SAMPLING TECHNIQUE

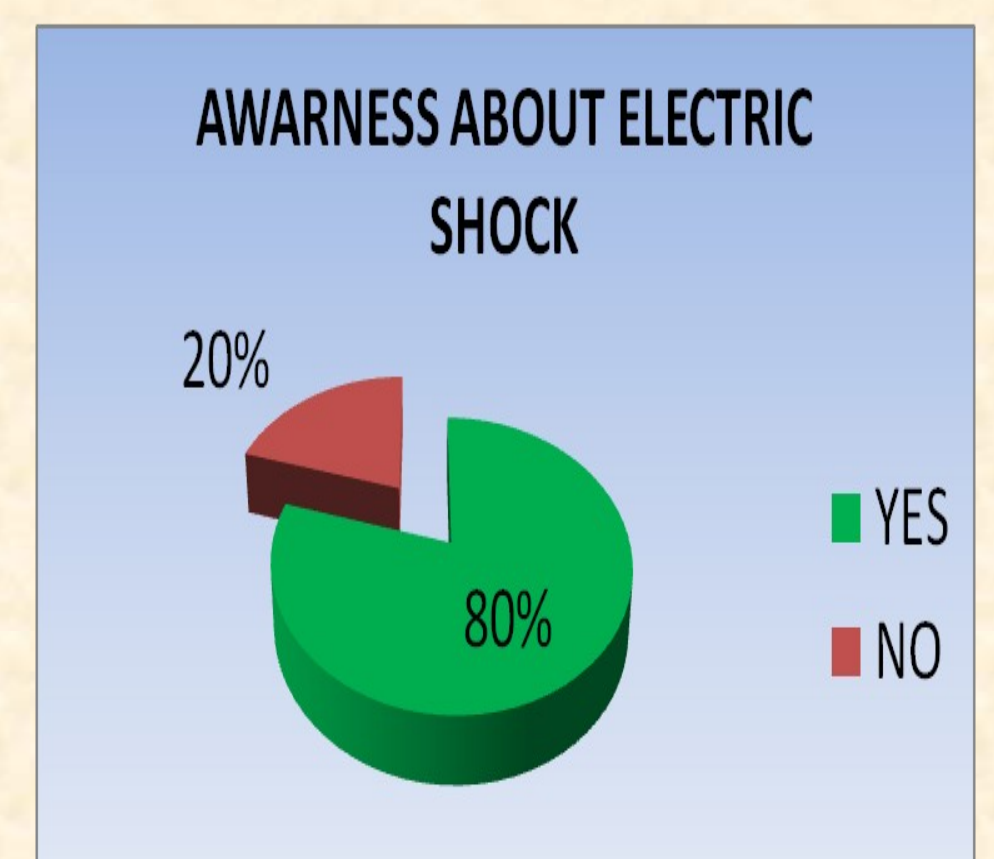
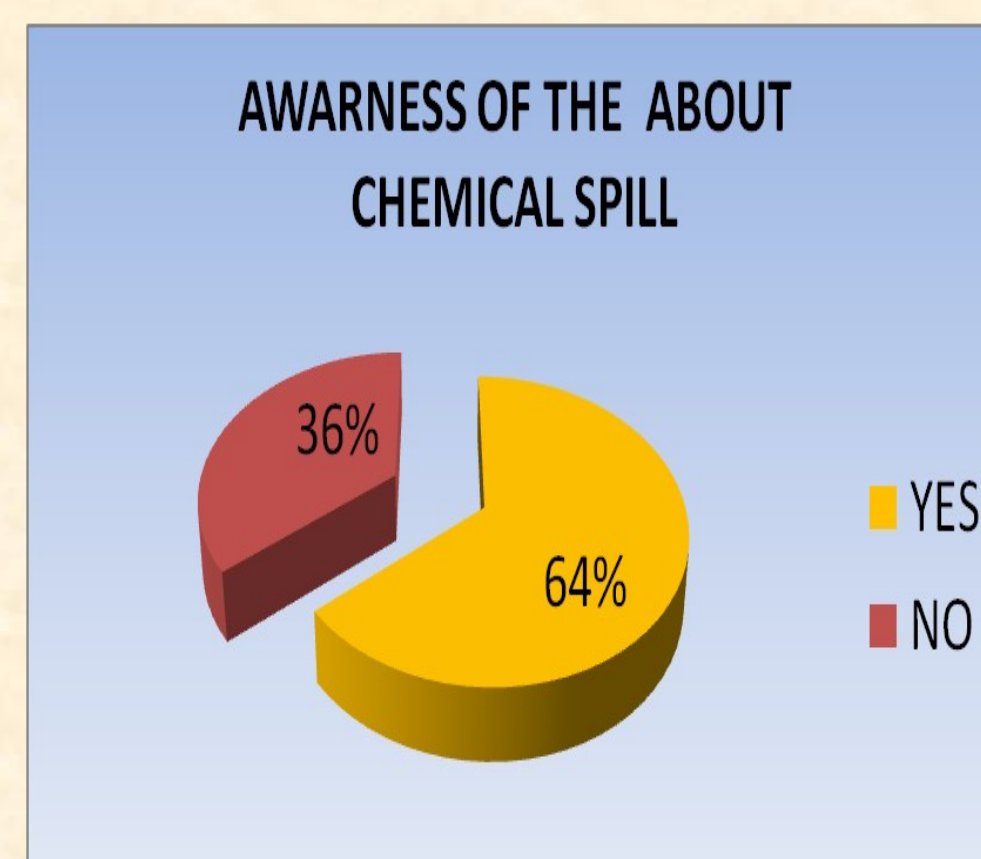
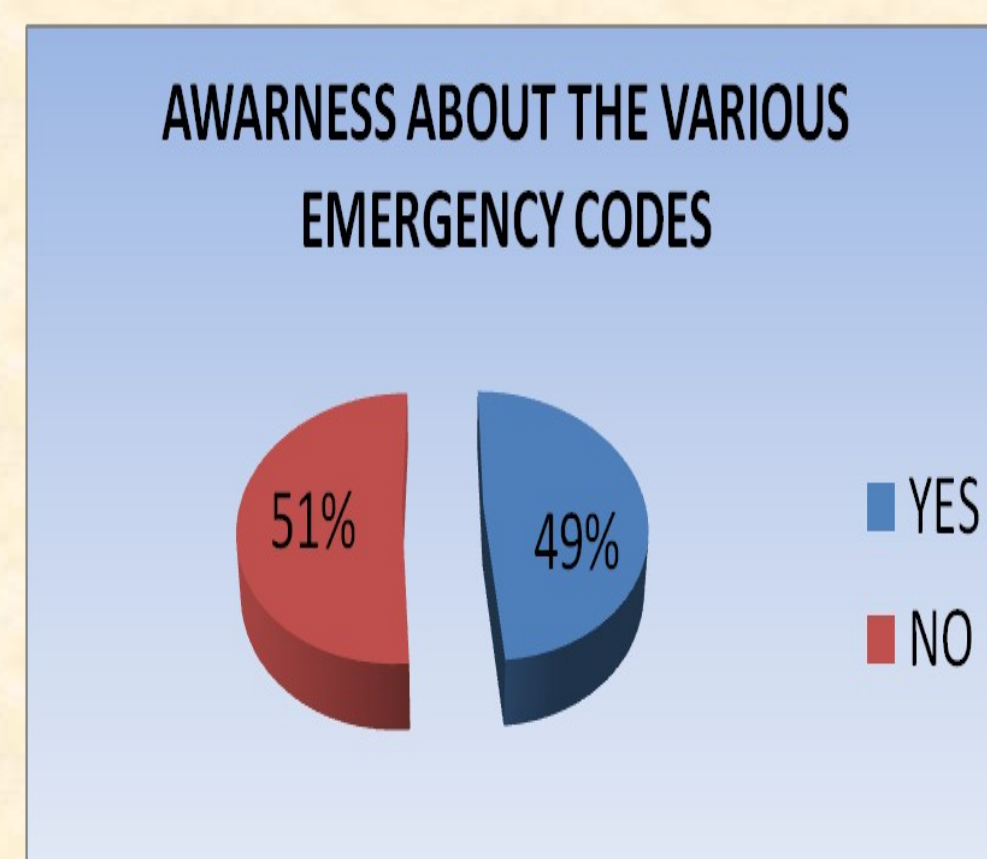
- Non-probability convenience sampling technique has been used.

- Occupational health and safety checklist for different department for seeing practices(Observation)

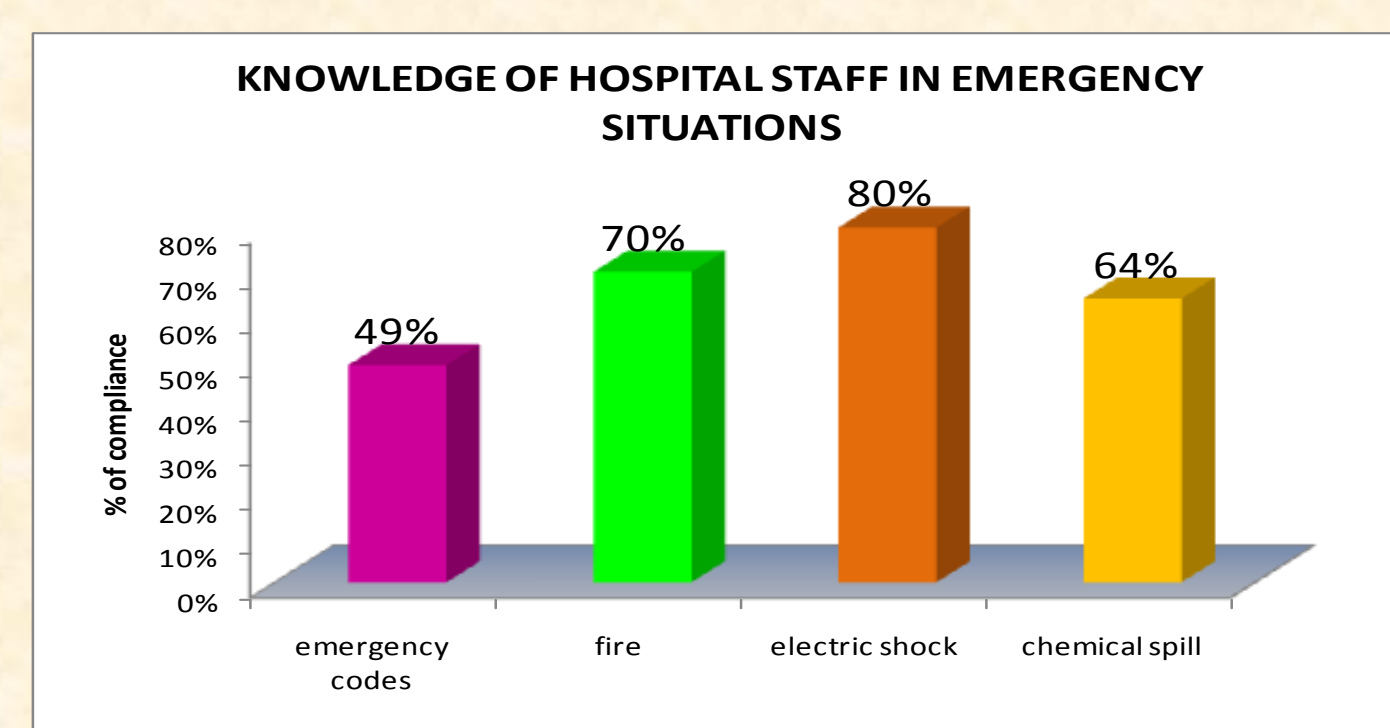
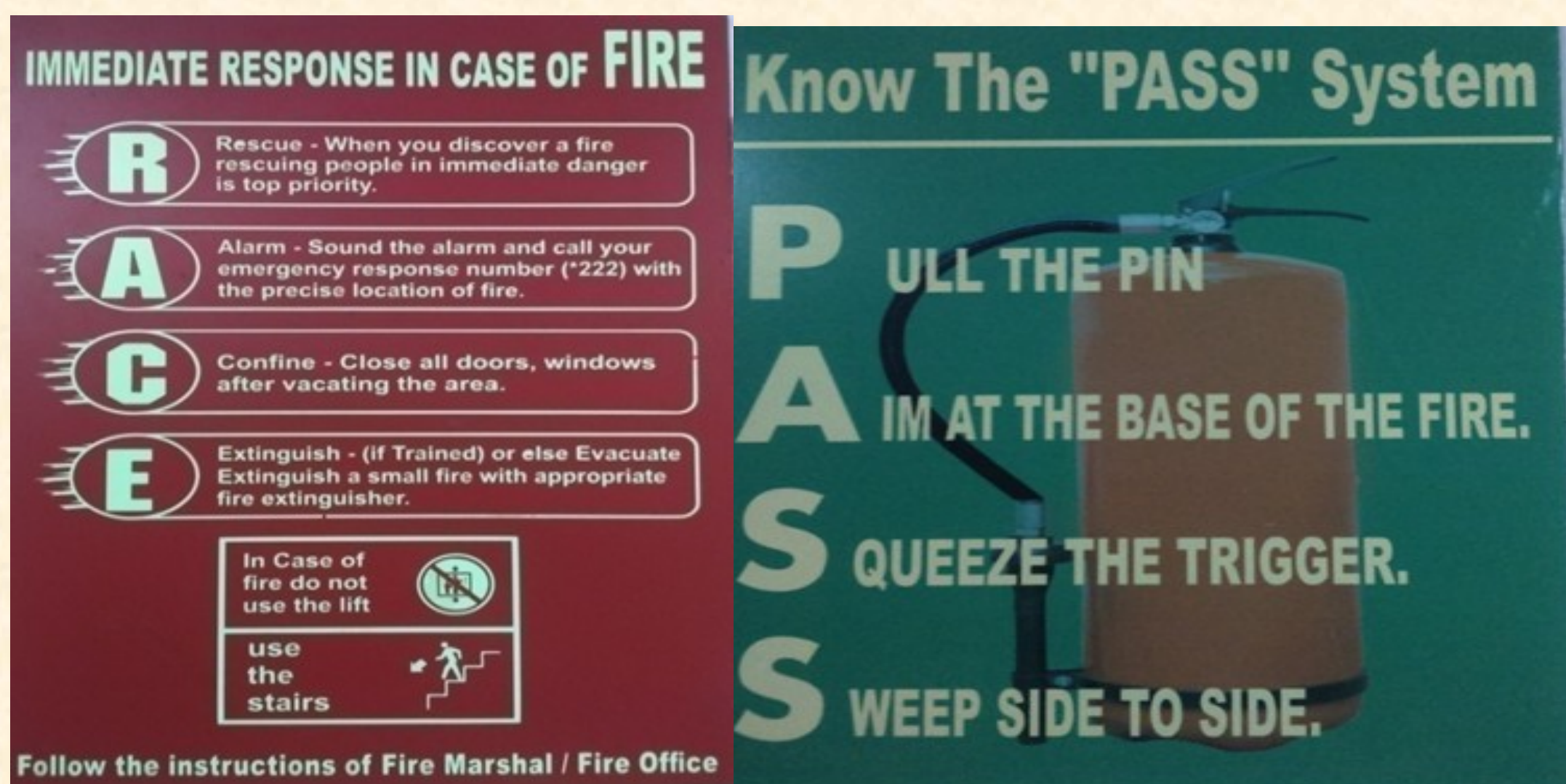
FINDINGS OF THE STUDY

TRAINING NEED ANALYSIS-



On analysis of various practices in emergency situations by Narayana hospital staff, various gaps were identified between the standard practices and the current practices. So there is need of imparting training in particular to use of emergency codes(49%), followed by chemical spill(64%) and in case of emergency fire conditions(70%) .

RECOMMENDATIONS-

- There should be regular/on the job training can be given to the staff in respect to the emergency protocols.
- Proper review of the training imparted through the assessment test by the management.
- Time to time mock drills can be conducted which help the employee about practical usage of codes and procedures used in emergency situations.
