by a full time Chief Executive Officer (CEO), The CEO is being supported by a full time Chief Operating Officer (COO) and a team of senior level professionals and thematic experts. The SMMU has unveiled its independent vertical at district and blocks as District Program Manager and Block Program Manager, respectively.

Vision

To build sustainable livelihoods and enhance the quality of life for the rural poor in Jharkhand through community-driven and participatory approaches.

Mission

To mobilize and empower rural communities, particularly the poor and marginalized, to take charge of their socio-economic development by providing access to financial resources, livelihood opportunities, and support services.

Values

Inclusivity and Equity: Ensuring all sections of the society, especially the marginalized and vulnerable, are included and have equal opportunities.

Transparency and Accountability: Maintaining openness and responsibility in all processes and actions.

Community Participation: Encouraging active participation and ownership of the community in the development process.
