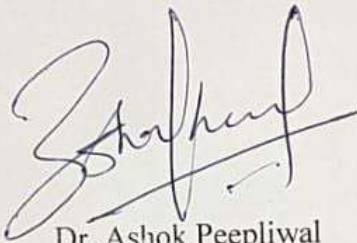

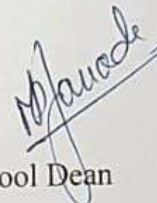

Patients should closely have observed when taking cardio selective beta-blockers if they have second- or third-degree heart block, notable sinus bradycardia, cardiogenic shock, or complete heart block.

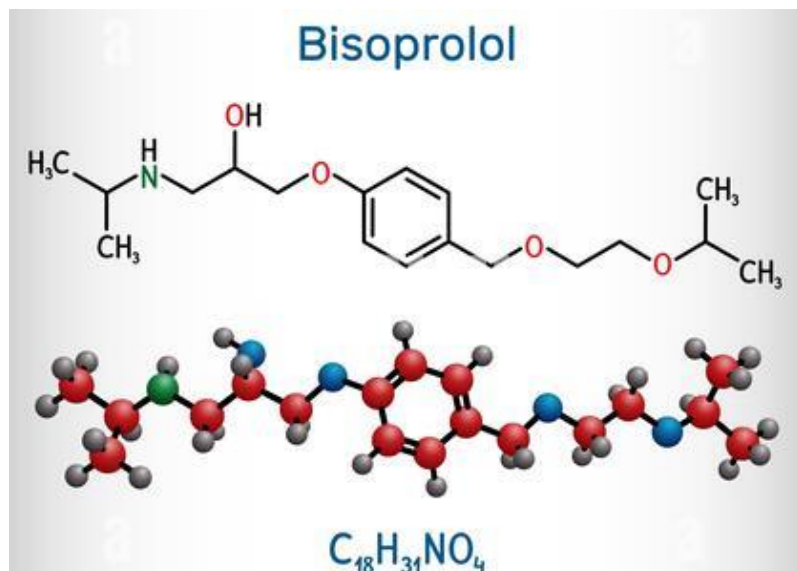

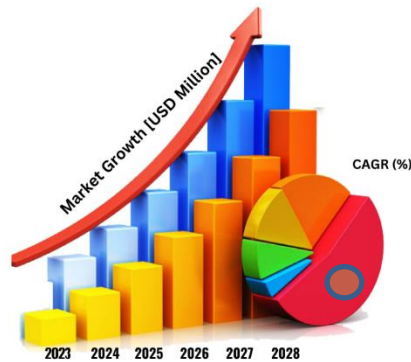
