- The present study has covered 6 self-help groups of 89 SHG members in village- Jagannathpur, Tola- Dipasai.
 - The study based on primary and secondary data.
 - The Primary data collected from the respondents through interview, group-discussion and questionnaire.
 - The Secondary data were collected from various reading, journals, newspaper and website.
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KEY FINDING

- Most of the respondents are in the age group of 30-40 year of age.
 - 30% of the members have at least basic education, still many members are illiterate.
 - Forty-five percent of the respondent have been members of the SHGs for more than 5 years.
 - All members have taken up different entrepreneurial activities as their main occupation.
 - All the members of SHGs have knowledge about Financial Activities.
 - Twenty-eight percent, Seventy-two percent members are Strongly agreed and agree that they participate in decision making.
 - None of the SHGs members participating in the panchayat or any other election.
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CONCLUSION

- SHG as a participating approach are successful in contributing to community development, Social Change, removal of social evils, breaking the norms of traditional society and fulfilling the gap of credit facilities and skill base.
