 - What do users think about reliability and performance?
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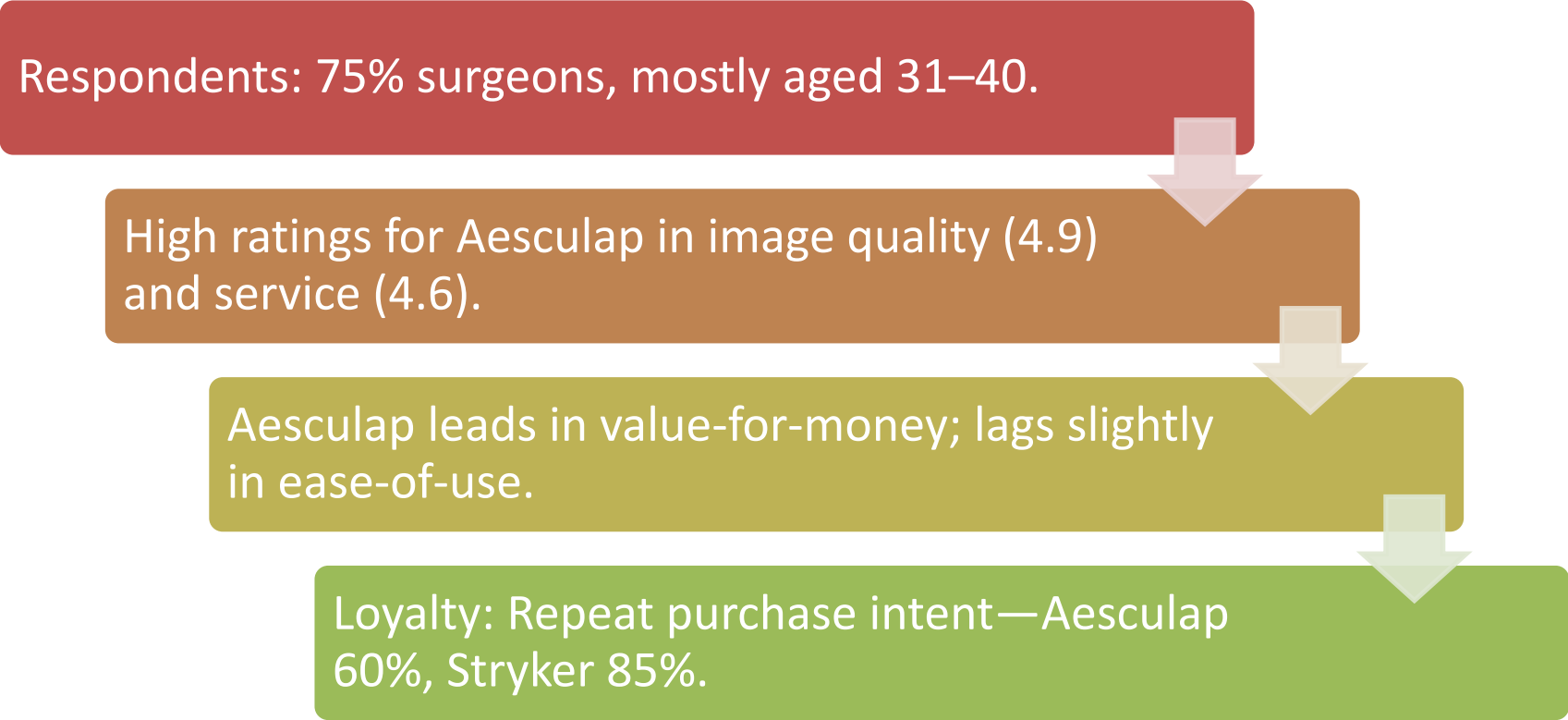
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Methodology

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Survey Results

Respondents: 75% surgeons, mostly aged 31–40.
