Research Question.

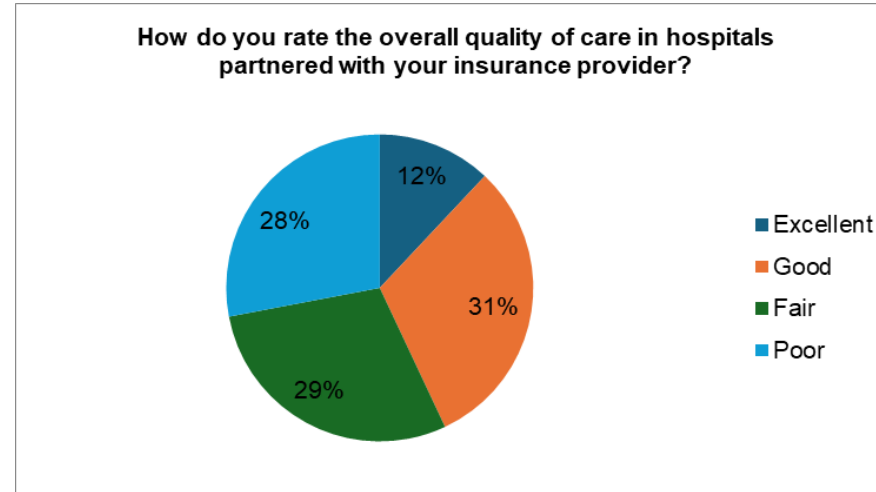

Methodology

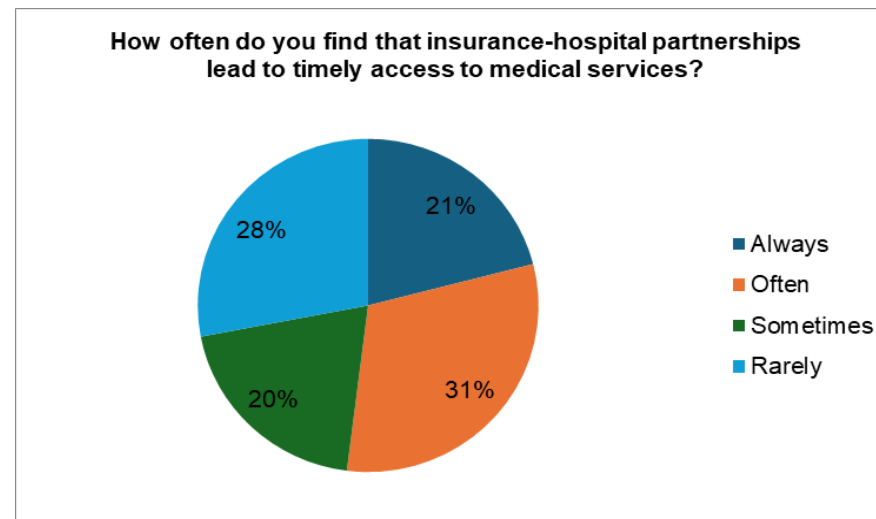
- **Study Type** :-Observational study (cohort or case-control) comparing patient outcomes between hospitals with and without insurance partnerships.

Result

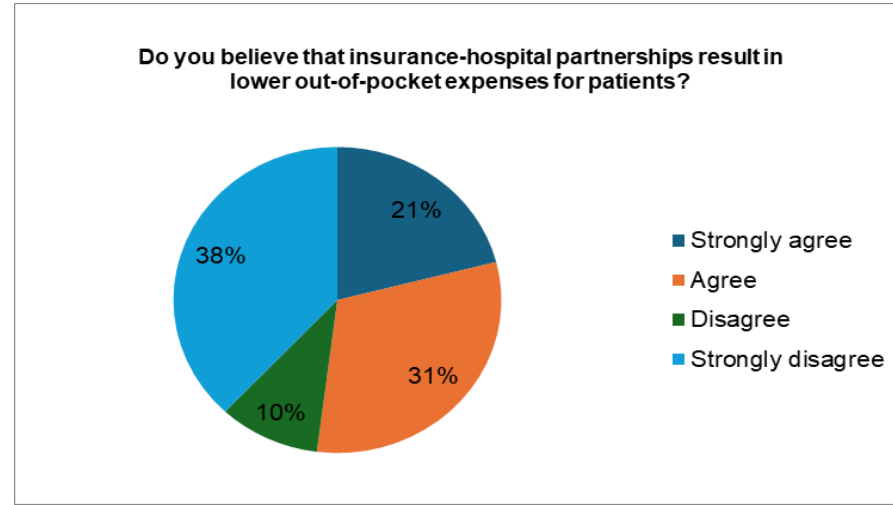
1. How do you rate the overall quality of care in hospitals partnered with your insurance provider?



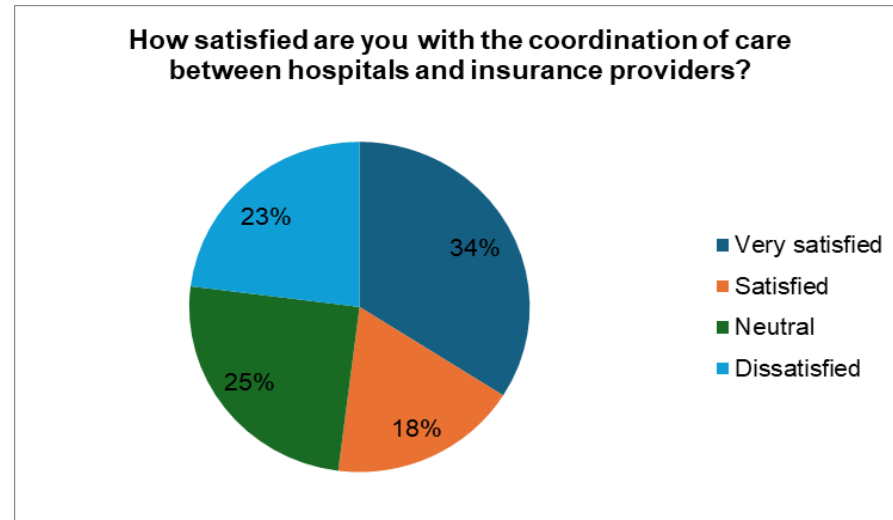
2. How often do you find that insurance-hospital partnerships lead to timely access to medical services?



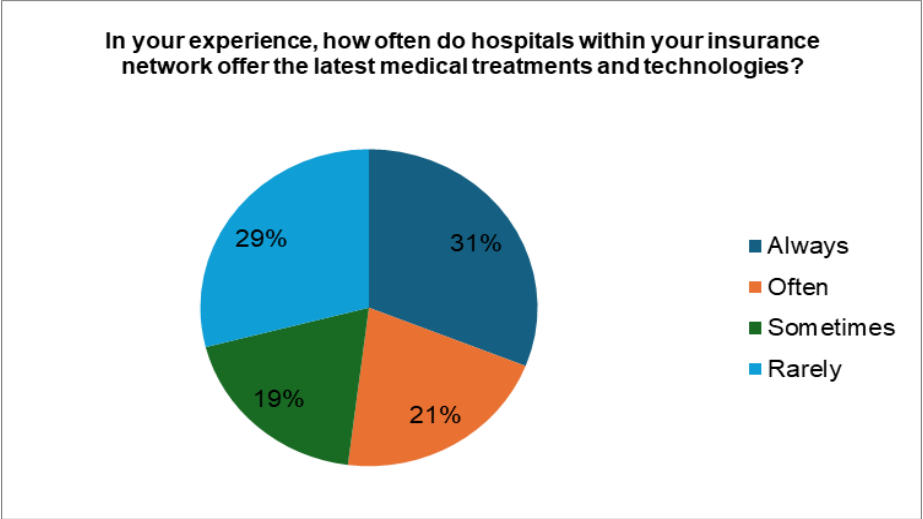
3. Do you believe that insurance-hospital partnerships result in lower out-of-pocket expenses for patients?



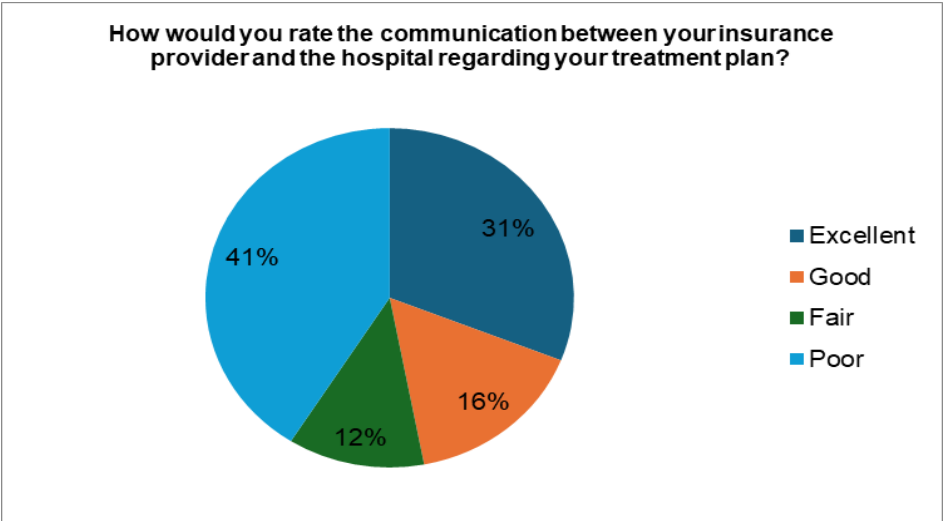
4. How satisfied are you with the coordination of care between hospitals and insurance providers?
