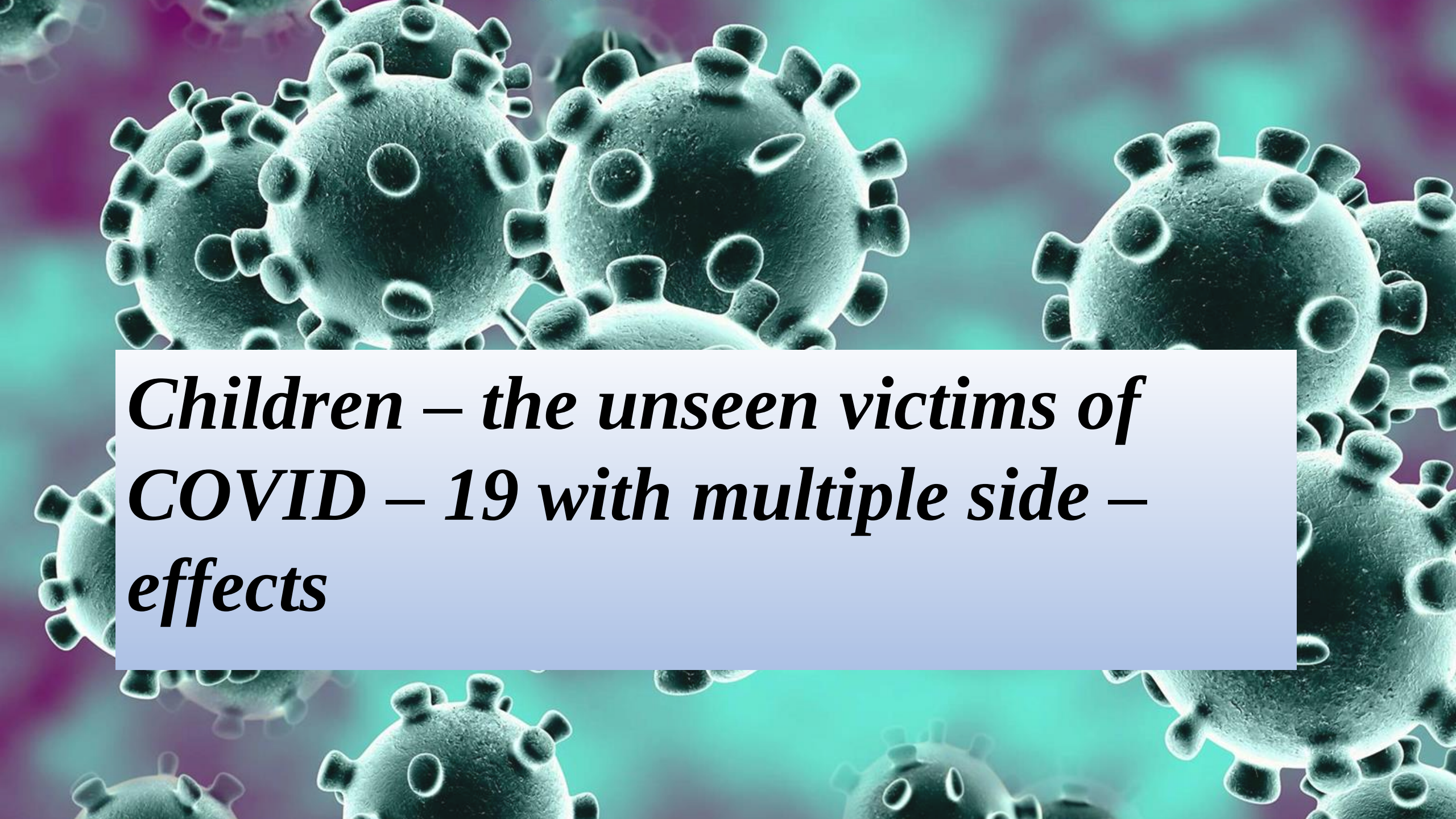


# Summer Training Presentation

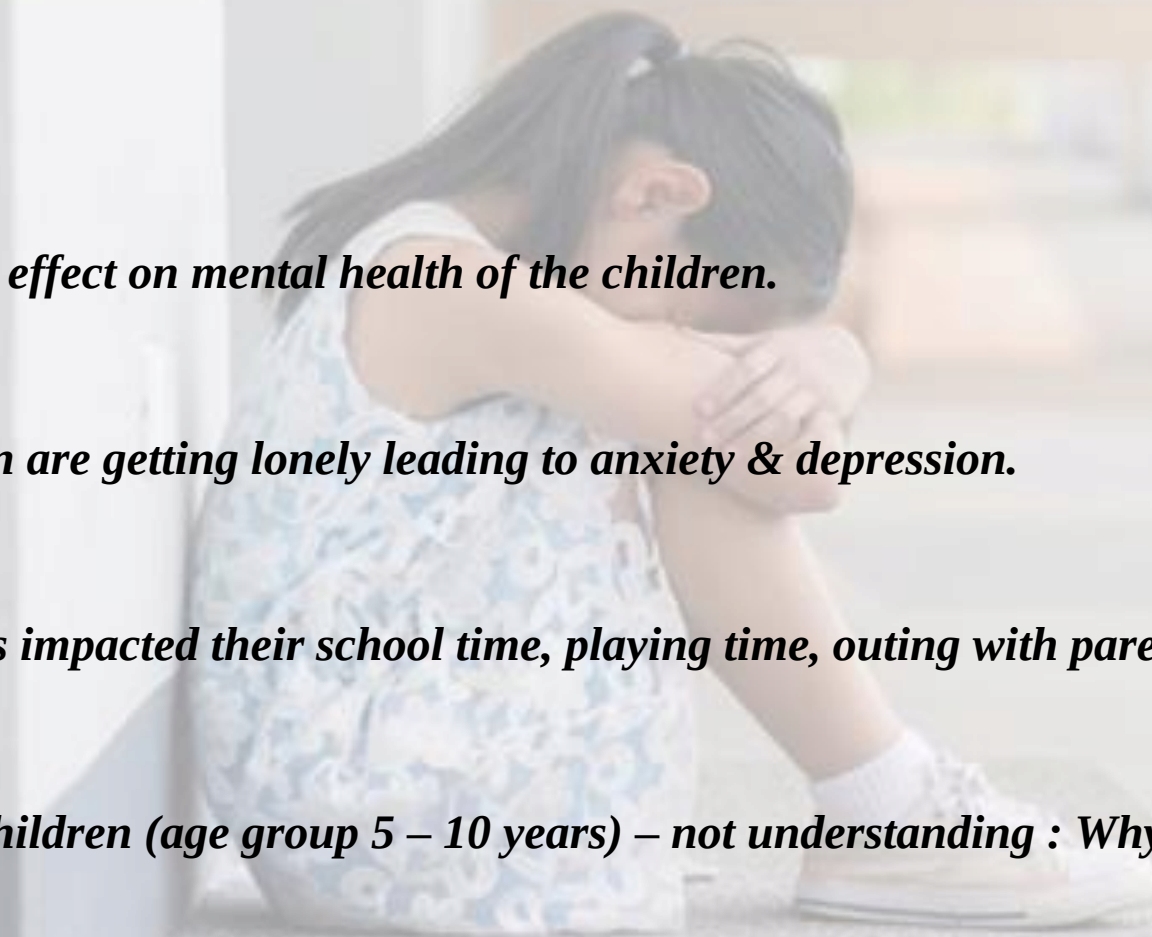

# Impact on Physical Health

- ✓ *Children are minimum susceptible to the corona virus disease. As compare to adults.*
- ✓ *Children with health conditions like heart disease, lung disease or weak immune system are more susceptible to serious COVID-19*
- ✓ *Children under age 1- 2 (infants) are at higher risk of severe illness with COVID-19.*
- ✓ *New born babies can be affected by this virus during delivery or by infected beds etc.*
- ✓ *Social events such as baby shower should be avoided.*

# Impact on mental health – lockdown pressure

- 
- ✓ *Adverse effect on mental health of the children.*
  - ✓ *Children are getting lonely leading to anxiety & depression.*
  - ✓ *This has impacted their school time, playing time, outing with parents etc.*
  - ✓ *Small children (age group 5 – 10 years) – not understanding : Why to wear mask ?*
  - ✓ *lockdown is a tragedy for most of the children whose families are struggling financially.*



# ***COVID – 19 affecting children's education - School closures***

- ✓ *Education of around 300 million students was affected due to school closures*
- ✓ *Various barriers in conducting online classes such as no internet connectivity, no availability of laptops or phones and many more.*
- ✓ *The parents are worried about their child's education*
- ✓ *Poor children do not have access to laptops and internet*
- ✓ *Parents - children are not going to schools then why they have to pay school fees.*

# ***COVID – 19 has left many children hungry – Food insecurity***

- ✓ ***Mid – Day meal stopped – 1.75 million students affected in India***
- ✓ ***Food insecurity to children - affecting children's health and nutrition needs.***
- ✓ ***Daily wage workers – no wages – No money for food***



# ***Impact of COVID - 19 on children whose parents are front line workers***

- ✓ ***Children are feeling alone at home because their parents are not coming home or coming daily***
- ✓ ***Parents feel scared in going close to their children because of this disease.***
- ✓ ***Children - dependent on their mothers for breastfeeding, they are facing lot of problems due to this.***
- ✓ ***Children who understand this and they are feeling very proud of their parents***
- ✓ ***During this time, children need time so that they may not feel depressed or scary.***



# ***Impact of COVID- 19 on Child labour***

- ✓ ***lockdown - increase in participation of child in labour***
- ✓ ***it has increased the work poverty in legally working children***
- ✓ ***The vulnerable children are at high risk of getting trapped in the child labour forcedly.***
- ✓ ***Girl children are at a high risk of getting burdened by household chores and domestic violence***
