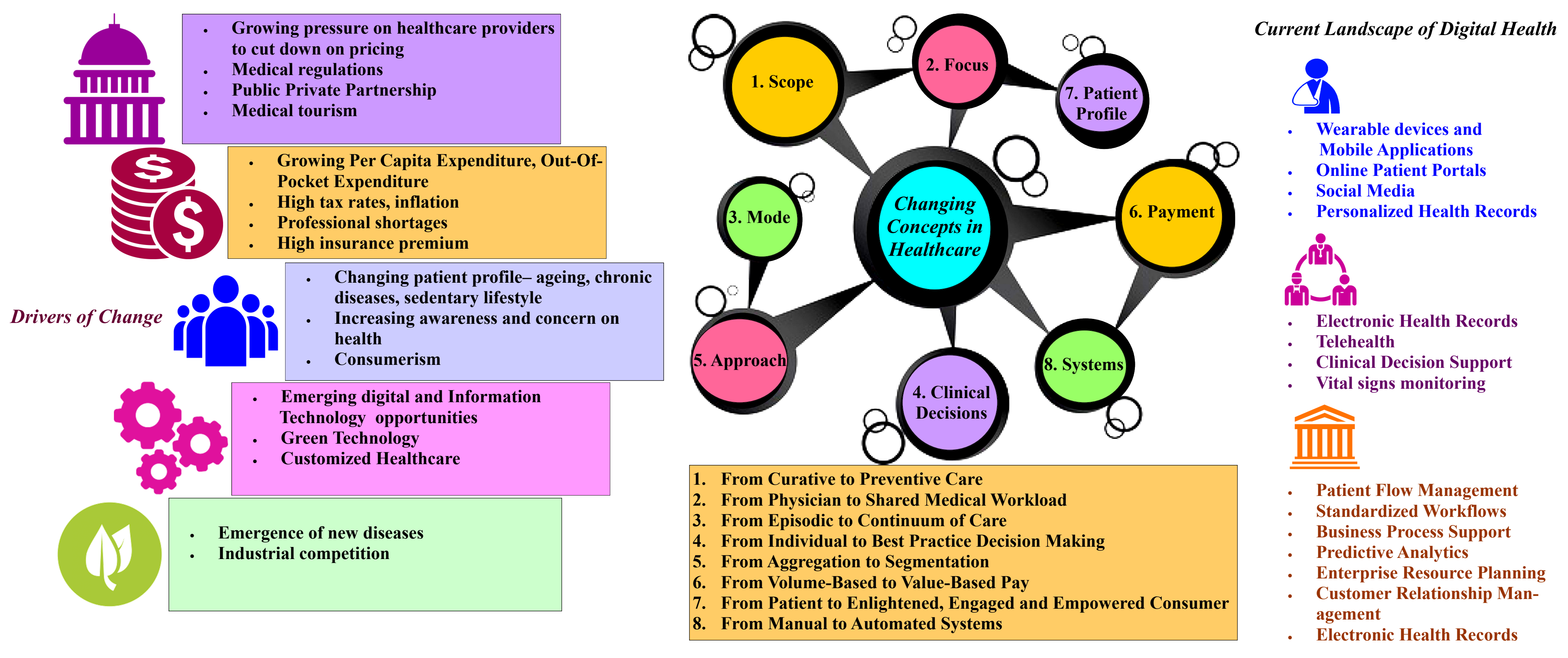
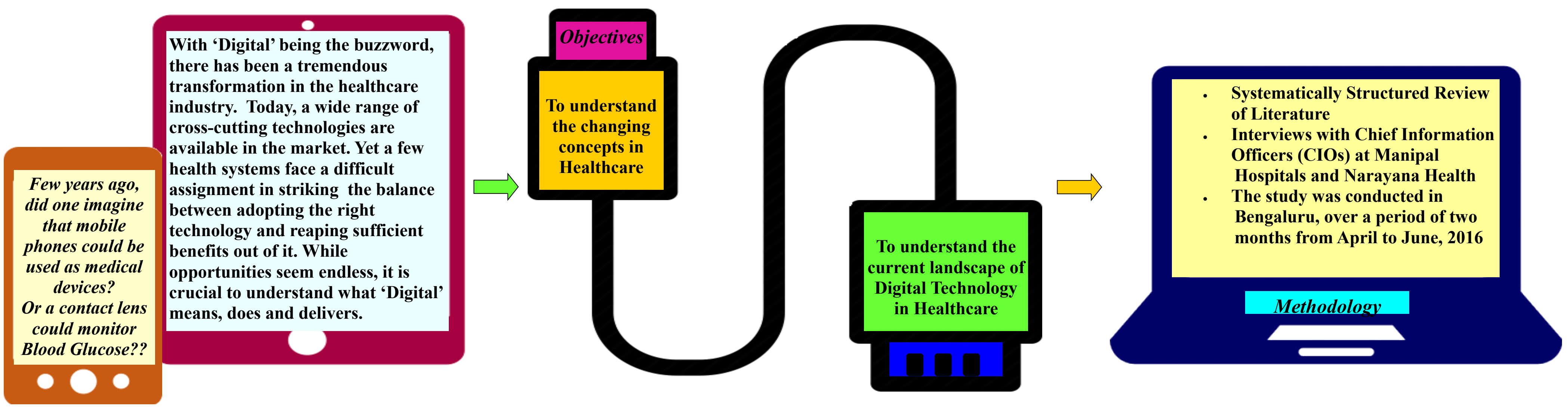

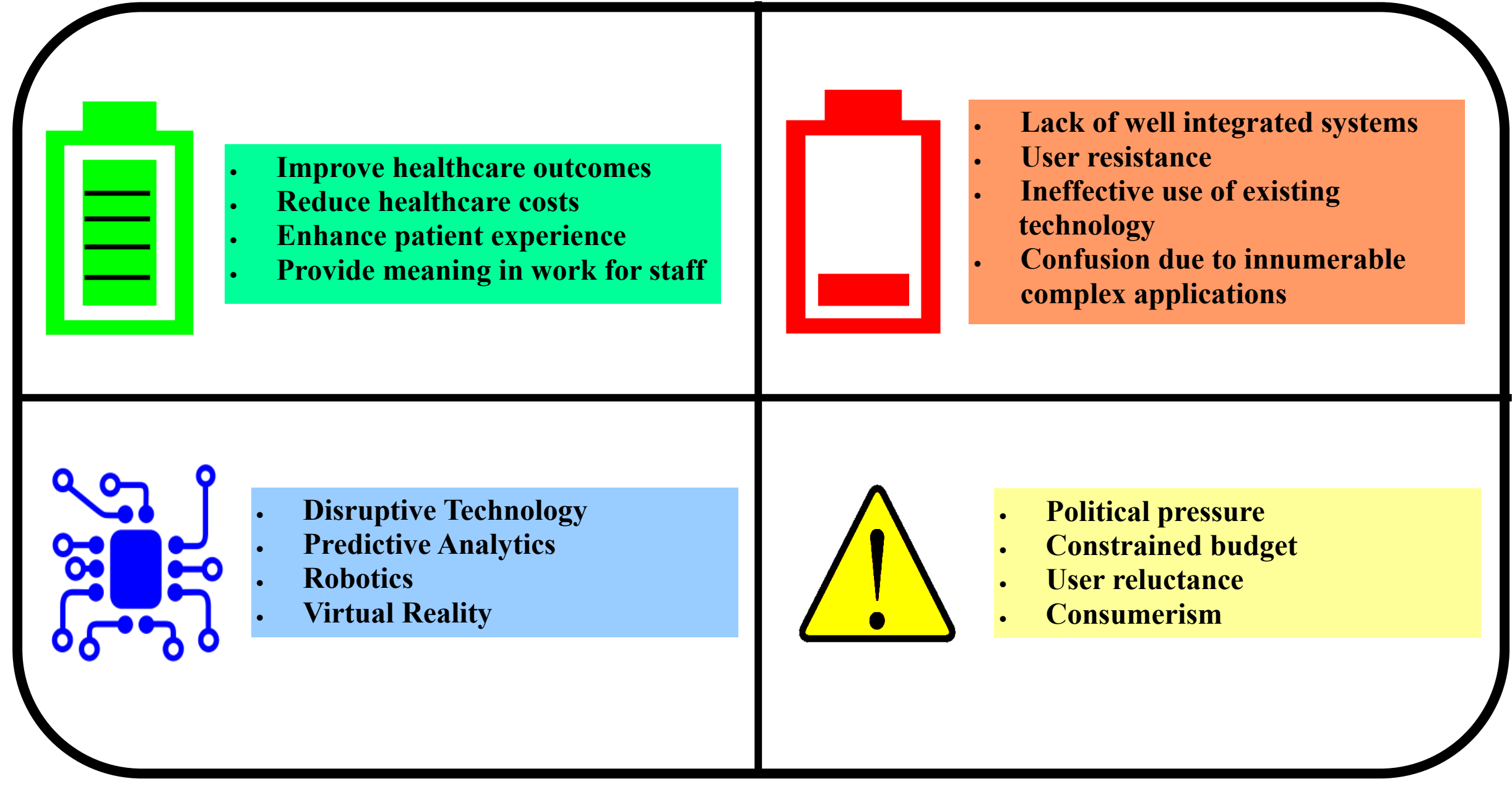

Adoption and Impact of Digital Technology in Healthcare
