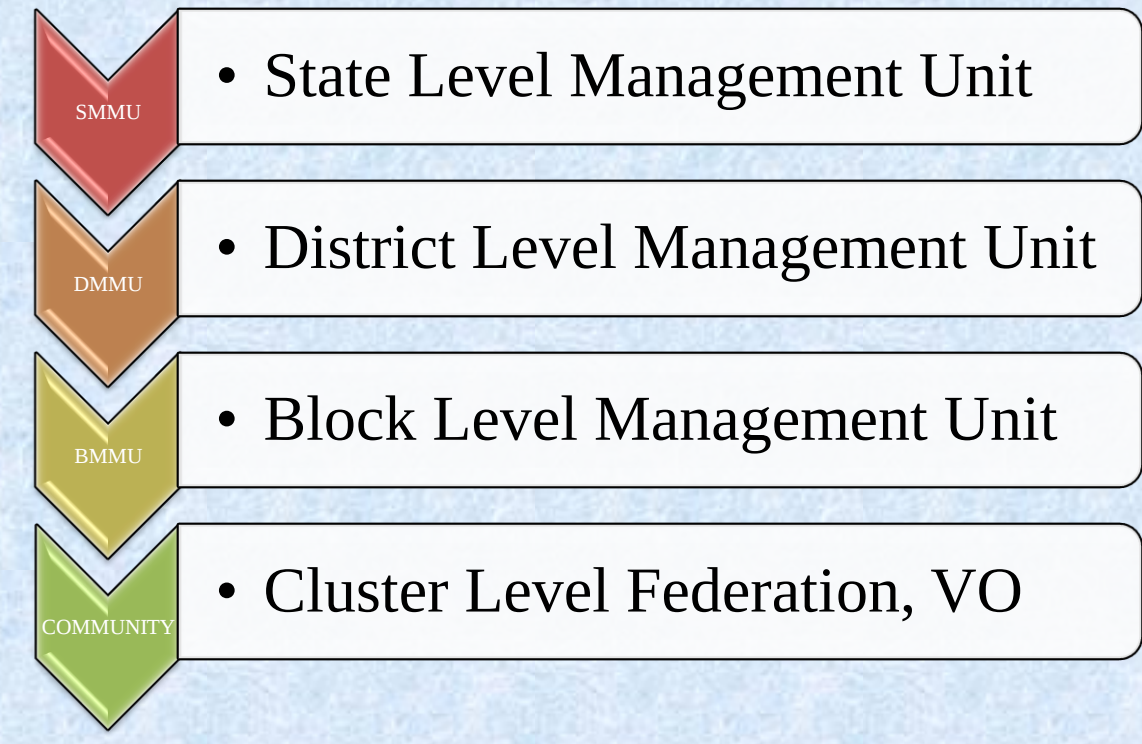

- To evaluate the impact of the program.

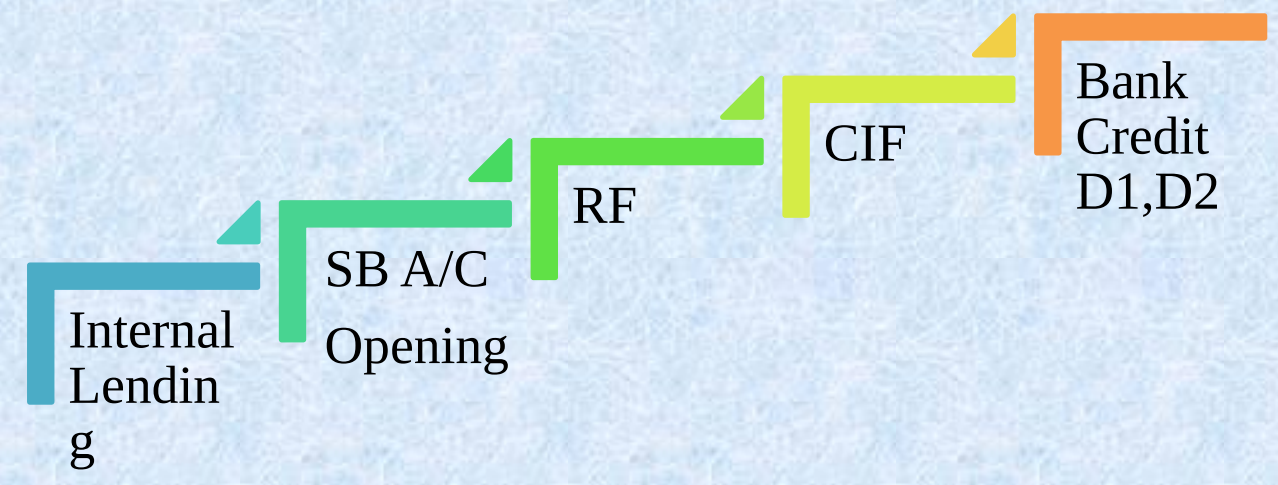
Methodology

Data Collection : Questionnaire, Interview, and from RGAVP MIS.

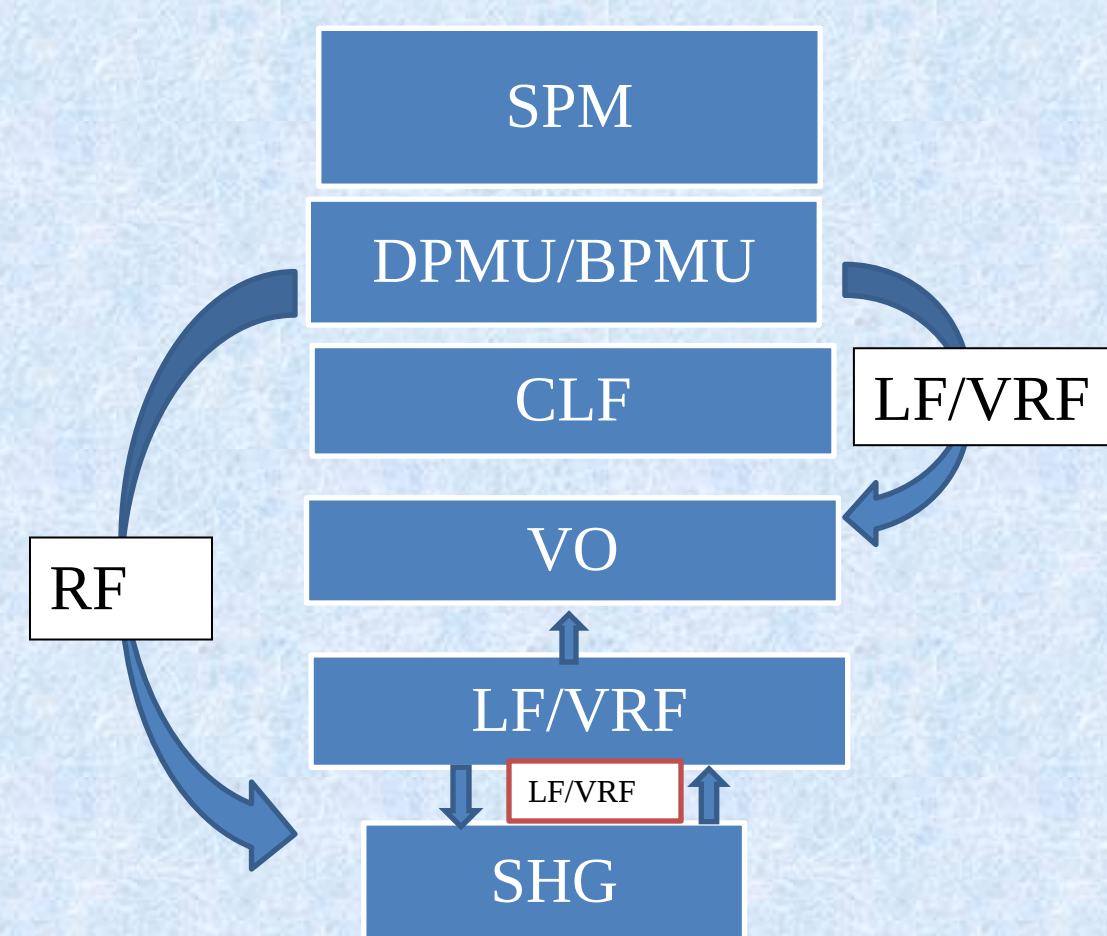
Structure of Rajeevika



Capitalization Structure of SHG

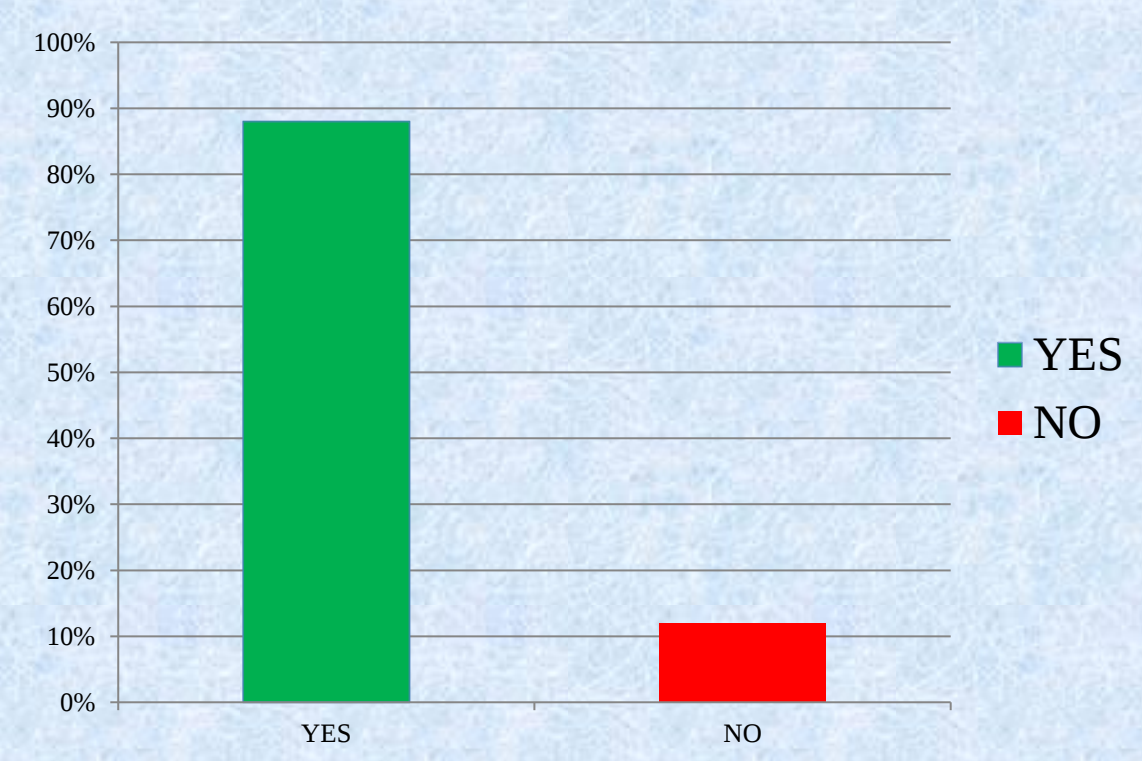


Flow of Funds among CI

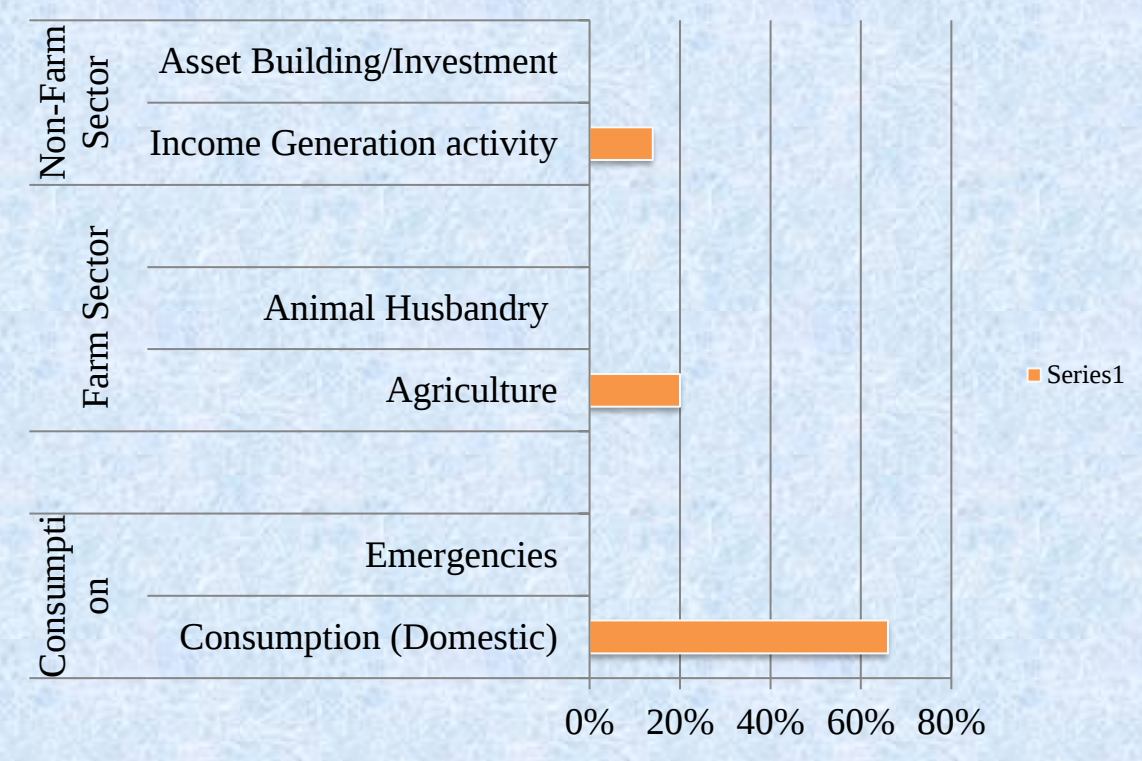

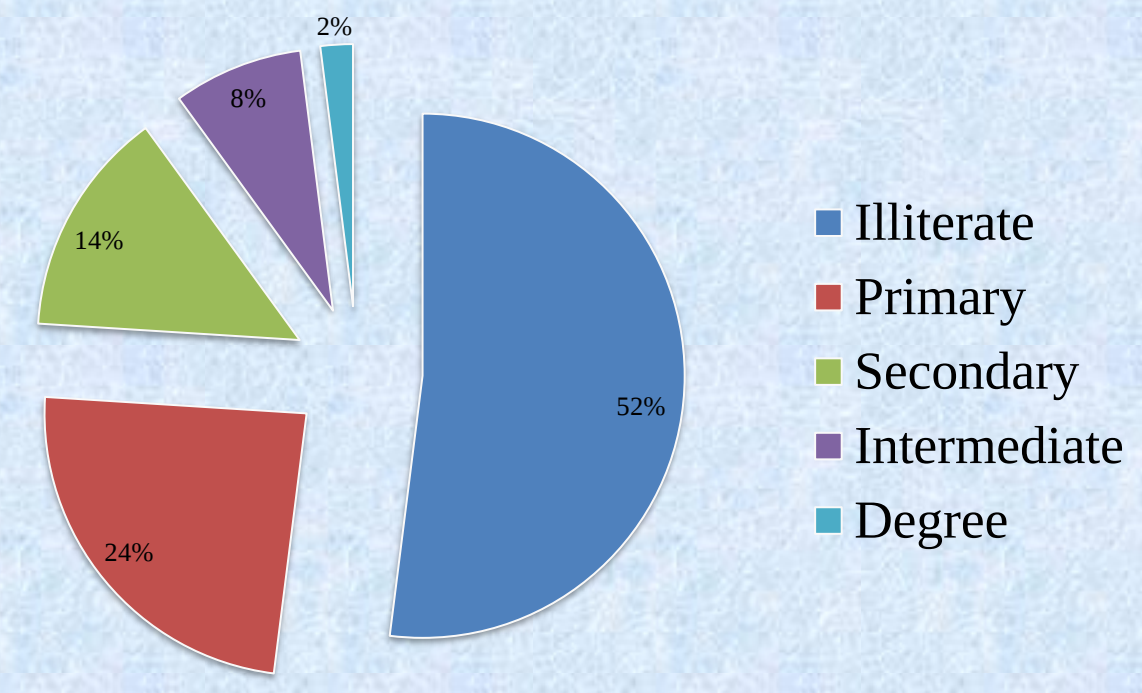
Impact of Joining SHG on Social Status



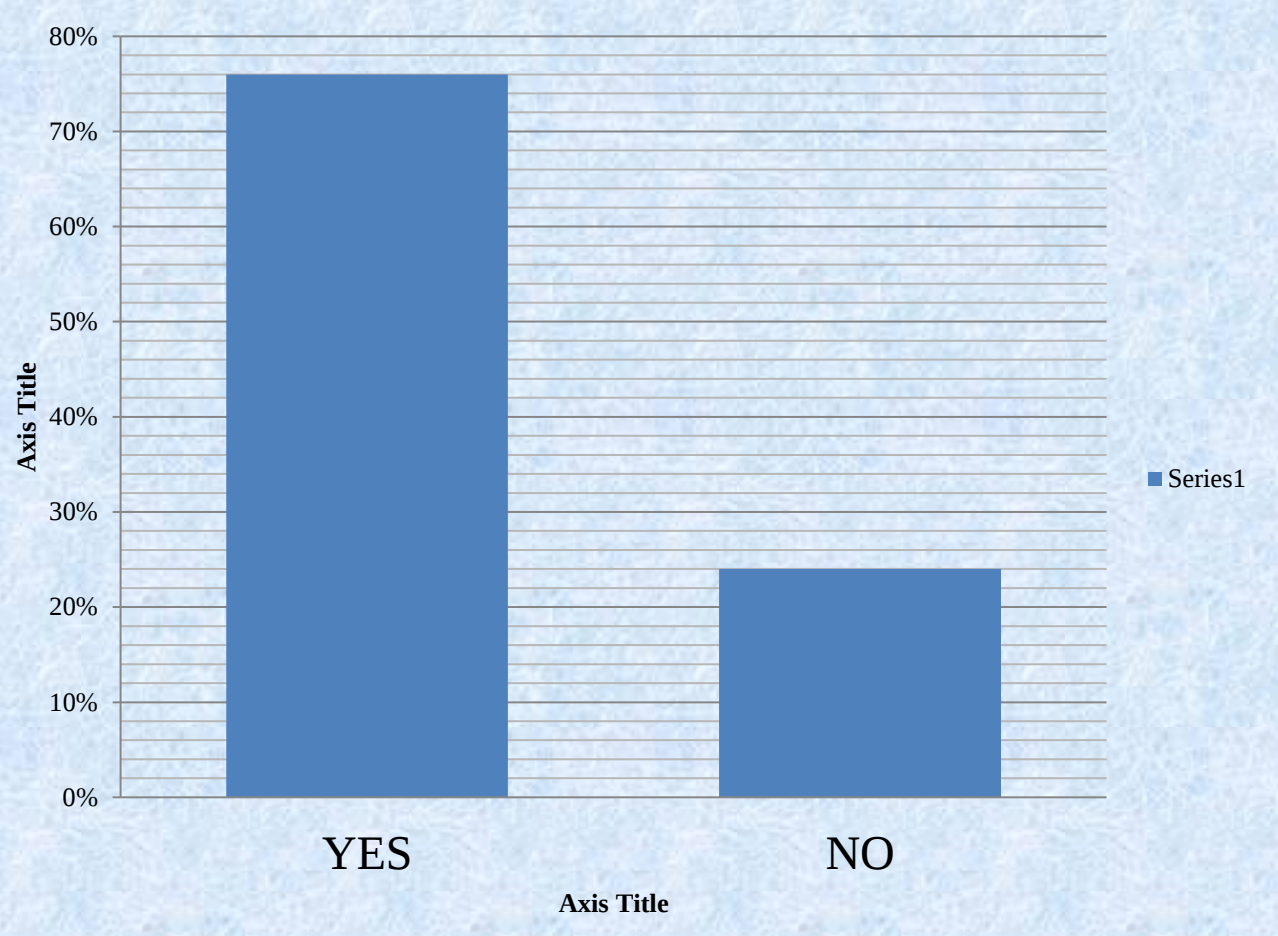
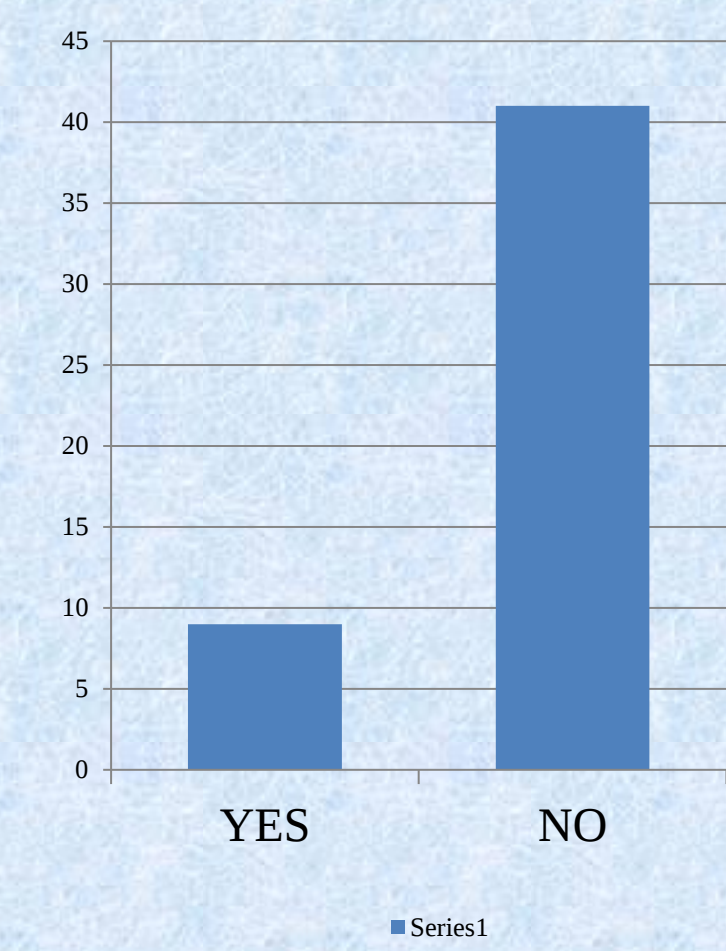
Utilization Of the Loan Amount

Suggestions and Conclusion

1. As per the survey it found that social states of woman's are increased. Now there is a growing participation of woman's in the political activities in rural areas, in this situation there is a growing need to develop leadership qualities in the SHG woman's
2. As per diagram of level of literacy is very low so there is an urgent need to provide education to all members, at least to impart functional literacy.
3. It is found that lot of SHGs faced the problem of administration which effect SHGs, so I think we have to give then suitable administrative training to all the members of SHGs
4. Proper monitoring is needed on all levels and also Cadre.

Conclusion:

Self-help groups are playing a major role in removing poverty. The SHG model is widely practiced for rural development, poverty alleviation and woman empowerment. It found that SHG woman's are more confident after joining SHG. But the quality of Self-help groups and utilization of loan amount is not good and it is because of lack of proper monitoring and because of cadre like CRP.MCLP, CBKA, MBK.

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
