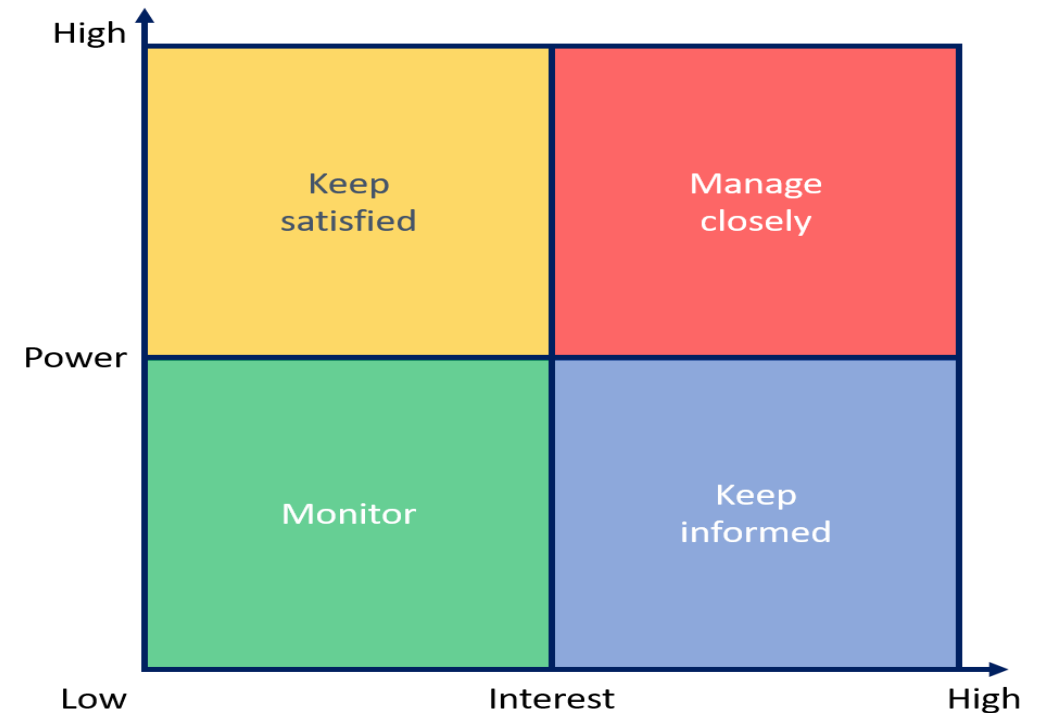
Objective-

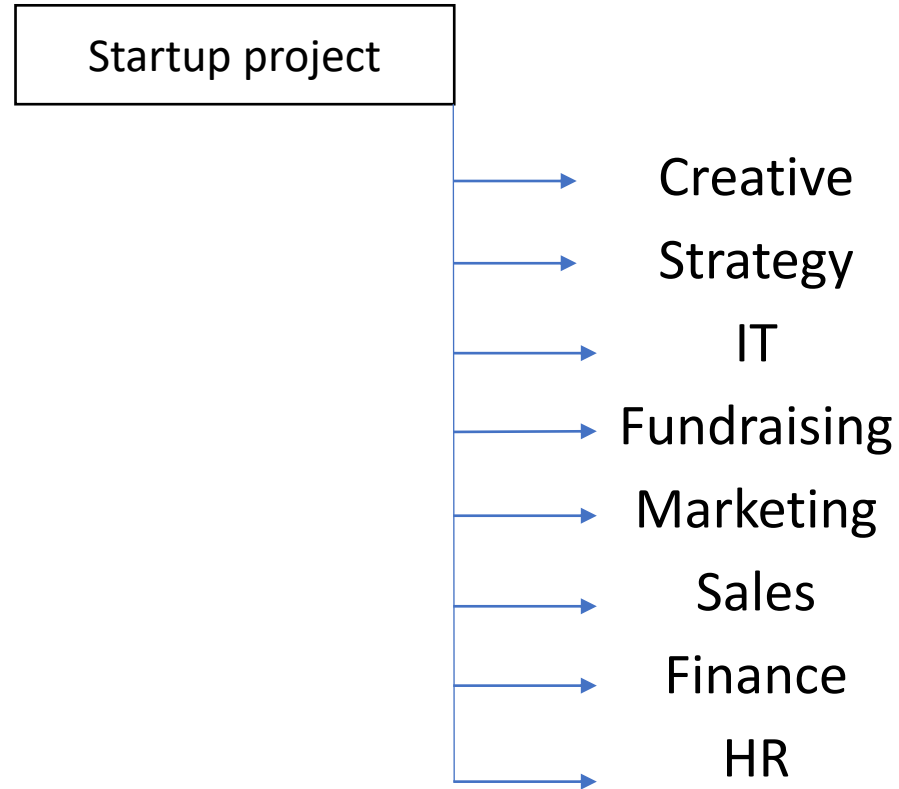

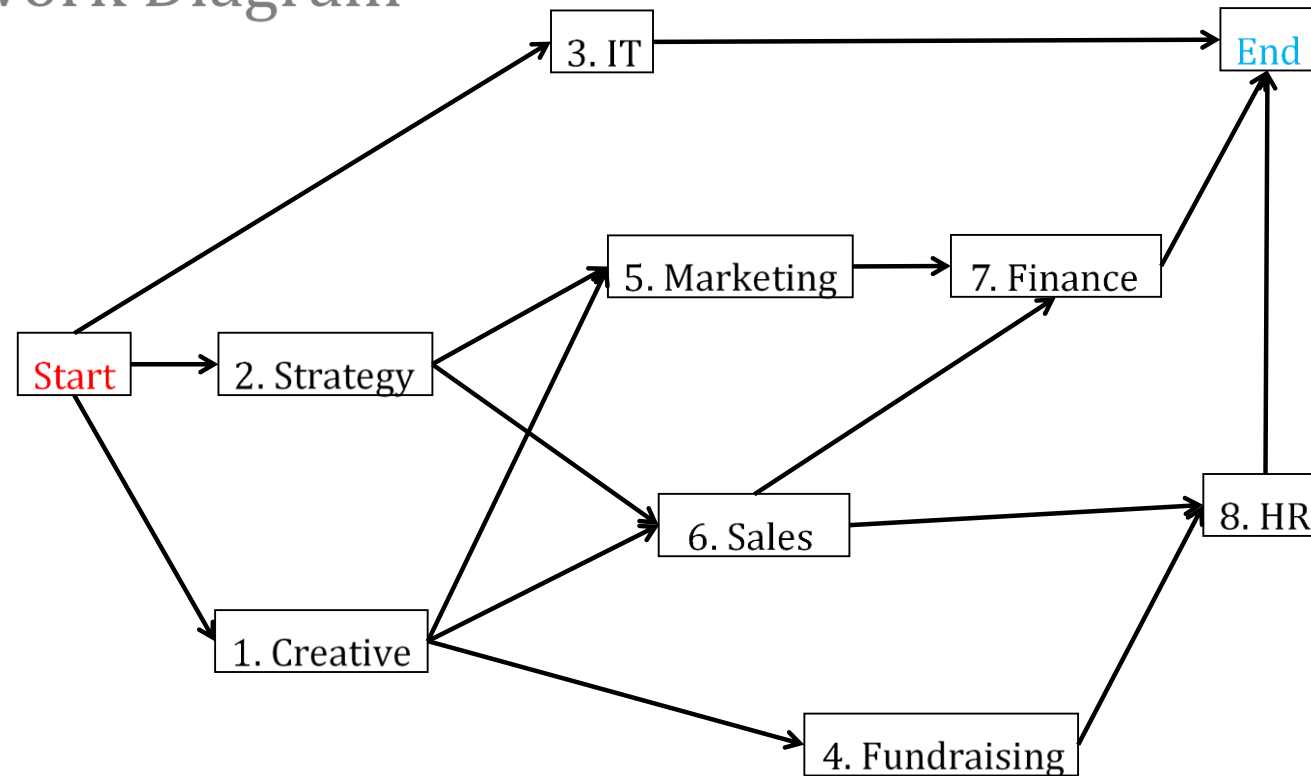

Work breakdown structure-

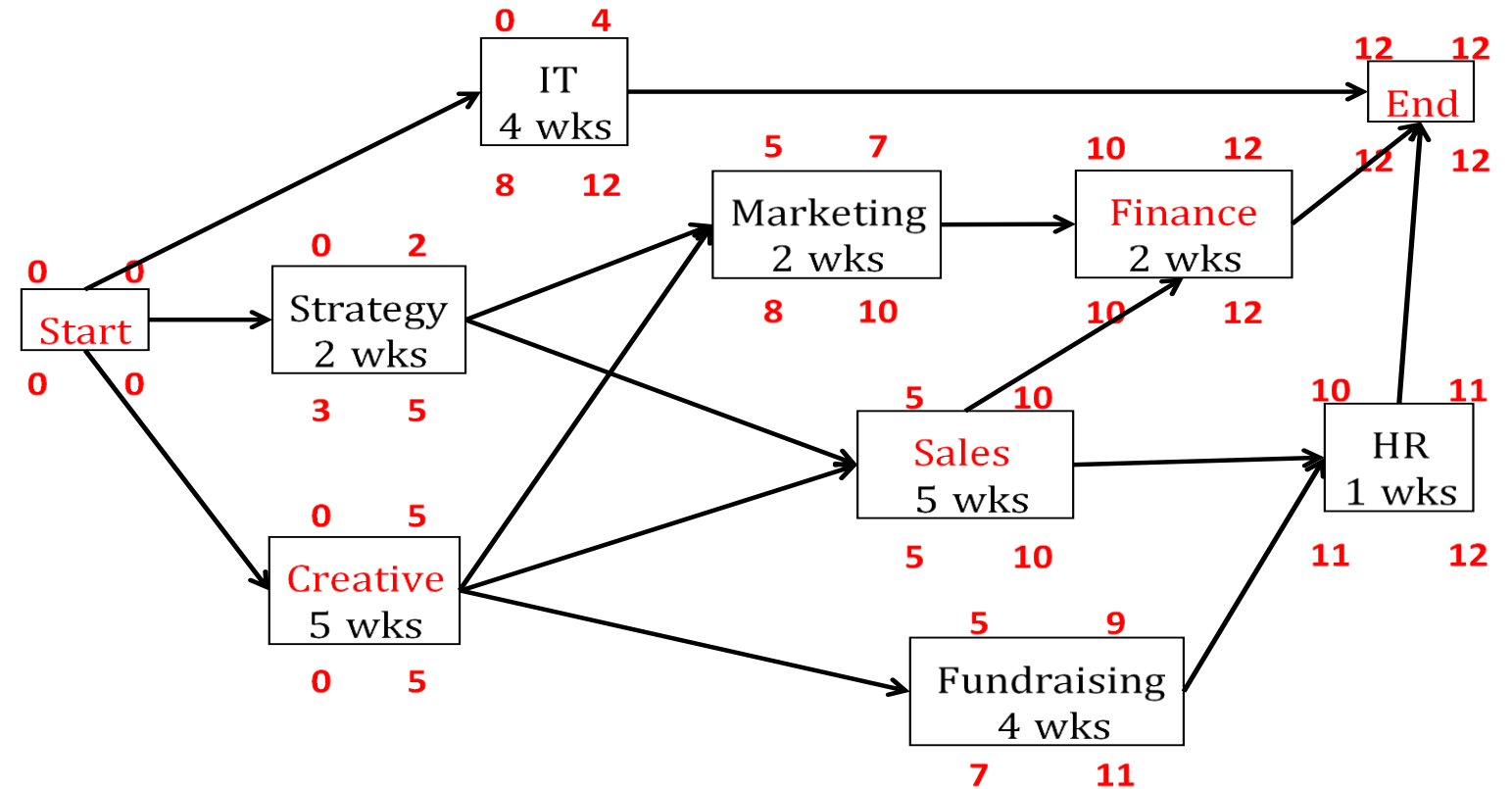


Network Diagram



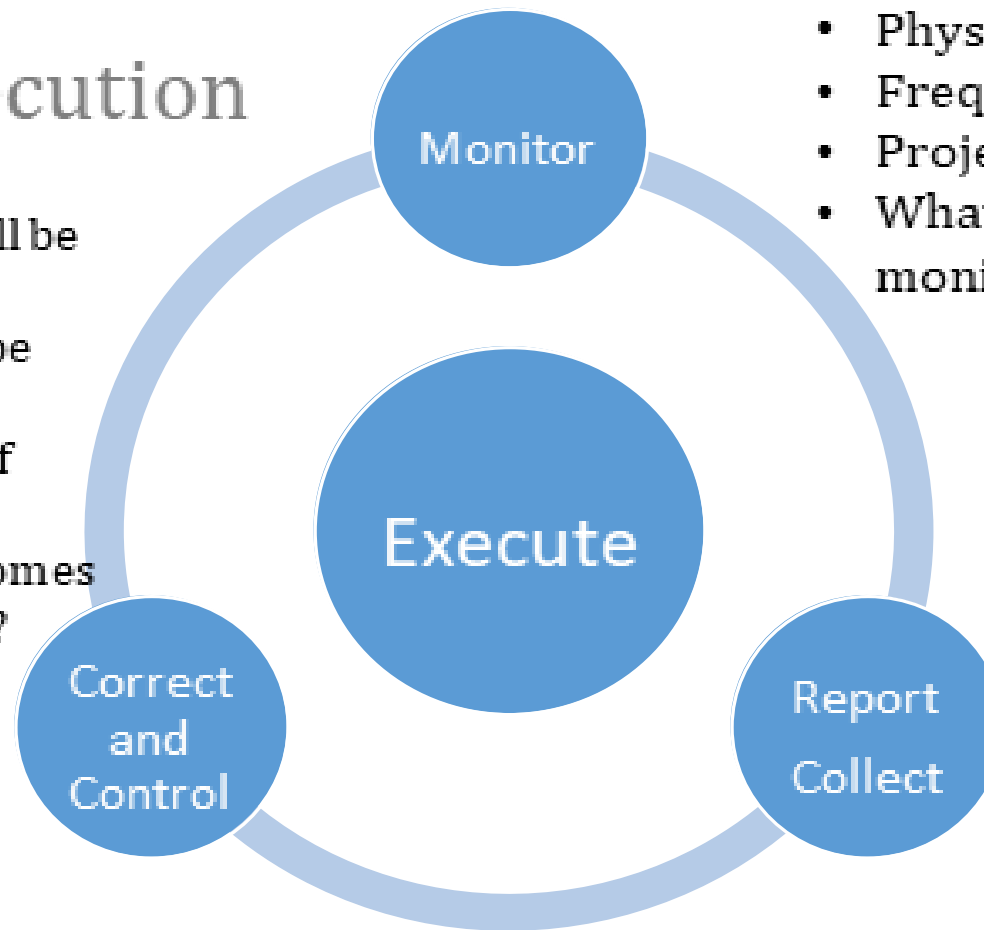
Critical Path Analysis

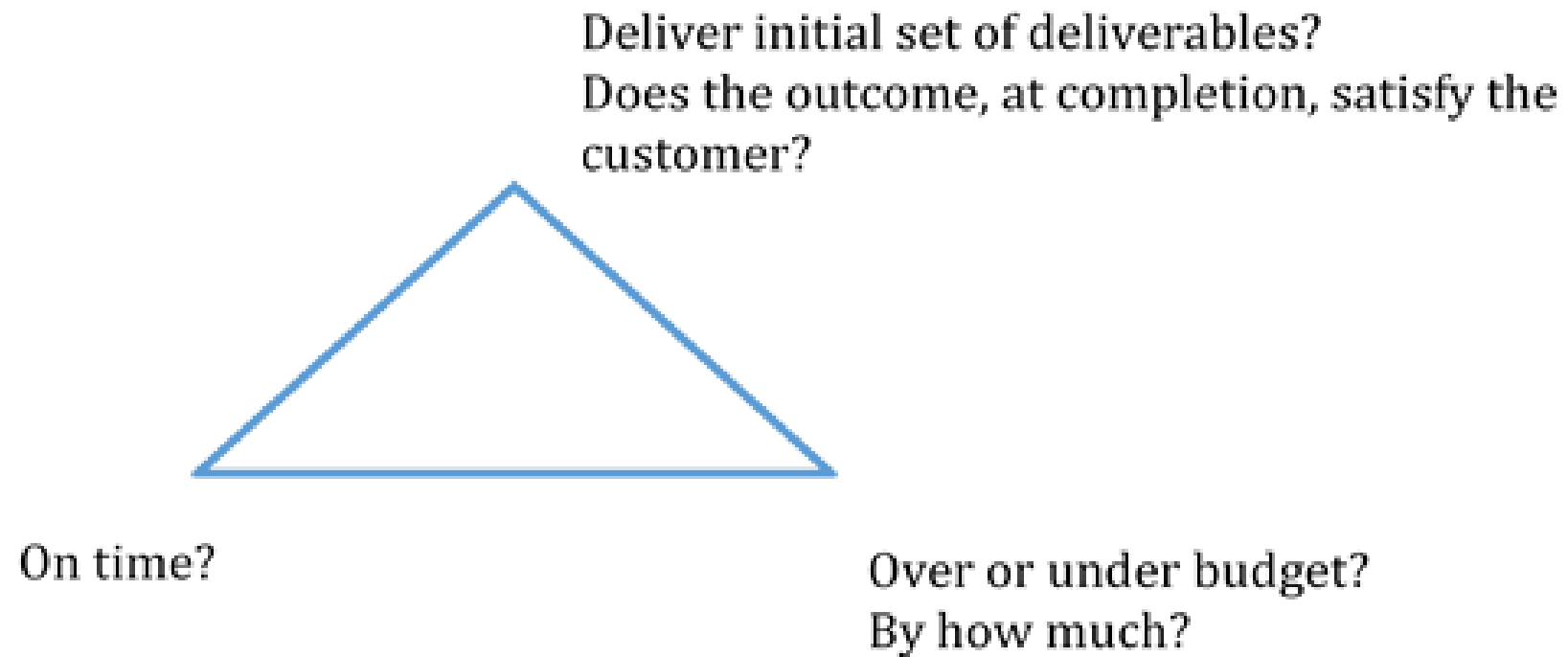
