



BACKGROUND

According to JJ act:

- Child in need of care and protection:-
 - child who is found without any home or settlement,
 - Who resides with a person who has threatened to kill or injure the child
 - Has killed, abused or neglected some other child or children
- Who is mentally or physically challenged
- Who has parent or guardian and is unfit to exercise control over child
- Who is being or is likely to be turned or exploited for the purpose of sexual abuse or illegal acts
- Who is found vulnerable and is likely to be inducted into drug abuse or trafficking

Rehabilitation and Re-integration:-

- The action of restoring children to health or normal life by giving them medical care, education etc

- To understand case interventions of CHILDLINE for child in need of care and protection.

CONCLUSION

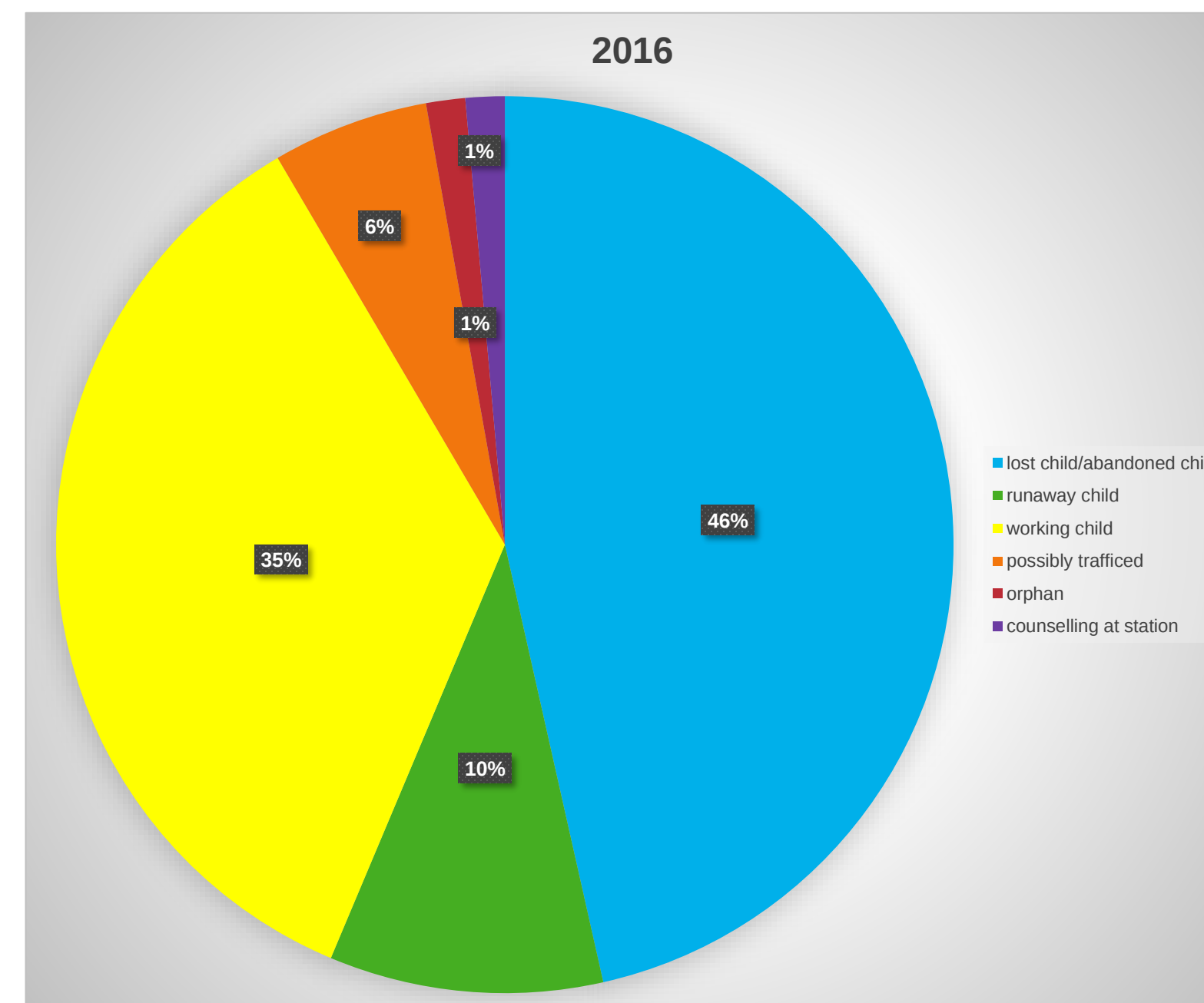
- Cases related to runaway children are found to be maximum in number.

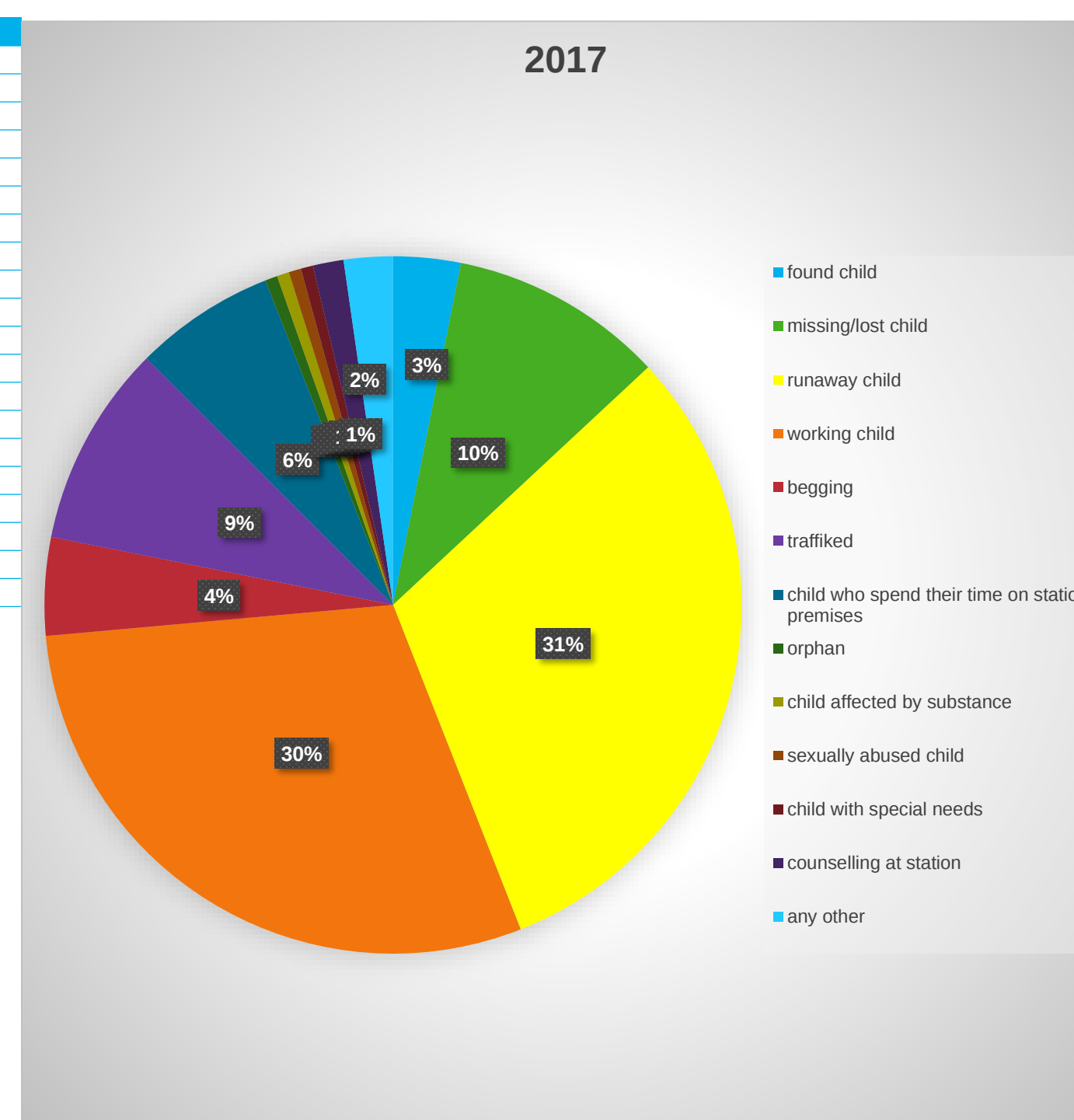

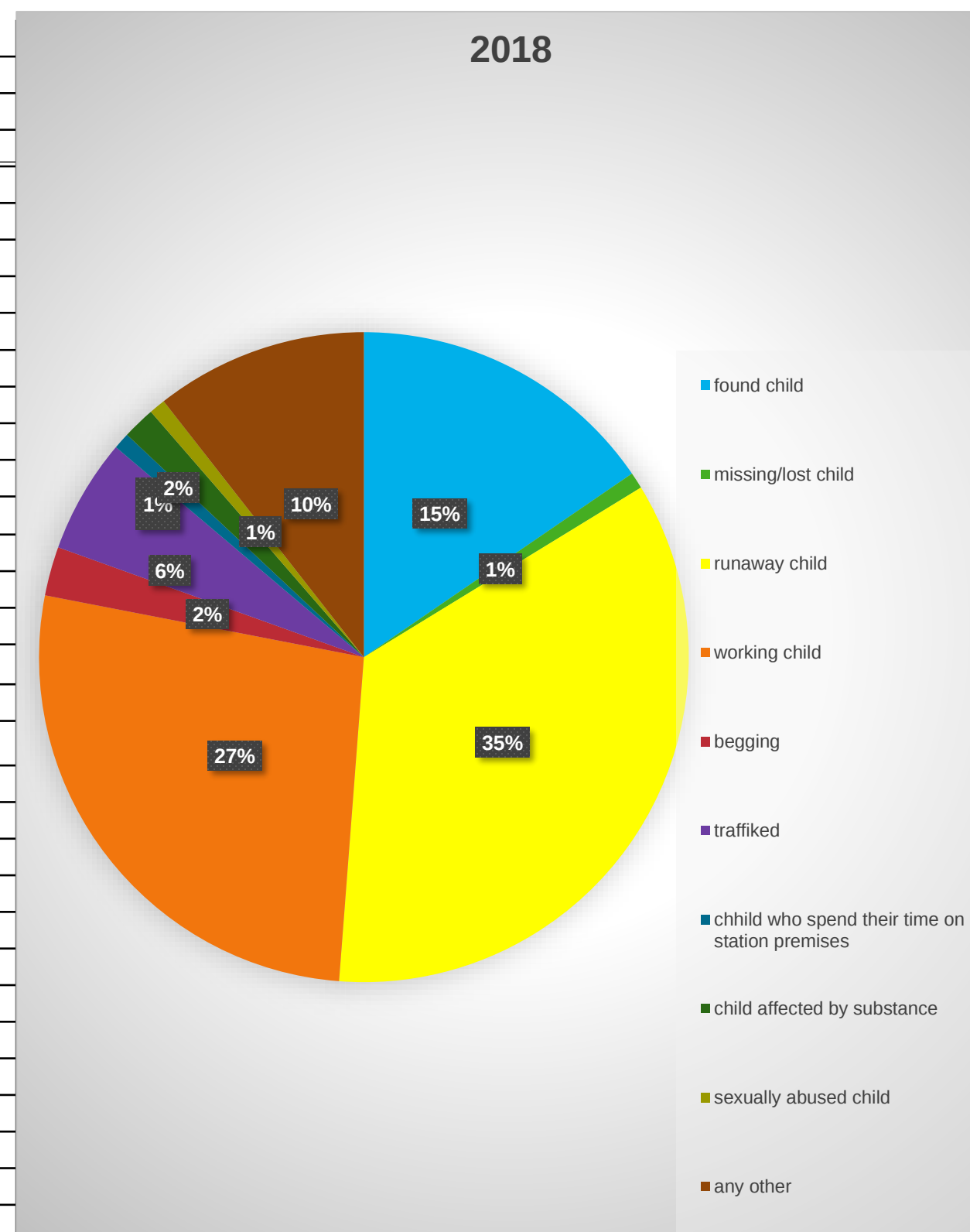

- Currently institutionalizing children is considered as first priority by the authorities.

 - exploited children
 - runaway from home
 - children indulge in smuggling

FINDINGS (FXB)

FXB INDIA SURAKSHA:-

Group discussion

- Deals with the children from nearest slums and who parents are somehow engaged with railway and are living in open.
- Provide support in education, health facility, medical care, nutrition, psycho-socio session, safety and protection.
- Nearest hotels are helping in providing food for 30-40 children.
- Conducting health session with family.
- Family counseling and time to time observation.
- Also trained them to take admission in schools.
- Time to time sessions which includes safety from accessing internet and social media
- These children also take active participation in the awareness campaigns and help spread the word.
- Lack of capacity building and sensitization of the children.
- Parents are not taking active participation in counseling.
- Parents of some children asks them to leave organization and start working with them in order to earn some money

FINDINGS (OSCMCC)

- Limited capacitated staff in handling children case
- Deals with the children below the age of 18
- Procedural delays and daily hassles
- Outlook to assume children on the other side of law and criminals
- Lack of family support
- Lack of availability of child friendly structures and environment
- Non availability of services of experts
- Also deals with the children who have to face procedural delays when they come in contact with police.
- Currently institutionalising children is considered as first priority by the authorities.
- Cases related to teenagers are difficult to handle.
- Helped many children to reunite with their family.
- Provided shelter to many children.
