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INTRODUCTION

In order to empower poor, tribes and backward society politically and improve their participation in Panchayati Raj System, the concept of Mission Badlaav organization received increasing attention in recent years. Mission Badlaav can be defined as groups of youngsters who voluntarily form legally registered associations aimed at spreading awareness about constitutional rights, by improving access of governmental services. Main goal of Mission Badlaav is to spread awareness about their constitutional rights and interests among villagers. Poor farmers, laborers and backwards can avail governmental services and rights through collective action.

Mission Badlaav organization is a legal entity formed by Farmers, labourers, youth, students, women, service man. Members of Mission Badlaav works voluntarily. They do not get any kind of salary. The organization does not get any external fund.
