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Chapter 1

Introduction

1. 1 Background

Medicolegal cases (MLCs) are those cases that contain medical and legal features in their occurrence for which the healthcare workers practice their jobs with legal consideration. These cases often involve emergency departments given the nature of emergency situations, which basically involves accidents, assault or any other incidents that may result in a legal process. Such cases require proper recording, strict legal procedures, and collaboration with the law enforcement departments.

The Ramkrishna Care Hospital in Raipur has been considered as a leading healthcare organization and it addresses a huge number of MLCs in its ER. This is the reason why these cases are considered complex and highly sensitive that identifying their handling process helps in finding areas for development. Therefore, the purpose of this research is to investigate the MLCs status in this particular hospital and to understand how these cases are managed in the present scenario with regard to practices, enablers, barriers, and outcomes.
