Q. 1. Read the following case of a village and answer the questions. (20 marks)

"A village Sheogarh is an isolated village having 200 households, all belong to scheduled tribe. The village is affected by drought and low agriculture productivity every year. The extreme poor families have no land, little food availability and large family size including young and old people who are not capable of productive work. Some of the poor families also migrate to cities for earning income. Among the poor, widow and people with disability are more vulnerable with no means of livelihood. Majority of population especially women and children in the village are malnourished due to poverty and lack of health care services. Many families are so poor that they even lack basic facilities of sanitation/ toilets. Also, large number of villagers are illiterate and the drop out ratio of children is high as they frequently migrate with the family."

1. You are deployed as rural management professional in the district and came across the situation of the village as above. What would be your first action towards the development of the village?
2. What kind of services may be provided to the community to help them come out of abject poverty?
3. What will be your role to promote education in the village?
4. Describe the strategies to generate awareness in the community.
