IMPORTANCE OF LICENCE TRACKER



- Licenses need to be renewed periodically. A tracker helps in monitoring expiration dates and sends reminders for renewals, preventing lapses in licensure that could interrupt hospital operations
- Hospitals are subject to regular audits by regulatory bodies. An organized license tracker system ensures that all necessary documentation is readily available, facilitating a smooth audit process.
- Keeping track of licenses helps in identifying and mitigating risks associated with expired or invalid licenses.

- Maintaining licenses can be expensive and time-consuming, involving substantial administrative effort.



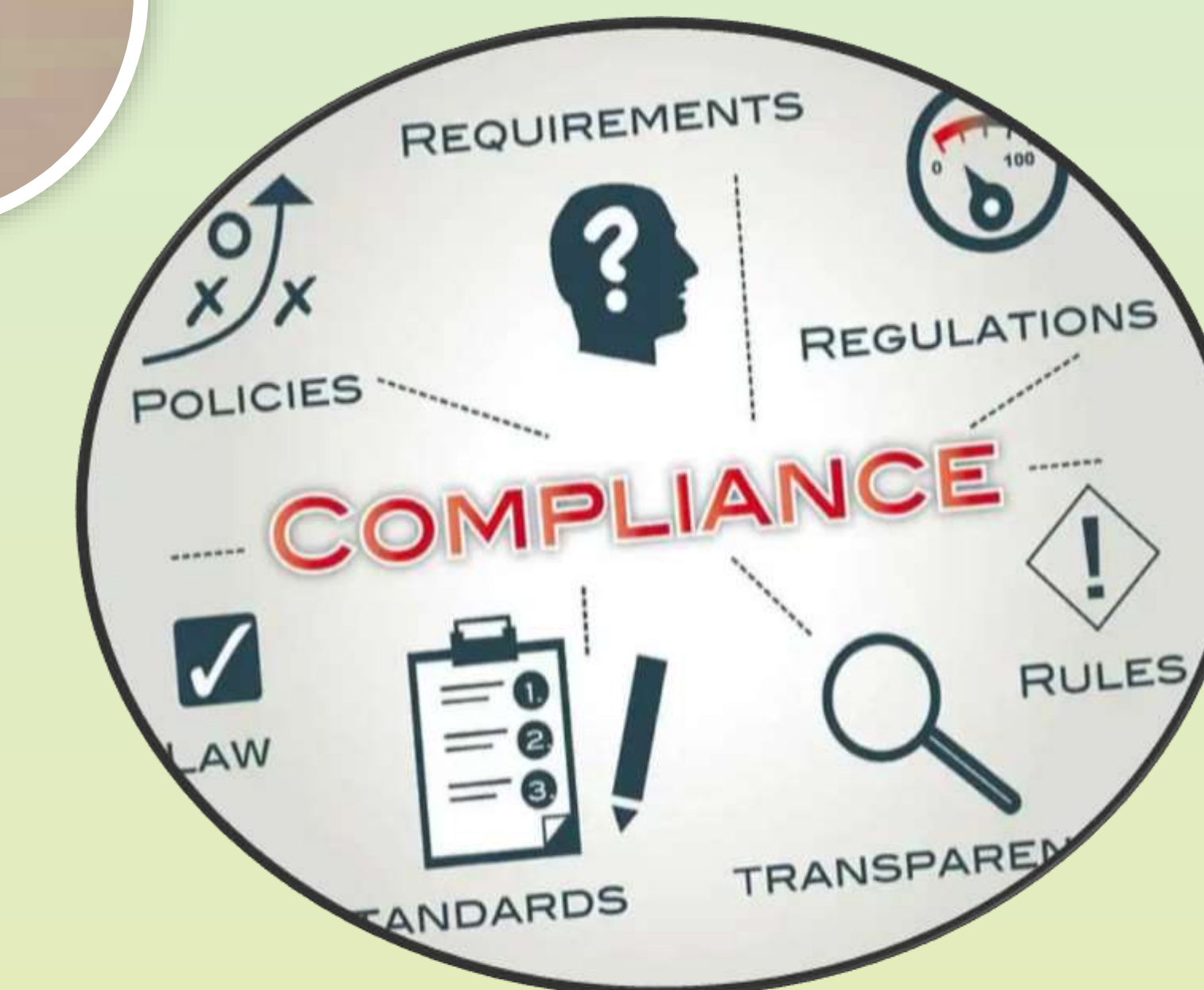
OPPORTUNITIES
