- Provide strategic recommendations.

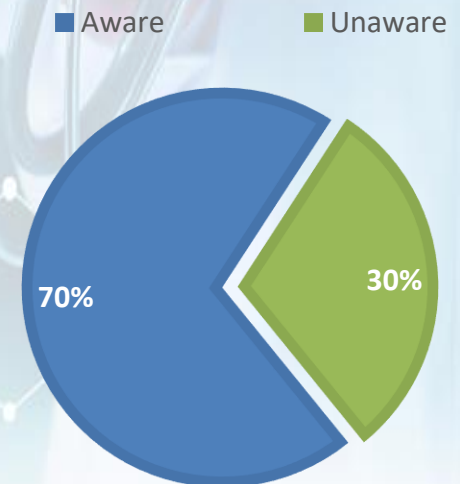
Methodology

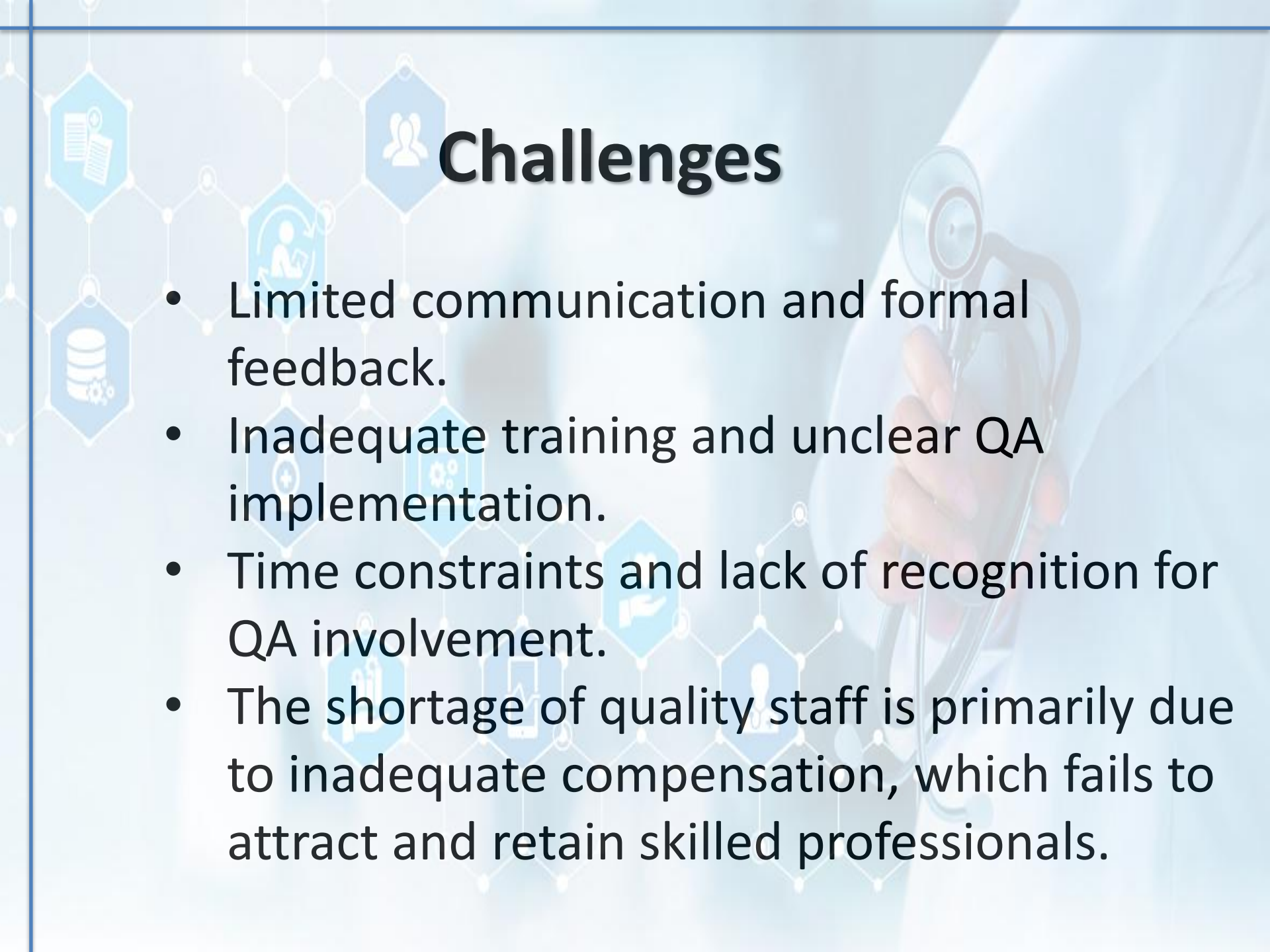
- **Study Design:** Descriptive cross-sectional study.

- **30%** lacked awareness – indicating training and communication gaps.

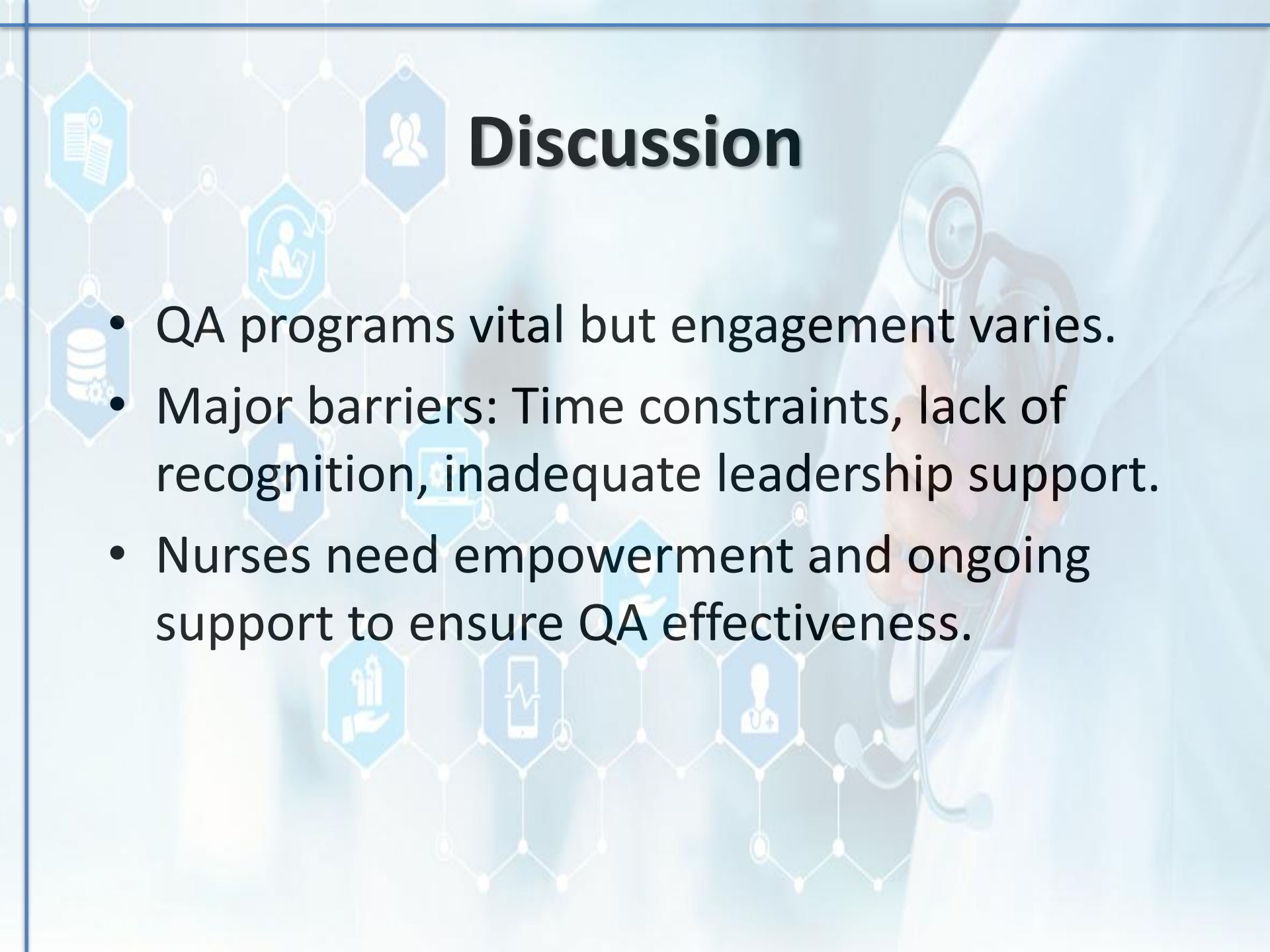
QA AWARENESS
